AMAZIN' STARTS HERE BROOKLYN CYCLONES (9-8, 9-8)

LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones put up their highest run total of the season in a 13-3 takedown of the Blue Rocks on Wednesday evening...Brooklyn utilized 11 walks en route to the win - five of which came in a seven-run third inning...All nine Cyclones found a way to reach base safely, led by LF Wilfredo Lara and DH Drake Osborn who each logged multi-hit affairs...RHP Douglas Orellana was untouchable out of the pen, tossing five innings while not allowing a baserunner...The win pushes Brooklyn's current streak to four games - the longest such streak of the season.

WALK THIS WAY!: Brooklyn finished Wednesday's 10-run win with 11 walks against Wilmington pitching...The 11 walks matched a season-high and marks the second time in the previous three games that the Cyclones have accomplished the feat...Brooklyn has made it a point to be patient at the plate; the 87 walks **Gilbert Gómez**'s squad has drawn this year is the third-highest mark in the SAL...Brooklyn is averaging over five walks per game...Both IB/OF **Ryan Clifford** (16; T-1st) and INF **William Lugo** (14; T-3rd) enter play Thursday in the top three in the circuit in bases on balls...On the contrary, Brooklyn's arms have allowed just 56 free passes, tied for the fewest in the league.

RUN FOR YOUR LIFE: The Cyclones' offense exploded for seven runs in the bottom of the third in a 13-3 win vs. Wilmington on Wednesday...Brooklyn had 10 consecutive batters reach base with one out in the inning...The seven-run frame was the largest for the Cyclones since they erupted for nine in the bottom of the second inning on July 27, 2023, also against Wilmington, in an 11-7 triumph...The 13 runs for Brooklyn also set a new season high...The Cyclones had not tallied that many in a single contest since a 13-12 win at Asheville in 10 innings on August 24, 2023...It was the first time Brooklyn scored 13+ in a nine-inning game dating back to an 18-1 thrashing at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022...Since 2005, the Cyclones' highwater mark for runs in a single inning is 10 in the top of the sixth of a 20-6 romp at Bowling Green on May 27, 2022...The 20 runs were also a franchise record.

DOGIE HOWSER: RHP Douglas Orellana was untouchable on Wednesday night vs. Wilmington...The 21-year-old retired all 15 batters he faced — striking out six — in five shutout innings of relief, earning the hold...Orellana became the first Cyclone since at least 2005 to throw five or more innings out of the bullpen without allowing a hit...RHP Benito García (8/12/23 vABD), RHP Daison Acosta (6/21/22 vJS), and RHP Chris Schwinden (6.0 IP; 7/18/08 @ONE) each posted 5.0+ innings, but allowed only one hit... Orellana is just the third Brooklyn pitcher in any capacity since 2005 to toss five or more innings without yielding a hit at all...However, the other two allowed a man to reach on a hit-by-pitch...LHP Nelson Pereira (5.0 IP) was the last to do it in a 2-1 win over 14 innings on August 15, 2010, at Williamsport.

YIPPEE KI-YAY: TWP **Nolan McLean** has been a revelation for the Cyclones so far in 2024...The 22-year-old has picked up at least one extra-base hit in all five games he has appeared as a position player and became the first Brooklyn starter to earn a victory in 2024 on Tuesday...At the dish, McLean is 7-for-20 (.350) with six runs scored, four doubles, two home runs, and four RBI...On Saturday, the Willow Springs, N.C. native registered a career-high three hits — including a pair of doubles — and an RBI...Offensively, McLean enters the day tied for 10th in the South Atlantic League with six extra-base knocks, despite at least 26 fewer plate appearances than any of the players tied or ahead of him...On the mound, Nolan is 1-1 with a 4.91 ERA (6 ER in 11.0 IP) with 12 strikeouts in three starts.

