**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** After dropping three games in a row for the first time all season, the FredNats make their final voyage to Historic Grainger Stadium in Kinston, N.C. to take on the Down East Wood Ducks, Single-A affiliate of the Texas Rangers. Fredericksburg makes its only trip to Kinston this year and begins its second series of the season against the Wood Ducks. FXBG beat Down East four games to two in the first series of the year at the beginning of the month at home. Heading into play today, Fredericksburg is still tied with Carolina for first place in the Carolina League North Division, and Down East is 2.5 games back with 21 games to play in the half. Nine of FXBG's final 21 games in the half are against the Wood Ducks, as DE returns to Fredericksburg for the final three games of the half as well. RHP Bryan Sanchez starts the series opener tonight for FXBG after giving up six runs in just three innings when facing the Wood Ducks the first time around. Down East does not have a video broadcast, so the only live broadcast of this week's series is on the radio on the FredNats Baseball Network. This is FXBG's last scheduled trip to Historic Grainger Stadium before it closes after this year and DE moves to Spartanburg, S.C.

**ABOUT LAST WEEK:** Fredericksburg won two out of the first three games at home during the build-up to Memorial Day against the Lynchburg Hillcats, but lost all three games at home on the weekend to fall back 27-18 and suffer the first series loss of the season. In the final two games of the series combined, the Freddie's went 6-for-32 with runners in scoring position and stranded a combined 26 runners on base. Saturday's 12-inning loss was also the longest game in the pitch clock era of FredNat baseball.

**BULLPEN WORK:** So far in 2024, the FredNat bullpen has been one of the best units in all of Minor League Baseball. So far this season, the bullpen has pitched 240.1 innings this year and allowed just 70 earned runs for a group ERA of 2626. The Freddie's are also 13/14 in save opportunities, and Thomas Schultz is tied for first in all of Minor League Baseball with eight saves. The unit also worked out of major trouble a bunch on the last trip. The first five wins of the last road trip, the opposing team has had the tying and/or go-ahead runs on base in the 9th inning, and FXBG's bullpen has slammed the door each time. Fredericksburg remains undefeated when leading after 7 (21-0), and 8 (23-0) innings after taking the lead in the 7th inning last night and not giving it up.

**NO GRAY MAY:** Roismar Quintana's emergence in the middle of this Fredericksburg order has been a huge key to success for FXBG in this month of May. This month, Quintana is slashing .318/.384/.530 for an OPS of .914, and his wRC+ is 162 (100 is average). Quintana's wOBA, which is a key advanced metric that measures how a hitter reaches base, is .426 this month (.320 is average).

**HE GONE:** Prior to today's game, infielder Gavin Dugas was promoted to High-A Wilmington. He becomes the third FredNat to get the call to High-A this year after playing significant time for FXBG. In 27 games with the FredNats, Dugas slashed .340/.438/.524 for an OPS of .962. The Nats' sixth round draft pick out of LSU had a wRC+ of 179 (100 is average), and a wOBA of .456 (around .320 is average) for FXBG.

**RBI KING:** Brandon Pimentel continues to tie for the lead in all of Minor League Baseball Double-A and below in RBI with 46 after he drove in three more runs last series. This year, Pimentel is hitting .411 with runners in scoring position, and is 10-for-19 (.526) with runners in scoring position and two outs. Pimentel continues to be one of the best situational hitters in all of MiLB.

**FORMULA FOR SUCCESS:** The FredNats are 20-2 this season when scoring first, including 17 out of the last 18 wins. Fredericksburg's only two losses this year when scoring first both came in the last road trip against Charleston. FXBG did not score first in any of its losses last week to the Hillcats.

**THE SKIP IS BACK:** The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 168-137 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

**THE STAFF:** The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freleigh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Alabama native and Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prairie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI).

**TONIGHT'S START:** Bryan Sanchez is making his eighth start of the 2024 season tonight for the Fredericksburg Nationals. Signed by Washington out of the Dominican Republic in 2018, Sanchez got his first taste of professional baseball in the Dominican Summer League in 2019.

After missing 2021, Sanchez came stateside for the first time in 2022, and impressed in the GCL with a 3.79 ERA across nine appearances (eight starts).

That earned him a spot on the Opening Day roster for the FredNats last season, where he split time evenly between starting and coming out of the bullpen. Bryan began the year as a reliever, with six appearances from April into early May. But after some reshuffling, Sanchez moved into the starting rotation. He excelled in that role, allowing one run or fewer in four of his six starts before ultimately being shelved for the year due to injury in mid-June.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Sanchez was his own worst enemy last week, as he walked four Lynchburg Hillcats and hit another. However, he managed to limit them to just three hits and a pair of earned runs over four innings.
