HAPPY OPENING NIGHT: The Fredericksburg Nationals begin the 2023 campaign - their third in Fredericksburg - on Friday night at Virginia Credit Union Stadium against the Lynchburg Hillcats. The FredNats are coming off a 75-55 regular season record in 2022, won the second half championship in the Carolina League North Division, and topped the Carolina League in many important statistical categories. This year's Opening Day roster features eight of the top 30 Washington Nationals prospects, and promises to be one of the most exciting young teams in all of Minor League Baseball. Fredericksburg faces Lynchburg, the Single-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, in a three-game series to open the season and will begin the traditional six-game series next week when the team travels to face the Fayetteville Woodpeckers. Lynchburg defeated the FredNats last Septemebr in the Carolina League North Divisional Playoff series. 2022 second round pick Jake Bennett makes his professional debut for the FredNats as the Opening Night starter. The lefty from Oklahoma follows in the footsteps of his college teammate Cade Cavalli in the Washington organization.

OPENING DAY BLUES: Since moving to Fredericksburg, the team is 0-2 on Opening Day with both losses coming to the Delmarva Shorebirds. This is the first time the FredNats have played anyone other than Delmarva on Opening Day. The organization has not won an Opening Day game since 2016 when the franchise was still located in Potomac. Coincidentally, that last Opening Day win for the organization came against the Wilmington Blue Rocks, who are now the High-A affiliate of the Nationals and the next team up the organizational ladder. That 2016 Opening Day win also came on April 7. The Blue Rocks switched to the High-A South Atlantic League after the Covid reorganization of Minor League Baseball.

PROSPECTS APLENTY: The 2023 FredNats Opening Day roster is loaded with young talent as the Washington organization continues to rebuild. Fredericksburg features eight of the top-30 Nationals prospects (according to MLB Pipeline) on the Opening Day roster, including four of the top nine prospects. 2022 first round draft pick Elijah Green leads the way at No. 3, 2021 first-rounder Brady House is No. 5, Jarlin Susana is No. 6, and 2022 second rounder Jake Bennett slots in at No. 9. Other top-30 prospects on the Opening Day roster include Armando Cruz (No. 14), Daylen Lile (No. 16), Roismar Quintana (No. 17), and Brenner Cox (No. 23). All but one of those prospects was either drafted by the Nationals or signed internationally by Washington, with Susana being the lone exception as he came over from San Diego in the Juan Soto trade last August.

BACK IN THE 'BURG: The FredNats' Opening Day roster features 16 players that played in at least one game in Fredericksburg last year. Those names are Pablo Aldonis, Jose Atencio, Bryan Caceres, Mason Denaburg, Miguel Gomez, Jarlin Susana, Max Romero, Steven Williams, Paul Witt, Branden Boissiere, Armando Cruz, Brady House, Sammy Infante, Cortland Lawson, Zion Pettigrew, and Murphy Stehly.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from 2022 returns to the Managerial role for 2023. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg after winning the Washington organizational Manager of the Year award last year after leading the FredNats to a 75-55 record. Lowery, 32, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978.

THE STAFF: Joining Lowery on the staff is returning hitting coach Delwyn Young, pitching coach Justin Lord, returning developmental coach Carmelo Jaime, athletic trainer Jacob Meyer, strength and conditioning coach Nathan Sier, and Performance Analyst Josh Freligh. Young, 41, played parts of five major league seasons with the Dodgers (2006-08) and Pirates (2009-10), and participated in spring training with the Nationals in 2013. Under his guidance, The FredNats' offense scored the most runs in the Carolina League in 2022. He previously served as a hitting coach with Kingsport and Brooklyn in the Mets system, and spent the 2021 season managing the State College Spikes of the MLB Draft League.

Lord, 43, begins his third year in the Washington organization after serving as the Pitching Coach for the Double-A Harrisburg Senators last season. Lord was scheduled to be the FredNats' Pitching Coach in the team's inaugural season in Fredericksburg in 2020, but that season was ultimately canceled due to Covid. Jaime, 37, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and he returns with Lowery and Young as holdovers from last year's FredNat coaching staff. Meyer begins his sixth season in the Washington organization and first in Fredericksburg after spending the first five years of his Nationals career at the Spring Training facility in West Palm Beach, Florida. Sier begins his first year in the Washington organization after previous stops with Macomb Community College in Metro Detroit (Mich.), and ZSP Sports. Freligh steps into the newly-created Performance Analyst role after previous stops with the L.A. Dodgers and Boston Red Sox.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

TONIGHT'S START: A second round draft selection by Washington in the 2022 MLB Draft, Jake Bennett makes professional debut tonight against the Lynchburg Hillcats. The Tulsa-born southpaw was drafted out of high school by the Nats in 2019, before electing to attend the University of Oklahoma.

With the Sooners, Bennett was the Friday night starter through his junior year before declaring for the draft. Bennett dazzled on his way to being named 2nd Team All-American honors by both Baseball America and D1 Baseball.

POSTSEASON PITCHER: Bennett saw his draft stock rise even higher after a series of strong outings in the 2022 College World Series. He fanned 10 Ole Miss batters in 6.1 innings in the CWS Finals, and also struck out eight against Virginia Tech in the Super Regional

FAMILIAR FACES: Bennett enters the Washington system with some foresight - he was both high school and college teammates with Nationals prospect Cade Cavalli
