TODAY'S GAME: The Isotopes hold a 1-0 series lead after winning game one last night, 7-2, ending Albuquerque's twogame losing streak ... Carson Palmquist is slated to start for the Isotopes while Jared Kollar is expected to take the hill for El Paso.

DUKE CITY HR RECORD: Sam Hilliard homered with two outs in the first inning last night, his 79th in an Isotopes uniform – which ties Mike Busch (Dukes, 1993-96) for most among Albuquerque Triple-A players.

ISOTOPES RBI RECORD: Hilliard has 221 RBI with Albuquerque, which ranks third among career leaders in team history. Jordan Patterson (2016-18) is second with 229 RBI.

SAM I AM: With Sam Hilliard's homer yesterday,he has reached base in 10-straight games, every contest he's played this year. It's the seventh longest active on-base streak in the PCL ... Has a walk in five games.

STEAL OF HOME: Aaron Schunk was credited with a steal of home in the sixth inning last night, the 11th time in lsotopes history a player has accomplished the feat. Only two have been straight steals, including the most recent before tonight (Zac Veen on Sept. 7, 2024 at Tacoma).

KEEP IT CLEAN: Albuquerque played their 12th errorless contest in 16 games to begin the season last night. The lsotopes have seven miscues for the year, tied for the second-fewest among Triple-A teams (also: Durham, Memphis and St. Paul).

TAKE YOUR BASE: The Isotopes drew 10 walks last night, a season-high and their most since July 5, 2024, at El Paso (also ten).

VS. EL PASO: Albuquerque has won five of their last six home games against El Paso, dating back to June 12, 2024.

NO HITS FOR YOU: EI Paso collected four hits last night, the third time Albuquerque has limited their opponent to four or fewer knocks in 2025. Last season, the Isotopes allowed at least five hits in all 150 contests.

DINGERS: Albuquerque has homered in 12 of their first 16 games to begin the season ... The club has 24 homers on the year, tied for the most in MiLB (also: Las Vegas).

THE CLOSER: Jaden Hill worked another two scoreless innings of relief last night, with two walks and two strikeouts. The free passes were his first two of the year. Hill has punched out 15 of 29 batters faced this season.

BULLPEN: The Isotopes bullpen's 3.94 ERA (77.2 IP, 34 ER) is the third-lowest in the Pacific Coast League.

REAL SLIM SCHUNKY: Aaron Schunk singled last night and has reached base in six of his last seven contests.

YF: After going 7-for-18 with three homers from April 6-10, Yanquiel Fernandez is hitless in his last three contests (0x10).

RITTER: Ryan Ritter is 3-for-18 with one homer and four RBI over his last five games, average dropped from .344 to .280 ... Drew two walks last night for the first time since July 1, 2024, with Double-A Hartford.

 ${\rm DC}$: Diego Castillo has tossed 3.2 scoreless frames over his first three appearances, allowing just one hit and one walk.

SWIPES: Albuquerque stole three bases last night, a seasonhigh and most since also stealing three bags on September 10, 2024, vs. Las Vegas.

HOMETOWN KID: Jordan Pacheco begins his fourth season as the Isotopes hitting coach ... An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI) ... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his third season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five seasons with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his second year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... The former outfielder played in 33 games for the Isotopes and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the third-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 22) will host the second half winner (beginning June 24) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, on September 27.
