### PITCHING DUAL ENDS WITH MISSIONS VICTORY ON THURSDAY:

The Frisco RoughRiders mounted a ninth-inning comeback rally on Thursday night, but fell just short in a 3-2 loss to the San Antonio Missions from Nelson W. Wolff Municipal Stadium. Following walks for **Scott Kapers** and **Liam Hicks**, **Luisangel Acuña's** third hit of the game plated a run and put Hicks at third base as the tying score. **Evan Carter** grounded a two-strike pitch right to the first baseman to end the ballgame. **Ryan Garcia** (2-7) had an excellent day on the mound for Frisco, setting a season-high and tying his career-best with nine strikeouts. He gave up just two runs in 5.1 innings with two hits. Garcia went 14 batters without allowing a hit from the second inning until the seventh, giving up just his second hit of the game on a single. He struck out the last man he saw and left with a 1-0 Frisco lead, but was charged with two runs when both runners scored following his departure. **Eudrys Manon** entered in the seventh inning and posted a zero on the board to keep the deficit at 3-1. **Nick Starr** did the same in the eighth. The Riders took a 1-0 lead on a two-out rally in the third inning. Acuña doubled to left center field and came home on Carter's base hit. Carter went 2-for-5 on the evening and has started the series with five hits in nine at-bats. Frisco coaxed seven walks, including a pair by **Trevor Hauver**. Hauver added a single and has reached base seven times this series in his nine plate appearances in San Antonio.

### WELCOME BACK, CARTER:

**Evan Carter** has been fantastic since returning from the Injured List on June 21st against Springfield. Over his last seven games since his return, he has five multi-hit games, batting .481 (13-for-27)/.531/.815/1.346 with one double, one triple, two home runs, eight RBIs and seven runs scored. Carter is now seventh in the Texas League in batting average (.305), fourth in OBP (.422) and eighth in OPS (.869).

### TO HAVU AND TO HOLD:

**Trevor Hauver** has been one of the best hitters for the RoughRiders recently. He is currently riding a nine-game hitting streak, batting .387 (12-for-31)/.537/.548/1.085 with two doubles, one home run, four RBIs, seven runs scored, 10 walks and a steal.

### RISP-ECT THIS:

This season, the Riders are just seventh in the 10-team Texas League in batting average with runners in scoring position, hitting .256, though Frisco is fourth with 278 RBIs with RISP. Over the last 13 games (6-7 record), Frisco is hitting .266 (33-for-124) in those situations.

### THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

**Thomas Saggese** has been incredible for the RoughRiders on offense. He had a 15-game hitting streak ended on Thursday. In that streak, Saggese hit .443 (27-for-61)/.507/.803/1.310 with five doubles, five home runs, 17 RBIs, eight walks, 13 runs scored and a steal. Among those who have played at least 50 games, Saggese is first on the team with a .308 batting average, 10 homers, 54 RBIs, 47 runs scored (tied with Acuña) and .867 OPS. For his efforts against Springfield, Saggese was named the Texas League Player of the Week, hitting .591 (13-for-22)/.654/.955/1.609 with three doubles, one triple, one home run, seven RBIs, seven runs scored and four walks.

### AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

**Thomas Saggese** has been fantastic on first pitches this season, second in the Texas League with a .565 average (13-for-23) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.540 OPS on the first pitch, which is second in the league as well. **Luisangel Acuña** has also been great, hitting .449 (22-for-49) on the initial offering while his 22 hits on the first pitch lead the league and are second in the minors.

### SPEED KILLS:

**Luisangel Acuña** leads the league in steals with 32 and is on pace for a career-best 63 swipes. The RoughRiders are second in Texas League steals with 102 bases in 121 attempts (86 percent).

### ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season on last Friday. They are one of two teams with seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (2)).

### ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire at the plate. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .301 (81-for-269)/.360/.442/.802 through the first 62 games. In June, Acuña is hitting .300/.336/.460/.796. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (113).

### WALK THIS WAY:

On the season, Frisco's 348 walks are first among Texas League teams while their .355 team OBP is tied for second in the Texas League. **Dustin Harris** is still first in the league with 44 walks despite being promoted to Triple-A Round Rock last Tuesday.

### ABOUT JACK

-Leiter was drafted in the first round (No. 2 overall) in 2021 by the Rangers out of Vanderbilt University. With the Commodores, Leiter was a unanimous First Team All-American and a finalist for both the Golden Spikes Award and the Dick Howser Trophy.

-Threw first regular-season, complete-game no-hitter to start SEC play since 1971 against No. 16 South Carolina on March 20th, 2021. He walked the first batter of the game before retiring the last 27 he saw with 16 strikeouts on 124 pitches. Followed up that no-hitter with 7.0 no-hit innings in his next start (20.2 consecutive no-hit innings over three starts from March 20th - April 2nd).

-Drafted in 20th round in 2019 by NYY out of Delbarton School (NJ). Named 2019 New Jersey Gatorade POY, striking out 95 in 57 innings as a senior.

-The family lineage is strong with Jack. His father, Al, pitched in 19 MLB seasons (1987-2005), making two All-Star teams and winning both the 1993 and 1997 World Series. His uncle, Mark, played 11 seasons in the majors (1990-99; 2001) and his cousin, Mark Jr., pitched two seasons (2017-2018) with Philadelphia and Toronto. Al now works as an analyst for MLB Network.

### 2023 SEASON

-Leiter entered the 2023 season as the No. 78 prospect in baseball according to MLB.com and the No. 5 prospect in the Rangers system.

-Over three starts on May 5th, May 11th and May 17th, Leiter allowed just three earned runs over 17.0 IP (1.59 ERA) while striking out 25 and walking five.

### 2022 SEASON

-Leiter entered the 2022 season as the No. 17 prospect in baseball according to MLB.com and the No. 1 prospect in the Rangers system.

-Leiter dazzled in his professional debut, striking out seven over his three innings against the Arkansas Travelers on April 9th. The righty helped draw the largest crowd since 2019 at Riders Field for the debut (9,322).

-Threw the Riders first quality start of the season on May 7th against Arkansas. Leiter retired the last 15 batters he saw, allowing just two hits (one in the first and one in the second inning).

-Leiter came out of the bullpen as a "start" to finish a suspended game on May 31st (game was finished on June 1st) and recorded a career-best eight strikeouts against Wichita over 5.2 innings. The game resulted in a 3-0 win for Frisco, the Riders second shutout win of the season to that point.

-The righty allowed just one home run over his first nine outings before allowing two against Amarillo on June 7th. The two home runs were a grand slam and a two-run shot in a 7-4 loss to the Sod Poodles.

-Leiter was placed on the Development List on June 28th and was activated on July 10th before his start against San Antonio.

-Pitched a 1-2-3 inning on nine pitches in The SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game from Dodger Stadium on July 16th.

### 2021 SEASON

-After being drafted second overall in the 2021 draft, Leiter did not pitch in the minor leagues. Instead, he returned to Vanderbilt to workout, continue college and prepare for 2022. Did not finish degree, but got closer.

### MORE INFO

-Leiter was high school teammates with Yankees No. 1 prospect (No. 8 in baseball) Anthony Volpe at Delbarton School (NJ).
