The Fightin Phils begin a six-game series tonight at the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox. It is the 19th-of-21 matchups between the teams this season and seventh-of-nine in Reading. Portland leads the season-series 11-6 over Reading, alreading clinching a victory in the season series.

## Wilson a Walk Off Winner

The Fightin Phils finished their final game before the All-Star Break on a very high note. Reading jumped out to a 4-0 lead thanks to two-run home runs from Otto Kemp and Robert Moore. Matt Osterberg was spectacular on the mound, going six-shutout innings, with five strikeouts. He ultimately earned a no-decision as Efrain Contreras and Carlos Francisco combined to allow five runs in the top of the seventh, to make it 5-4, Akron. Baron Radcliff hit a game-tying home run in the bottom of the seventh to even the score at five. Daniel Harper entered in the top of the ninth and allowe a home run to Aaron Bracho, making it 6-5 Akron. Reading came back in the bottom of the ninth thanks to a game-tying double from Baron Radcliff and then a walk off single over the head of the Akron center fielder from Ethan Wilson. It was Reading's second walk off win of the season and first sine May 8. Akron won the series ultimatelty 4-2.

Fightin Phils pitching set a new season-high with 16-straight scoreless innings from the top of the ninth onf Friday, July 12 through the top of the seventh inning on Sunday, July 14. It was led by seven-shutout innings from Lachlan Wells last Saturday night and then six-scoreless frames on Suday evening form Matt Osterberg.

### **Bombs Away**

Since June 1, the Fightin Phils lead the Eastern League in home runs hit at 51. That recent surge has propelled the Fightin Phils to second in the Eastern League in home runs with 93. They trail Somerset by three and are ahead of third-place Erie by 12. That stretch featured a team-best home runs in 13-straight games from June 13-28, which tied a mark set by the 2016 Fightin Phils. Currently, Reading has homed in 10-straight games, dating back to July 3. The Fightin Phils  $have also \ hit the \ most \ home \ runs \ in \ home \ games \ in \ Double-A \ this \ season \ with \ 71 \ (1.4/game). \ That \ mark \ ranks \ tied \ for \ fifth \ in \ all \ of \ Minor \ League \ Baseball.$ 

Otto Kemp finished last week's series at Akron on a high note with a home run, as he had two long balls on the week. Since his call-up from High-A Jersey Shore on June 11, Kemp is tied for the Eastern League lead in home runs with seven. He also ranks tied for sixth in RBI and eighth in OPS over that span.

After a recent slow stretch, Carson Taylor has picked up where he had been for most of the season this week. Over five games last week, Taylor is slashing .375/.474/.625, with a 1.099 OPS. He's added three runs, a double, home run and three RBI. He's also walked three times and not struck out once.

### Newcomers on the Block

The Phillies announced roster moves ahead of this weekend's series in Portland. Pitchers Eiberson Castellano and Andrew Walling are joining the Fightin Phils, while infielder Erick Brito joins the mix as well. Outfielder Leandro Pineda was also called up from High-A Jersey Shore. Most notably, Phillies No. 2 Prospect Justin Crawford was called up to Reading and will make his R-Phils debut this weekend in Portland after playing in last weekend's Futures' Game in Texas.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

Portland enters tonight after finishing in third place in the Eastern League's Northeast Division for the first half with a 36-33 record. They are second in the Northeast Division with a 10-6 record in the second half of the season. Portland most recently took three-of-six on the road at Hartford. Following this week, Portland heads to Somerset. Portland's roster features nine players ranked amongst the Boston Red Sox top-30 prospects: Marcelo Mayer (1), Roman Anthony (2), Kyle Teel (3), Wikelman Gonzalez (5), Blaze Jordan (19), Eddinson Paulino (22), Hunter Dobbins (25), Angel Bastardo (26) and Kristian Campbell (30).

### Portland Pitcher

Righty Isaac Coffey makes the start tonightr for Portland. This season, Coffey is 6-2, with a 3.71 ERA over 15 games and 12 starts. He's pitched 68 innings, allowed 57 hits, walked 37 and struck out 78 hitters. He last pitched on July 13 at Hartford and took the win, allowing no runs on three hits, with six strikeouts over five innings pitched. This is the fifth appeaance for Coffey against Reading this season. He is 1-1, with a 3.50 ERA over 18 innings pitched, with 20 strikeouts and nine walks. Coffey spent last season between High-A Greenville and Portland, combining to go 11-6, wit a 3.37 ERA over 23 games and 22 starts. The Red Sox took the 24-year old in the 10th round of the 2022 draft out of Oral Roberts.
