#### JUMBO SHRIMP FALL 7-1

Worcester blitzed Jacksonville early on Friday in a 7-1 Jumbo Shrimp defeat from VyStar Ballpark. Marcelo Mayer doubled two runs in during a three-run first inning and then the WooSox added in three more tallies in the third. In the fifth, Abraham Toro's RBI double made it 7-0. Jacksonville's only run came home in the bottom of the sixth when Agustín Ramírez scored on Troy Johnston's RBI single. The Jumbo Shrimp bullpen yielded only one run on three hits in 6.1 innings of work, combining to strike out nine against three walks.

#### MAXIMO OVERDRIVE

Jumbo Shrimp infielder **Maximo Acosta** is off to an absurd start to the 2025 season. In seven games thus far, the native of Caracas, Venezuela has recorded four multi-hit contests and two multi-RBI affairs. Acosta is 10-for-30 in total at the plate, slashing .333/.394/.467/.861 with one double, one home run, six RBIs, three walks, four runs scored and two stolen bases. He ranks in a tie for fourth in the International League in hits (10) and tied for 14th in RBIs (6).

#### BOOM OR BUST

With little in-between thus far in 2025, Jacksonville's offense has either been extraordinary or has really struggled depending on the game. In two of their seven contests thus far, the Jumbo Shrimp have plated double-digit runs - something they accomplished only 10 times in 149 games last season. However, in their other five contests, Jacksonville has plated a total of nine runs.

#### **DE LOS SANTOS CLAUS**

Jumbo Shrimp infielder **Deyvison De Los Santos** is coming off a monster 2024 season while playing for Jacksonville, Triple-A Reno and Double-A Amarillo. The 21-year-old native of Santo Domingo in the Dominican Republic led all of Minor League Baseball in home runs (40), RBIs (120) and total bases (307). He also ranked in the top 20 in the minor leagues in hits (2nd, 158), extra-base hits (T-2nd, 67), slugging percentage (5th, .571), OPS (10th, .914) and runs scored (18th, 89). Of the 250 hardest-hit balls in Triple-A during the 2024 season, De Los Santos smacked 11 of them, including a 116.0 mile per hour (10th overall in Triple-A) single while playing for Reno on June 12, 2024.

#### MEN OF STEAL

After failing to steal a base in the 2025 season opener, Jacksonville has recorded multiple stolen bases in five of their last six games. In fact, the Jumbo Shrimp's five stolen bases on March 29 at Nashville was a mark the club has reached only once in the prior two seasons. Jacksonville currently leads the International League with 16 stolen bases. The last time a Jacksonville squad ranked in the top 10 of the league in steals was 2008, when the Suns finished second in the 10-team Southern League with 128 swipes. The Jumbo Shrimp finished 17th, 13th and last (20th) in steals from 2022-24 in each respective season.

#### 'PEN PALS

Through seven games in 2025, Jacksonville starting pitchers have gone only 5.0 innings (and no further) just three times. The club's bullpen has responded to the added responsibility in a huge way. Jumbo Shrimp relief pitching has combined for a 2.04 ERA, the second-best such mark in the International League. The club's bullpen also ranks third in the circuit in batting average against (.152), third in strikeouts (46) and fifth in fewest hits allowed (19). Jumbo Shrimp relievers have combined to toss 35.1 innings through seven games (5.0 per game), fourth-most in the IL.

#### MUSICAL CHAIRS

The 2024 season saw unprecedented player movement in Northeast Florida. Jacksonville set franchise records in their combined Triple-A/Double-A era (1962-present) with 90 players used, including a club-record 51 pitchers. The Jumbo Shrimp also smashed another franchise record with 28 different starting pitchers used during the 2024 campaign.

#### SHRIMP BITES

Jumbo Shrimp relievers have combined to allow just one run in their last 17.1 innings (0.52 ERA) dating back to the sixth inning on Tuesday... Jacksonville not only leads all of IL in stolen bases, but the club's 94.1 success rate ranks third. The two teams ahead of them in success rate, Omaha and Syracuse, have combined for only 17 steals... The Jumbo Shrimp rank second in the league in ERA at 2.70, just 0.01 shy of Nashville for the IL lead. Jacksonville has yielded three runs or fewer in four of the club's seven games thus far in 2025.

#### ABOUT FREDDY

- -A two-way player at Riverview High School (Fla.), Tarnok went 7–0 with a 0.66 ERA while also batting .393. He was selected by the Braves in the third round, signing with Atlanta to bypass a commitment to the University of Tampa.
- -Tarnok made his major league debut for the Braves on August 17, 2022, pitching 0.2 scoreless innings in a 9-7 loss to the New York Mets in Atlanta. His first big league strikeout came at the expense of Tyler Naquin.
- -On December 12, 2022, the Oakland Athletics acquired Tarnok from the Braves in a three-team trade in which the Atlanta Braves received Sean Murphy, the Milwaukee Brewers acquired William Contreras, Joel Payamps, and Justin Yeager, and the Athletics also acquired Manny Piña, Kyle Muller, Esteury Ruiz, and Royber Salinas.
- -The Philadelphia Phillies claimed Tarnok off waivers on June 1, 2024. Following the 2024 season, he signed a minor league contract with the Miami Marlins.

#### 2024 SEASON

-In seven starts, Tarnok was 0-2 with a 3.65 ERA (12.1 IP, 13 H, 3 BB, 15 K, .283 BAA). However, over 16 relief appearances, he posted an 0-3 record and 9.78 ERA (19.1 IP, 21 H, 17 BB, 21 K, .280 BAA).

#### 2023 SEASON

-Tarnok held left-handed batters to a .192/.276/.269/.545 line in 58 plate appearances compared to a .184/.333/.447/.780 line for right-handed hitters over 93 plate appearances.