LOVE THE DRAKE!: C Drake Osborn has been unstoppable at the plate to start the 2024 season...On Thursday, the 25-year-old notched his fifth straight multi-hit game...Osborn has reached base safely in all nine games he's played, hitting an eye-popping .464 (13-28) with a 1.262 OPS and adding three doubles, a home run, and four RBI...Among players in the South Atlantic League with at least 35 plate appearances, the Corpus Christi, Texas native leads the circuit in batting average (.464), on-base percentage (.583), slugging percentage (.679), and OPS (1.262).

GLORIOUS LORUSSO: INF **Nick Lorusso** has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...The former Maryland Terrapin tied a career-best with three hits in Tuesday's victory, adding a triple and a career-high three RBI...Entering play on Thursday, Lorusso is tied for fourth in the SAL in extra-base hits (7) and total bases (26), sixth in OPS (.946) and tied for sixth in slugging percentage (.553).

TIME TO MAKE THE DONUTS: RHPs Nolan McLean, Dakota Hawkins, and Joey Lancellotti combined on Brooklyn's second shutout of the season, a 5-0 win vs. Wilmington on Tuesday... RHPs Brandon Sproat, Jordany Ventura, and Justin Lawson united on a five-hitter vs. Asheville on April 9...Both of the Cyclones' blankings have been in the first game of their two home series...The Cyclones set a franchise record with 11 shutouts in 2023.

CANARSIE'S OWN: IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** returns to his native Brooklyn to start a minor league rehab assignment on Tuesday, recovering ...The 23-year-old grew up in the Canarsie neighborhood, roughly 10 miles north-

vs. WILMINGTON: Brooklyn opens their first two-week homestand of the season against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks possess three of Washington's top 30 prospects per Baseball America: OF Daylen Lile (11), INF Kevin Made (24), and INF T.J. White (28)...Wilmington swept a three-game season-opening set against Brooklyn, winning the last two games on walk-offs from OF Jared McKenzie...In 30 meetings during the 2023 campaign, Brooklyn posted a 16-14 record against Wilmington, but just a 9-9 record at Maimonides Park...The Cyclones were 7-5 last year against the Blue Rocks at Frawley Stadium...Including 2024, the 'Clones are 44-41 (.518) all-time against the 'Rocks.

east of Maimonides Park...Palmer also attended Holy Cross High School in Flushing, Queens, approximately five miles east of Citi Field...The right-handed swinger has appeared in at least one game with Brooklyn each season since 2021 and enters the day as the franchise's all-time leader in games played (201), runs scored (100), walks (108), stolen bases (49), and hit-by-pitches (17).

DE RECORD SETTER: OF **Omar De Los Santos** enters Wednesday's contest 8-for-9 stealing bases to start the season...The eight swipes are tied for fifth in the South Atlantic League...De Los Santos is second on the Cyclones' all-time stolen base list (45)...He is four steals shy of matching IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer**'s (49) all-time record...Since the start of 2022, De Los Santos is tied for eighth across the Minors for swipes (115)...He broke INF **Walter Rasquin**'s (32) franchise single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023.

GRAB SOME PINE: RHPs Calvin Ziegler, Jordany Ventura, Sean Reid-Foley, Justin Lawson, and Ben Simon united to punch out 18 Asheville batters in April 14's walk-off victory...RHPs Calvin Ziegler, Josh Hejka, Dakota Hawkins, and Joshua Corneilly also combined to strike out 18 Wilmington hitters over 9.2 innings in April 7's loss at Wilmington...The 18 strikeouts by Cyclones pitching are the most for the franchise in a single game since July 23, 2016, vs. Aberdeen...RHP Justin Dunn (5), LHP Kyle Regnault (2), and RHP Nabil Crismatt (11) combined to whiff 18 IronBirds over 9.0 innings in a 7-2 win...The multiple contests with 18+ strikeouts are tied for the most by a Cyclones team since 2005...Brooklyn also accomplished the feat in a pair of extra-inning games in 2016 and two nine-inning games in 2008...The single-game franchise mark for team strikeouts is 22 set in a 20-inning, 3-2 loss vs. Staten Island on June 17, 2016.

KING STANLEY: OF Stanley Consuegra is Brooklyn's all-time leader in several categories, including 44 extra-base hits, 29 home runs, and 98 RBi. On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C Francisco Álvarez for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by Ronny Mauricio in 2021.

