NO-NO IN SB: In game two of the doubleheader on June 5th, Eriq Swan and Roque Gutierrez combined to throw the second no-hitter in Loons history, a 3-0 win.

Swan went six innings and Gutierrez collected the final three outs in a seven-inning contest. South Bend had just three baserunners, all walks and were struck out nine times.

The first GL no-hitter was on July 23rd, 2021 against Lake County in Eastlake, Ohio. A nine-inning combination from pitchers Clayton Beeter, Bobby Miller, Jake Cantleberry and Cameron Gibbens.

WAGS TO RICHES: Logan Wagner in his last 21 games has four home runs and 16 RBI, taking the team lead in longballs (9) and has the second most runs batted in (43) in the Midwest League.

The 21-year-old has only missed two games in 2025. Wagner supplied the lone walk-off for Great Lakes this season, an RBI single on June 1st.

BY GEORGE! Kendall George stole six bases on Sunday, May 18th at Dow Diamond against Lake County. The previous franchise record was four.

George became the fourth player in Midwest League/High-A Central history with a six stolen base game. Beloit's Emaarion Boyd on April 9th, 2025, Wisconsin's David Hamilton on June 2, 2021, and Mount Vernon's Charles Popovich on May 16th, 1951 were the three other instances.

JOSUE LEADS THE WAY: 20-year-old Josue De Paula is tenth in the Midwest League in OPS (.856) amongst qualified players.

Saturday, May 10th was the Dodgers No. 2 prospect's second multi-homer game as a pro. He hit two over the left field fence against former big leaguer Wade Miley in Dayton.

De Paula a left-handed hitter mashes against left-handed pitchers. The Brooklyn, New York native is hitting .338 with four homers, and a .995 OPS in 71 at-bats. His OPS is second-best among qualified players, CR's Nate Baez has a 1.057 in 33 at-bats

A NEW HOPE: Zhyir Hope's 41 RBI is fifth in the Midwest League. The 20-year-old ranks fifth in OPS (.884) among qualified players.

Hope reached 19 RBI in 58 at-bats, the fastest Loon to 19 RBI ever in the first month of the season. He is the third Loon to gain 20 RBI in April, with 21. Jerry Sands had 22 RBI in April 2010 and Kyle Farmer drove in 21 in April 2014.

The Dodgers No. 3 prospect has 16 doubles tops on on the Loons and is top 5 in home runs (7), triples (2), stolen bases (7) & batting average (.303).

FUN FIRSTS: The Loons have scored in the first inning in 25 of the first 66 games. Great Lakes has tallied 44 runs, 11 home runs and a .813 OPS in the first frame of games, the most HR and best OPS in the Midwest League.

STOLEN BASE CHASE: In 2024, Great Lakes had 203 stolen bases in 130 games, setting a new franchise record. This year the Loons have 91 stolen bases in 64 games, which paces for 183 stolen bases in an 131 game season.

STRIKEOUT SUMMER: Great Lakes has led the Midwest League in pitcher strikeouts the last three seasons. Last year they compiled 1263 in 130 games. In 2023, they struckout 1303 and in 2022 they punched out a franchise best 1398, they averaged 10.5 per game. In 2025, they are pacing for 1228 which would be their lowest total since the 2021 season.

LOON -> SHOW: In 2025, 10 former Loons have made their MLB Debut. Jack Little is the 129th Loon to appear in MLB.

MANAGER

Jair Fernandez

The Great Lakes Loons in conjunction with the Los Angeles Dodgers have named Jair Fernandez as their manager for the 2025 season. Fernandez will manage Great Lakes for the second straight season. Jair Fernandez is the 11th manager in the Loons' 18-year history and the fourth to return for a second year. 2025 will be Fernandez's ninth season as a coach within the Los Angeles Dodgers organization. This will be Jair's second stint with the Great Lakes Loons. He served as the hitting coach in 2017 and 2018. The Loons hit a combined .240 in those two seasons, accumulating 192 home runs. For his home country, Fernandez has served in a multitude of coaching roles. In 2017 and 2023, he coached for Team Colombia in the World Baseball Classic. He manned third base in the 23' Classic. In the Colombian League, played annually from October to January, Fernandez managed two different franchises from 2016 to 2018. Leones de Monteria for two seasons and Tigres de Cartagena midway through the end of the 2018 campaign. Fernandez, 38, debuted in minor league baseball in 2007 at the age of 18 in the Seattle Mariners organization. The Colombian-born catcher spent nine seasons in baseball, appearing with two teams at the Triple-A level. Fernandez played within four major league organizations, the Mariners, Minnesota Twins, Houston Astros, and Chicago Cubs. Two summers were spent in the Midwest League. In 2008, he was an MWL All-Star with the Beloit Snappers, now the Beloit Sky Carp. Beloit was then affiliated with the Twins. He had 36 hits in 36 games, batting .283 and posting a .703 OPS. Before that season, he was traded from the Mariners organization to the Twins organization for 34-year-old R.A. Dickey. Fernandez totaled 470 games in his minor-league career, 31 at the Triple-A level including two with Oklahoma City, in 2012. Since 2015, Oklahoma City has been a Dodgers affiliate.

