Lansing scored three runs in the first two innings and added two more in the seventh on a home run by Cobie Vance. Lake County's runs came on a third-inning RBI single by Joe Naranjo and a fourth-inning RBI infield single by Quentin Holmes. Captains starter Hunter Gaddis bounced back to hold Lansing to three runs, two earned, over six innings, but took the loss.

**PLAYOFF PICTURE:** The Captains enter today one game behind the Great Lakes Loons and Cedar Rapids Kernels for the second playoff spot in the High-A Central League (HAC). Lake County, Great Lakes, Cedar Rapids Kernels and the Dayton Dragons are all separated by just 2.0 games. The Quad Cities River Bandits currently hold the top playoff spot and are 11 games ahead of Great Lakes and Cedar Rapids. The top two teams in the HAC earn playoff bids (regardless of division).

**LIMITING DAMAGE:** Since July 1, the Captains have the second-best ERA (3.91) in the High-A Central League (HAC), despite allowing the most home runs (47).

**GETTING ON:** Since July 1, the Captains are second in the High-A Central League (HAC) in on-base percentage (.340) and have worked the most walks (141). From May through June, the Captains were last in the league in walks (167) and third from the bottom in OBP (.320).

VALERA RAKES AND TAKES: George Valera is 5-for-17 with three homers and five walks in August. He is hitting .294/.480/.824 (1.304 OPS) this month. Since July 1, Valera has more walks (30) than strikeouts (29) and a 22.4 BB% (up from 11.1 in May-June).

ALL OR NOTHING: José Tena has a team-best 23 multi-hit games, compared to 24 one-hit games and 25 zero-hit games. 68.4% of Tena's hits have come in multi-hit games (54 of 79). He is hitting .587 (54-for-92) in multi-hit games and .133 (25-for-188) in all other contests.

HOME COOKIN' TASTES BETTER: The Captains are 22-13 at home, compared to 22-26 on the road. Captains pitchers have experienced the biggest home/road disparity. Lake County has a 3.79 ERA at Classic Park and a 4.58 ERA on the road.

ALUMNI UPDATE: 2017 Captains RHP Justin Garza became the 102nd former Captain to reach the major leagues when he debuted for Cleveland on June 27. A record 10 former Captains have made their major league debuts this year – OF Ka'ai Tom (2016), RHP Luis Oviedo (2018-19), LHP Sam Hentges (2016), RHP Louis Head (2012-13), RHP Nick Sandlin (2018), INF Ivan Castillo (2014), Jean Carlos Mejia (2018), RHP Eli Morgan (2018), INF Ernie Clement (2018) and Garza. That breaks the record for the most former Captains to debut in a single year, besting the nine alumni that debuted in 2013 and 2016.

HIGH-A: The 2021 season marks the Captains' first as the High-A Affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. Lake County had been Cleveland's Low-A Affiliate for 17 seasons (2003-2019) and 18 years (2003-2020).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Hickman picked up his third straight win after holding Dayton to one run over five innings last Sunday at Dayton. The right-hander surrendered a solo homer to Mariel Bautista in the third, and otherwise allowed just two singles. The Captains beat the Dragons, 7-2.

**COLLEGE ACCOLADES:** Hickman was named a Preseason All-American by *Collegiate Game*, and Second Team Preseason All-America by *Perfect Game* before the shortened 2020 season.

**2020 DRAFT:** Cleveland selected Hickman in the fifth round (154<sup>th</sup> overall) of the 2020 draft, which was shortened to five rounds. This was considered a bit of a steal by some outlets with both *Perfect Game* and *Baseball America* ranking Hickman as the 65<sup>th</sup> best draft prospect entering the draft.

COLLEGE WORLD SERIES CLINCHER: Hickman's shining moment at Vanderbilt came in 2019 as he helped lead the Commodores to their second National Championship in school history. In the series clinching win, Hickman started for Vanderbilt tossing six strong innings, allowing just one run while fanning 10 Wolverines in the 8-2 win. He also started in the CWS semifinals against Louisville throwing six scoreless frames and surrendering just two hits with three strikeouts. In four total NCAA Tournament starts he went 2-0 with a 1.57 ERA in 23 innings.

**CAPTAINS AND VANDY**: Hickman is just the second Captain ever to come out Vanderbilt. The first and only other Commodore to come to Lake County was catcher on the 2003 Captains and Lake County Manager in 2012, David Wallace.

**STAFF LEADER:** In 2019 Hickman found himself starting 2019 out of the bullpen despite being the teams Sunday starter as a freshman, appearing out of the bullpen three times in 2018. After coming out of the pen in his first six appearances of 2019 with a 2.50 ERA Hickman rejoined the rotation and thrived. He finished the year with a 2.05 ERA to lead the team and finish 4th in the SEC.

**COACHES WORDS:** Hickman worked with Tim Corbin at Vanderbilt who has built a powerhouse in Nashville churning out top baseball talent. In recent years Walker Buehler, Sonny Gray and David Price among others have all starred in the big leagues after pitching for Vandy. Corbin says "Mason has turned into one of the most dependable and reliable starting pitchers that we have had in our program. He continues to develop and get better as his craft while taking on a leadership role on our pitching staff. He is a quality young man that excels in the classroom as well. Very competitive in everything that he does."

**STRIKEOUT BUMP:** After striking out just eight batters per nine innings as a freshman in Nashville, Hickman saw an increase in whiffs towards the end of his sophomore season. In his final six starts of the season he struck out nine or more batters five times. He finished 2019 with 129 strikeouts to finish 13th in the country and struck out 12 per nine innings.

PROFESSIONAL STAFF: The teammates Hickman worked with at Vanderbilt have been highly regarded around baseball. Pitchers that Hickman joined in the clubhouse that have recently been drafted include Tyler Brown (2020, HOU), Jake Eder (2020, MIA), Drake Fellows (2019, SD), Zach King (2019, MIA), Jackson Gillis (2019, MIL), Joe Gobillot (2019, TB), AJ Franklin (2019, KC), Patrick Raby (2019, CIN), Maddux Conger (2018, DET) and Justin Wilson (2018, NYY). In 2021, Commodores Kumar Rocker and Jack Leiter are both expected to be first round draft picks in 2021 and were teammates of Hickman's in 2019 and 2020. Vanderbilt has also had 12 position players since 2018.