YOUTH IS SERVED: Gilbert Gómez takes over as manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2024...At 32 years of age, the Santo Domingo, D.R. native is the youngest skipper in franchise history...After leading Single-A St. Lucie last summer, Gómez served as manager of Tigres del Licey in the Dominican Winter League (LIDOM)...Became the youngest manager to win a championship in LIDOM history and the second-youngest manager to win a game in Caribbean Series history...Gómez's younger brother, **Dariel**, played at Double-A Binghamton in the Mets' organization last summer and is currently with the Charleston Dirty Birds of the MLB Partner Atlantic League...Older brother, **Dosé**, is a scout for the Tampa Bay Rays and general manager for LIDOM's Leones del Escogido...Older brother, **Héctor**, is a well-known baseball reporter...Gómez also played seven years in New York's farm system, posting a .662 OPS in 537 games.

GENIUNE DRAFT: Eight members of last summer's New York Mets' draft class are with the Cyclones early in 2024...Pregent returned to the roster, while second-round selection RHP **Brandon Sproat** and third-round pick two-way player **Nolan McLean** are scheduled to make their High-A debuts...**FIP Noah Hali** (7th), INF **Nick Lorusso** (9th), RHP **Brett Banks** (1ith), RHP **Ben Simon** (13th), and RHP **Justin Lawson** (15th) round out the group...RHP **Dakota Hawkins**, who signed as an undrafted free agent, is also with the club.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to Baseball America and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have four of the Top 30 per BA: Ryan Clifford (No. 5), Brandon Sproat (1), Nolan McLean (15), and Calvin Ziegler (29)...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Clifford (4), Sproat (13), McLean (19), Ziegler (22), and INF Wilfredo Lara (23)...MLB Pipeline also considers Clifford the 93rd-best farmhand in all of baseball.

PROSPECT RADAR: After a stellar 2023 season, De La Cruz was deemed the New York Mets' No. 39 prospect entering the 2024 campaign by *Baseball America*.

WELCOME TO BROOKLYN: The 22-year-old joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie last year on August 22 and thrived over three starts...De La Cruz accumulated a 2-1 record with a 2.45 ERA (5 ER in 17.0 IP) with five walks and 17 strikeouts...The southpaw hurled quality starts in two of his three starts, including going all 6.0 innings in the lid-lifter of a doubleheader on August 31 at Greenville...After allowing a leadoff home run, De La Cruz retired 18 of the final 19 batters he faced, including sitting the last 11 down in order...The southpaw was credited with a complete game, the first for a Brooklyn pitcher since RHP José Butto accomplished the feat, tossing 6.0 innings in a 7-inning loss at Aberdeen in Game 1 of a twinbill on June 30, 2021...After making his SAL debut on August 23 at Asheville, De La Cruz ranked third in the circuit in WHIP (0.94), fifth in batting average against (.183), and sixth in ERA (2.65).

FELIPE FINISHES WITH A FLOURISH: De La Cruz racked up the strikeouts in bunches over his final month at Single-A...Over his final 8 appearances (7 starts), De La Cruz paced the Florida State League and all Single-A players in strikeouts (57)...Struck out 8 more batters than Clearwater's LHP **Danny Wilkinson** (49) who was second...De La Cruz went 1-2 with a 4.33 ERA (17 ER in 35.1 IP) with 18 walks (11.4 BB%) and 57 strikeouts (36.1%).

FLORIDA STATE FELIPE: De La Cruz was among the best strikeout artists in the Florida State League in 2023...Among FSL pitchers with 90.0 or more innings pitched, the 22-year-old led the circuit in strikeout rate (28.7%)...The southpaw also led the league in strikeouts-per-9 innings (11.36) and swinging strike rate (15.5%), while ranking 2nd in xFIP (3.68)...In 21 appearances (19 starts) with St. Lucie, De La Cruz was 3-6 with a 4.68 ERA (47 ER in 90.1 IP), 41 walks, and 114 strikeouts.
