#### **BIG INNINGS DROP CARDS TO 7TH STRAIGHT DEFEAT:** The Northwest Arkansas Naturals had 3 innings of 3 or more runs and racked up a season-high 20 hits as the Cardinals fell 14-7 on Sunday afternoon at Hammons Field. The loss is Springfield's 7th in a row, the longest skid for the Cardinals this year. **Bryan Torres, Jimmy Crooks** and **Jeremy Rivas** each had two hits for the Cardinals, and Torres extended his hitting streak to 8. **Steven Matz** threw three perfect innings for the Cards in his second rehab start with Springfield, but the Cards bullpen surrendered 14 runs in just 7 innings. With 6 games remaining in the first half, the Cardinals sit 1.5 games back of the Arkansas Travelers.



**DPPOSING STARTER:** Right-hander **Tyler Guilfoil** makes his 10th start (13th appearance) of the season for the Hooks...Last pitched on Wednesday, June 12 at San Antonio and allowed 3 ER on 5 H over 4.0 IP while walking 5 and striking out 4...Did not factor in the decision, a 7-6 Corpus Christi loss...Has allowed 6 ER over 10.0 IP (5.40 ERA) in June after going 2-2 with a 2.51 ERA in 6 appearances in May...Split the his first full season in 2023 between High-A Asheville (5 appearances) and Low-A Fayetteville (18 appearances) and went 3-6 with a 3.21 ERA over 23 total appearances (13 starts) overall...Made 7 appearances after being drafted in 2022 between the FCL and Fayetteville...Selected by the Astros in the 8th round of the 2022 draft out of Kentucky...Named 1st team All-American by Baseball America, NCBWA, and Perfect Game as a junior at Kentucky going 3-1 with a 1.59 ERA and 6 saves in 21 relief appearances...Spent his first 3 collegiate seasons at Lipscomb where he served as the Bison's closer saving 13 games from 2018-21...Grew up in Lexington, 1 mile from UK's campus...24 years old

**CARDINALS VISIT CORPUS CHRISTI TO CONCLUDE FIRST HALF:** The Cardinals make their only trip to the Gulf of Texas this season for their first of two matchups with the Corpus Christi Hooks (Double-A, Houston Astros). The Cards have not visited Corpus Christi since 2022 when they lost 4 of 6. In the only series between the two clubs in 2024, the Cardinals went 4-2 at Hammons Field from August 22-27.

#### **CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD**



The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

FIRST HALF PENNANT RACE: With just 6 games to play, the Cardinals are in a tight race for the 1st half title with the Arkansas Travelers and Tulsa Drillers. Arkansas leads the division by 1.5 games over the Cards while the Drillers are 2.5 games back. The Cards' last 1st half title came in 2016 when they went 41-29 and won the division by 3.5 games over Tulsa. Springfield won the 2nd half title last season and lost in the Division Series to the Travelers. Arkansas' magic number to clinch the first half title is 5.

**SKIDDING:** In the middle of a tight pennant first half race, the Cardinals come into the series opener in Corpus Christi on a season-high 7-game losing streak. The Cards last lost 7 straight from June 26-July 2, 2021, and their last 8-game skid came May 7-15 that same season. During their losing streak the Cards have a league-high 6.32 ERA and have surrendered a league-high 11 HR, 10 of which came last week against NW Arkansas. Offensively, the Cardinals are averaging just 3.1 runs per game and have homered just twice.

HOME vs ROAD: For a majority of the 2024 season, the Cardinals have had much more success on the road than at Hammons Field. After winning their first 8 games of the season at home, the Cardinals have dropped 18 of their last 23 games at Hammons field, a stretch that includes a franchise record-tying 8-game home skid. Overall the Cardinals are 13-18 with a team ERA of 6.05 at

Road games, however, have been a much different story. The Cardinals are 20-12 with a 3.66 ERA away from Hammons Field, both numbers trailing the Frisco RoughRiders for the 2nd-best road marks in the league. The Cards went 8-4 on their most recent 12-game trip through Wichita and North Little Rock.

**GRINDIN':** Simply put, the Cardinals don't strike out very much. The Cards have struck out the 2nd-fewest times in all of full-season Minor League Baseball with 445 whiffs in 63 games. The only team with fewer strikeouts than Springfield is the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (426 K in 63 games). The Cards are averaging just 7.06 K's per game.

FOR STARTERS: More often than not recently, Cardinals starting pitchers have given their club a chance to wib. Since May 27 in Wichita, Springfield starters are 4-4 with a 3.74 ERA (35 ER in 84.1 IP) over their last 17 games.

CARDS ON WRONG SIDES OF POWER: While the Cardinals are at or near the top of the Texas League in several important categories, such as batting average (1st), hits (1st) and strikeouts (3rd), Springfield is on the wrong side of home runs on both sides of the ball. The Cards have the lethal combination of allowing the most home runs (71) while hitting the fewest (33) this season.

The Cardinals are on pace to give up 155 HR, which would be just 3 more than they gave up all of last season (152). Springfield, however, is on pace to hit 72 homers this season, wich would be the fewest in the Texas League since 2016 when the Arkansas Travelers hit 71. The Cardinals have run especially cold over the last month, with just 8 HR since May 18, and have allowed a league-high 27. The next lowest umber in the league during that time is 17 (Corpus Christi & Midland). Over their first 36 games leading up to May 18 Springfield had hit 25 homers, good for 7th in the circuit. The Cards have hit just 3 HR over their last 19 games. The last time Springfield hit more than one home run in a game was May 21 in a 7-6 win against Tulsa at Hammons Field (Nathan Church & Matt

RELEASE THE PRESSURE: During their 7-game losing streak, the Cardinals have had a tough time generating offense. Springfield has scored 22 runs (3.1/game) and is batting .236 as a team during that time with a .623 OPS, .293 SLG and just 9 extra base hits compared to 45 singles. The Cardinals have also scuffled with runners in scoring position, going 13-for-62 (.209).

**REDMOND ON DOORSTEP OF SPRINGFIELD HISTORY:** With his

go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger Chandler Redmond tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with Xavier Scruggs (2010-13). Redmond already holds the Springfield record for career

Since tying the record, however, Redmond has gone 33 straight games without a home run.
