Lansing relief trio **Jack Owen, Will Johnston** and **Micah Dallas** combined for five scoreless innings, limiting the Loons to two hits and one walk while striking out seven, and the Nuts used a four-run fourth inning and a three-run ninth to double up the Loons on Friday night in front of 4,174.

LUG NOTES

Grant's Boom: 2022-23 Lugnuts right-hander **Grant Holman** tossed 1 2/3 scoreless innings on Sunday for Triple-A Las Vegas, continuing a stellar season in which he may very well be the best relief pitcher in all of Minor League Baseball. Holman has made 39 appearances spanning 47 2/3 innings between Midland and Las Vegas, allowing only three earned runs for a 0.57 overall ERA.

Power of Will: First baseman **Will Simpson** tops the MWL in total bases (172), RBIs (71) and extra-base hits (42) while trailing the doubles lead by three (27-24), the runs lead by three (65-62) and the walks lead by nine (74-65).

Roll Call: Infielder **Ángel Arévalo** joined the Lugnuts on the road at Great Lakes and appeared on Saturday as a pinch-runner, becoming the 948th player in team history. This year, the Nuts have used 45 different players: 23 position players, 22 pitchers.

Team Effort: The Nuts' offense ranks 1st in the MWL in at-bats (3,590), base hits (892), total bases (1353) and triples (35); tied for 1st in doubles (175); 2nd in runs (531) and OPS (.716); tied for 2nd in batting avg. (.248); and 3rd in slugging pct (.377) and OBP (.339).

Welcome to the Pros: The A's first round (**Nick Kurtz**), second round (**Tommy White**), third round (**Joshua Kuroda-Grauer**) and fourth round (**Rodney Green, Jr.**) all debuted for Single-A Stockton over the weekend. Kurtz homered in his second professional at-bat and has opened 3-for-8 (.375) with two walks; Kuroda-Grauer went 3-for-5 with three runs scored in his debut; White is 3-for-9 with a walk; and Green is 2-for-7 with three walks, two RBIs and a stolen base.

Prospecting: The Nuts have six MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects: pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Ryan Lasko** (No. 16), pitcher **Kade Morris** (No. 20), infielder **Will Simpson** (No. 26), pitcher **Will Johnston** (No. 27) and outfielder **Jared Dickey** (No. 28).

The Future is Here: Lugnuts right-hander **Luis Morales**, today's starting pitcher and the A's No. 1 pitching prospect, tossed 2/3 of an inning in the 2024 All-Star Futures Game at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas, striking out Jeral Pérez and Deyvison De Los Santos alongside an HBP and BB. Morales was the A's sole representative in the prospect showcase, and the fifth all-time current Lugnut to play in the game.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2016: The Lugnuts played two extra-inning games at West Michigan, winning one of them. First, the Nuts and Whitecaps completed a game suspended after 10 innings from the day before, with Ryan Metzler's two-run single driving in Lane Thomas and Connor Panas for a 5-3 11-inning victory, extending the Nuts' winning streak to six games. Interestingly, Jackson Lowery pitched for the second straight day; Lowery had recorded the final two outs the day before (Friday), stranding the bases loaded to end the 10th before pitching a scoreless 11th on Saturday to earn the win. In the regularly scheduled game, Árvicent Pérez's bases-loaded, one-out RBI single in the 12th gave the Whitecaps a walkoff win. It not only ended the Nuts' winning streak, it ended a streak of eight straight Nuts wins against the Whitecaps.

In a Nutshell: Pitched in 2023 with the Nuts, returning to the Midwest League this season... spent the offseason training in Alabama with Tyler Baum... opened the season in a tandem with Opening Day starter James González... González was promoted on May 8, so Myers made the next four starts without a piggybacker... has since pitched in tandems with Chen Zhang-Ao Zhuang, Grant Judkins and Wander Guante... notable splits:

Respect: Mitch posted the No. 3 score in the world in the video game *Monkey Ball*... he is also considered the top chess player in the Lugnuts' clubhouse.

Hometown Hero: Hometown of Lanett's motto is "The Gateway to Alabama," since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

The Buc Starts Here: Initially committed to University of Alabama, but coach instability led to Mitch joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... as a freshman: 5-6, 4.28, 2 CG, 73 2/3, 35 BB, 62 K, 1 HR... as a sophomore: 7-2, 3.29, 3 CG, 79 1/3, 23 BB, 88 K, 3 HR... became one of 10 Bucs to sign on with a D-I program (not including Ryan Gusto, who was drafted in the 11th round by the Astros).

Onward to Pitt: Upon transferring to Pittsburgh, made four starts in 2020 (2-2, 3.52, 23 IP, 4 BB, 30 K, 0 HR) before the season was shut down, with 10 strikeouts in six shutout innings vs. Lehigh... followed in 2021 as Pitt's Friday starter: 13 GS, 5-5, 3.21, 1 CG, 81 1/3, 23 BB, team-leading 83 K, 6 HR... tossed 9-IP CG at Virginia, 3/20/21, allowing three hits, one run, and whiffing five... the last Pitt Panther to appear in a game for the Nuts before Myers was also the only other Panther to play for the Nuts: T.J. Zeuch (pronounced "Zoyk"), the 21st pick in the 2016 draft, who made two starts in the Midwest League for Lansing in 2016.

2022 Professional Debut: After signing for \$125,000 as the Athletics' 12th-round selection in 2021, did not appear in a Minor League game until 2022, spent entirely with Stockton... led Ports in starts (22, six more than the closest teammate), innings (124 1/3, 28 1/3 more innings than the closest teammate), and double plays (10)... worked seven innings five times, 6 2/3 innings once, 6 1/3 innings twice, and six innings four times: 12 starts of 22 starts lasting at least six innings... struggled in 12 games, 11 starts, at home (7.11 ERA, .304 avg, 16 HR, in 57 innings) compared to 11 starts on the road (4.14 ERA, .269, 10 HR in 67 1/3 innings)... lefties and righties hit nearly identically: .286/.355/.536 for lefties, .285/.339/.525 for righties, though righties hit 17 of the 26 home runs allowed... struggled mightily in first innings, allowing .353/.402/.627 slash line and six home runs... opposing base stealers swiped 10 bases in 16 attempts.

2023 with the Lugnuts: Opened season as the Nuts' Wednesday starter... tossed first quality start of the year on April 27, allowing two runs (both in the 5th) in six innings vs. Quad Cities April 27... followed up with a second quality start on May 4 vs. Dayton, though he once again received a no-decision... struck on the back of the head by a line drive against Peoria on June 13 and spent two weeks on the Injured List, missing his scheduled start at Wisconsin before returning to action at Great Lakes on July 3... tossed another quality start (6 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 0 BB, 6 K) against Quad Cities on July 27.
