About the Last One: In game one of the Double-A Northeast League Championship Series on Tuesday night,

Bowie recorded their first and only hit on a home run five pitches into the game. Bowie jumped out to the early lead off **Jordan Westburg's** leadoff home run, but Akron starter **Peyton Battenfield** dominated the rest of the way, walking none and striking out 10 over his seven innings. **Bryan Lavasitda** homered to put Akron in front in the fourth, and the RubberDucks added three more in the seventh.

Title Time: For the third time in franchise history, and for the second consecutive season, the Bowie Baysox are playing in the Championship Series. Bowie won their first Eastern League title in 2015, defeating Reading in five games. In 2019, the last minor league season that was played, Bowie fell to the Trenton Thunder, then the Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees.

Rodriguez on the Rubber: Making the start in game two for Bowie will be the No. 1 pitching prospect in baseball, right-hander **Grayson Rodriguez**. He has only allowed one run over his last 13 innings and has not walked a batter in his last two starts, while striking out a combined 10 batters in eight innings. Rodriguez has made three starts against Akron this summer, including his first start at Prince George's Stadium on June 15th. He allowed two runs in each of his first two starts against the RubberDucks, going 4.2 innings and 5.0 innings respectively. In his third start, on July 3rd, he allowed three runs, only one of which was earned, on five hits with no walks and three strikeouts. For more information on Rodriguez, see page two.

In the Other Corner: Looking to take a 2-0 lead in the series, Akron will start rightly **Xzavion Curry** on Wednesday night. Drafted in the seventh round by the Cleveland Indians in 2019 out of Georgia Tech, this will only be Curry's second Double-A start. In his first, last Thursday against the Somerset Patriots, Curry threw 4.2 innings and allowed two runs (two solo home runs), six hits, and no walks, to go along with five strikeouts. He began his season with Low-A Lynchburg where he made five starts and had a 1.07 ERA with a 3-0 record before earning a promotion to High-A Lake county. With the Captains, he made 13 starts and put together a 5-1 record with a 2.66 ERA. Curry did not make his professional debut until this year, as he was injured for a large portion of the 2019 season.

This Day in Baysox History: This is the latest the Bowie Baysox have ever played a game in team history.
