### JUMBO SHRIMP DOUBLE UP REDBIRDS 6-3

Edward Cabrera pitched 5.0 shutout innings and Willians Astudillo laced three hits, including a home run, in Sunday's 6-3 win for Jacksonville at Memphis. Lewin Díaz opened up the scoring with a two-run double in the third inning. Devin Hairston registered a sacrifice fly in the fourth before Astudillo's solo shot made it 4-0 in the sixth. After a Memphis run in the sixth, Díaz lifted a sacrifice fly in the seventh to grab the run back. A Peyton Burdick RBI double in the ninth put the margin at 6-1 before two Redbirds runs in the bottom of the ninth got things to 6-3.

### CHARLES LE MAGNIFIQUE

Charles Leblanc has reached base in 14 consecutive games (12-for-56, .375/.417/.554/.971, 4 2B, 2 HR, 12 RBIs, 7 R), tied for the longest active streak in the International League. On the season, the Laval, Quebic City native has reached base safely in 23 of his 25 games this year, with multiple trips on in 14 of those contests. On the season, Leblanc ranks first in the International League in batting average (1.064), second in batting average (1.374), fourth in OBP (1.438), tied for fourth in hits (37), tied for sixth in RBIs (23), seventh in slugging (1.626) and tied for 10th in home runs (6) Among the 132 qualified hitters in the circuit, Leblanc leads the league in both wOBA (1.462) and wRC+ (183).

### SIX & DIF

Heading into play on Tuesday, Jacksonville has scored at least six runs in 14 of their last 22 games, and 16 of the club's 30 contests (53.3 percent) this year. In 2021, the Jumbo Shrimp mustered at least six tallied in only 48 of their 130 games (36.9 percent). When scoring at least six runs this year, Jacksonville is 14-2 (.875).

### ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS

Jacksonville boasts an impressive 12-6 record on the road thus far in 2022, marking one of just two teams in the International League East with a winning record away from home. Interestingly, the Jumbo Shrimp have hit far better on the road, posting a team batting line of .299/.368/.516. The club's resulting .884 OPS places second in Triple-A. When playing at 121 Financial Ballpark, Jacksonville is hitting .241/.336/.384, with the club's .720 OPS ranking 16th at the Triple-A level.

### **BLEDAY OF THE DEAD**

Over the season's first 18 games, Jacksonville outfielder JJ Bleday struggled, going just 10-for-63 at the plate with two doubles and two home runs for a measly batting line of .159/.321/.286/.607. However, over the last 10 games, Bleday is 14-for-37 with three doubles and four home runs, slashing .378/.489/.784/1.273. Prior to an 0-for-4 showing on Sunday, Bleday had collected a hit in nine consecutive games.

### THE CHICKS DIG IT

Jacksonville has popped 43 home runs thus far in 2022, ranking fourth in the International League. The home run power the Jumbo Shrimp have shown has been a rarity for teams on the First Coast in recent years; no Jacksonville team has finished outside the bottom 10 in either Triple-A (2021) or Double-A (2014-19) in home runs since 2013, when the Jacksonville Suns bashed 104 bombs to place 14th in Double-A. In fact, the last time a Jacksonville club ranked in the top 10 of its level in long balls was 2009, when the Suns cracked 110 homers. The Jumbo Shrimp have blasted at least one home run in 11 consecutive games entering play on Tuesday; the club's longest streak in 2021 was just eight games.

### THIS CUBAN IS CRUSHING MISSILES

Over his last 14 games, **Lorenzo Quintana** has gone 21-for-61 at the plate, slashing .344/.403/.738/1.141 with six doubles, six home runs, 18 RBIs and 14 runs scored. This hot stretch has pushed Quintana up the International League leaderboards on the season; the native of Pinar del Rio in Cuba ranks in the top 20 of the league in slugging (6th; .626), OPS (7th; .990), home runs (T-8th; 7), RBIs (T-9th; 22), extra-base hits (T-9th; 14), hits (T-14th; 29) and batting average (T-14th; .319). Of the 132 qualified hitters in the International League, Quintana has posted the seventh-lowest strikeout rate (12.1%). He places ninth in both wOBA (.424) and wRC+ (158).

### SHRIMP SPECK

**Peyton Burdick** has reached base in 14 consecutive games dating back to April 20. However, during this span, he is just 11-for-53 at the plate (.208/.333/.434/.767, 4 2B, 3B, 2 HR, 6 RBIs).

### **ABOUT MATTHEW**

-It took Kent until his third season at Texas A&M University to move into the Aggies' starting rotation. He totaled six starts out of 45 total appearances between his freshman and sophomore years in 2013-14. In 2015, the left-hander started 14 games out of his 19 appearances, going 9-1 with a 2.76 ERA (98.0 IP, 103 H, 12 BB, 84 K). That performance helped convince the Boston Red Sox to select Kent in the 13th round of the 2015 draft.

-After six seasons in the Red Sox organization, Kent elected free agency on November 7, 2021. Less than a month later, on December 3, 2021, he inked a minor league deal with the Miami Marlins.

### 2022 SEASON

### 2021 SEASON

-Kent started just three games out of 27 appearances in 2021. In his previous four campaigns, he started all but eight of his 112 outings.

-The southpaw held left-handed hitters to a .161 average and .450 OPS in 56 at-bats. However, over 178 at-bats, righties batted .315 with an .823 OPS against him.

-Kent struggled pitching with runners on base. With Double-A Portland and the bases empty, opponents recorded a ..256 average and 674 OPS in 133 at-bats. In comparison, with runners on, opposing hitters hit .307 with a .809 OPS in 101 at-bats.

### 2019 SEASON

-Kent still had platoon splits in 2019, but far less pronounced than he would experience in 2021. In Double-A, opposing right-handed hitters posted a .755 OPS against him in 294 atbats compared to a .629 OPS for left-handed batters in 187 at-bats.

### 2018 SEASON

-Over 170 at-bats while Kent pitched for Double-A Portland, left-handed hitters collected a .650 OPS. In comparison, right-handed batters registered a .723 mark in 387 at-bats.

### **ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES**

-An outstanding hitter in addition to his pitching provess at Midway High School in Waco, Texas, Kent went 10-1 with a 0.63 ERA and 122 strikeouts in 66.2 innings pitched as a senior while also batting .421 with 24 extra-base hits. In the district playoffs, he tossed three consecutive no-hitters.