PITCHING COACH

Sean Coyne

Sean Coyne joins the Loons as their pitching coach for the 2025 season. Coyne, 28, led the Rancho Cucamonga 2024 pitching staff to 1282 strikeouts the third-most in the California League despite the fewest innings pitched. For the last two seasons, Coyne served as pitching coach for the Quakes winning a California League South Division championship in 2023. He joined L.A. as a development coach in 2022 and was assigned as the pitching coach for the organization's Arizona Complex League team in 2022. Coyne, a 2019 graduate of Westmont College, pitched for the Warriors for four seasons, posting a 3.39 ERA over 95.2 innings and earning five saves. After graduating with a degree in Kinesiology, Coyne began his coaching career as a part-time pitching coach at Scripps Ranch High School in San Diego, California. In 2020, he became an intern at Driveline Baseball in Seattle, WA. Coyne previously trained at the facility during his time at Westmont. His college roommate and former teammate Rob Hill worked for Driveline before taking a pitching coordinator job with the Dodgers in 2020. Hill is now the Dodgers' Director of Pitching. In 2021, Coyne returned to Westmont as a part-time assistant pitching coach and groundskeeper under Rober Ruiz. Hill gauged Coyne's interest in the possibility of pro ball over a phone call over the summer, and Coyne was hired that Fall. A native of El Cajon, CA, attended St. Augustine High School in San Diego, CA. Coyne is the 12th pitching coach in Loons history.

PITCHING COACH

Eduardo Dominguez

Eduardo Dominguez will join the Loons 2025 coaching staff as a pitching coach. Over the last two seasons, Dominguez was one of four pitching coaches for the Dodgers club in the Dominican Summer League. Dominguez was a 2019 international signing of the Dodgers, along with former Loons Yeiner Fernandez and Luis Rodriguez. A native of Madrid, Spain, Dominguez would start his career in the Dominican Summer League playing for both Dodgers Bautista and Dodgers Shoemaker in 2021. The left-hander pitched to a 4.85 ERA over 26 innings. During his youth playing career, Dominguez represented Spain in international play, earning a silver medal in the U-18 Baseball European Championship and competing in the WBSC U-18 Baseball World Cup in South Korea.

HITTING COACH

Kevin LaChance

Kevin LaChance, 30, will serve as the Loons' hitting coach in 2025. This is LaChance's second year as a coach within the Los Angeles Dodgers organization. In February 2024, LaChance was hired by the Dodgers and was the hitting coach for the 2024 Arizona Complex League Champions, the ACL Dodgers. The group had the top on-base percentage (.395), second-best OPS (.809), and second-most stolen bases (109) in a 60-game season. LaChance came to the Dodgers after two years teaching baseball at the Colangelo Baseball Academy in Manassas, Virginia, owned by former major leaguer Mike Colangelo. During the off-season, LaChance continues to instruct at the academy. The Clifton, VA native played five seasons of professional baseball. He was a 2016 10th-round draft selection of the Los Angeles Dodgers and played 50 games as a member of the 2017 Pioneer League Champion Ogden Raptors. After being released, LaChance would be signed by the Arizona Diamondbacks and appeared in 33 games across four affiliates in 2019. From the tail end of 2019 through the 2022 season, LaChance played for the Winnipeg Goldeyes of the American Association. A 2016 graduate of the University of Maryland, Baltimore County (UMBC), he played four seasons for the Retrievers baseball team. A career .301 hitter, LaChance started 198 games at UMBC, missing only one game over his tenure. LaChance played his high school ball at Centerville High School. Notable attendees include rapper Ludacris, sports reporter Lindsay Czarniak, and current New England Patriots running backs coach Tony Dews.

BENCH COACH

Joe Thon

Joe Thon will take the bench coach position for the Loons in 2025. Thon comes over from the Houston Astros organization where he was the manager of the Corpus Christi Hooks (Double-A) for two seasons. A 2010 fifth-round draft pick of the Toronto Blue Jays, Thon played six years in Minor League Baseball. Across 2014-2015, Thon played in 118 games with the Lansing Lugnuts of the Midwest League, a then Blue Jay affiliate. Following his playing career, Thon attended the University of Houston where he studied finance. He was informed by former Rice University player Enrique Cruz, son of Astros great Jose Cruz, that the Cougars needed a student assistant. In 2019, Thon completed a business internship with the Astros, and in 2020 was a volunteer assistant with the Cougars. In 2021, he entered the coaching ranks in professional baseball. He became a development coach for the Fayetteville Woodpeckers (Low-A Astros). Joe Thon is the son of Dickie Thon, a 15-year major leaguer who posted a career WAR of 23.9. Dickie was a National League All-Star and Silver Slugger at shortstop in 1983 as a member of the Houston Astros. In his fifth game of the 1984 season, Dickie was struck in the eye with a baseball hurled by Mets pitcher Mike Torrez. He battled vision and depth perception problems throughout the rest of his career, which lasted until 1993.
