LAST TIME OUT

MOOSIC, PA (September 4, 2026) - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders defeated the Lehigh Valley IronPigs 9-2 Friday night at PNC Field. The RailRiders fell behind early, but took a second-inning lead they would not relinquish. It marks their fourth straight victory over Lehigh Valley and now a share of first place in the International League standings.

The IronPigs jumped out to an early lead in the top of the first. Christian Cairo and Keaton Anthony homered off Yankees #13 Prospect Kyle Carr, giving Lehigh Valley a 2-0 edge. With two outs, Carter Kieboom was tagged out at home by J.C. Escarra on a frozen rope from center fielder Jarred Kelenick, limiting the damage.

Scranton/Wilkes-Barre drove in six runs in the bottom of the second, recording a season-high for hits in an inning, to take the lead. Oswaldo Cabrera led off with a bunt single, and back-to-back RBI doubles from Yanquiel Fernández and Ernesto Martínez Jr. tied the game at two. Later in the frame, Anthony Volpe smashed his 11th homer of the year to put Scranton/Wilkes-Barre ahead 4-2. After a pair of singles from Jasson Dominguez and Escarra, Marco Luciano and Cabrera each laced RBI singles to complete the eight-hit, six-run outburst. The RailRiders extended the advantage in the bottom of the sixth. Volpe doubled and Dominguez singled, before an Escarra sacrifice fly plated the seventh run to give SWB a five-run cushion. Kelenick lifted his first homer as a RailRider in the bottom of the seventh, becoming the 30th Scranton/Wilkes-Barre player to homer this season. His two-run blast to right-center field scored Schuemann for a 9-2 lead.

Carr allowed two runs on five hits in 2.1 innings of work. Hayden Merda (1-0) struck out a season-high six batters in 2.2 innings for the win. Zach Messinger and Eric Reyzelman each pitched two scoreless frames in relief. Brian Keller (1-5) started for the IronPigs, surrendering six runs on 11 hits over 2.2 frames in the loss.

NEWS & NOTES

ATOP THE LEAGUE - After four consecutive wins, the RailRiders move tied for first with Rochester atop the International League. They are now one games in front of third place Indianapolis. The RailRiders are 7-3 in their last ten games, are eleven contests above .500 on the full season. Lehigh Valley is seven and a half games out of first place and have gone 2-8 in their last ten contests.

VOLPE'S VALUE - Anthony Volpe homered yesterday to help lift the RailRiders to victory. It was his third of the series and fifth in six contests. In four games this week, Volpe is hitting .692 with nine hits and seven runs scored. He has also stolen three bags. The 25-year-old has hit .299 since returning to the RailRiders in 25 games since August 7.

AGAINST KING - SWB has faced off against IronPigs starter Chuck King three times already this summer. The RailRiders have lost two those contests. The team holds a .233 average against King, going just 14-for-60. Only Oswaldo Cabrera has hit a homer off the righty arm.

OFFENSIVE PROWESS - Scranton/Wilkes-Barre had base runners in every inning, and every batter in the lineup reached safely as five RailRiders recorded multiple hits. Over the last three games, SWB has outscored Lehigh Valley 38-7, torching the Pigs for 54 hits.

HOMER HEAVEN - The RailRiders smacked two more homers last night to total 194 on the season. Jarred Kelenick had his first with the team and Anthony Volpe had his eleventh of the summer. The team currently holds the second most in Triple-A, behind the league leading Saints with 239. Fernández has the most tallying 24 on the summer, a dozen hitters have double digits, and 30 different players have at least one on the books for the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre.

ELI'S ENERGY - Eli Morgan has now made four scoreless appearances out of the SWB bullpen. In six innings of work, he has walked just two while striking out six. Morgan joins the team from the Kansas City organization where he was playing in Triple-A Omaha. With the Storm Chasers, the righty held a 1.40 ERA in 25.2 frames. With the Royals, he made 16 appearances for a 5.12 ERA.

FROM NEW YORK - Both Yerry De Los Santos and Justin Topa recently joined the RailRiders roster from the Yankees. De Los Santos pitched two scoreless frames while Topa added a clean inning and a third. Yerry has been nothing but stellar in New York's bullpen with a 1.35 ERA in 20 frames. Topa holds a 0.00 ERA for the Yankees before he was designated for assignment and chose to re-sign with the organization.

DUKE'S RECORD PERFORMANCE - Duke Ellis set a new single season record with 47 stolen bases on the season. He broke the record of 44 set by Tommy Barrett in 1989. Barrett did so in 120 games, whereas Ellis marked his in 85 contests. Ellis also holds the franchise record for 88 total with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. The prior record was held by Nick Punto who stole 82 bags in 263 games.

CAREER:

2026: Began the season in Double-A Somerst (6-4, 3.65 ERA, 19 G/15 GS, 0/2S, 14 HR, 41 BB, 114 SO, .176 BAA)...Earned Eastern League Pitcher of the Week honors after his start on 6/16 @POR, when he took a no-hitter into the sixth inning, totaling 5.2 IP with 0 R, 0 H, 2 BB and 8 K...Did not make it out of first inning in Triple-A debut allowing six runs (3 scored after exit) on two hits and four walks in 38 pitches on 8/12 @ LHV...Kyle Carr opened for him on 8/25 & 8/30 @ WOR

2025: Made his professional debut, going 6-4 with a 3.38 ERA (85.1IP, 50H, 35R/32ER, 50BB, 113K, 6HR) in 19 combined appearances (18 starts) with the FCL Yankees, Single-A Tampa and High-A Hudson Valley...posted a 11.9 K/9.0IP while holding opposing batters to a .166 (50-for-302) batting average...ranked eighth among qualified Yankees farmhands in strikeouts...was named the Florida Complex League "Pitcher of the Month" for May after going 1-0 with a 1.15 ERA (15.2IP, 2ER) and 22K over four games (three starts) with the FCL Yankees...was named the South Atlantic Leagues "Pitcher of the Month" for August after going 2-1 with a 1.50 ERA (24.0IP, 8H, 4R/ER, 10BB, 34K, 1HR) in four starts with High-A Hudson Valley...was named the Florida Complex League "Pitcher of the Week" from 5/12-18 after recording eight strikeouts through 4.2 no-hit innings in his start on 5/13 (G2) vs. the FCL Tigers (OR/ER, 1BB,)

2024: After being drafted by the Yankees in 2024, Rivas did not pitch and instead recovered from Tommy John Surgery

SCOUTS SAY: "Rivas doesn't fool hitters with a riding fastball that sits at 90 mph and maxes out at 92, but he utilizes it well enough to set up a pair of baffling secondary pitches. He does an excellent job of killing spin on a low-80s changeup with splitter action that generated a 41 percent chase rate and 57 percent swing-and-miss rate in his pro debut. Hitters also consistently swung over the top of his tight low-80s slider..."

COLLEGE Began his college career at Division II Indianapolis in 2021 and 2022. After serving as the Sunday starter his freshman year (2021), Rivas returned for his sophomore year (2022) with added velocity and went 7-0 with a 2.44 ERA, 0.98 WHIP and 128 K in 80.1 IP en route to D2CCA First Team All-America, Midwest Region Pitcher of the Year and 2022 GLVC Pitcher of the Year honors. That summer of 2022, he pitched in seven games as a starter with the Northwoods League's Wisconsin Rapids Rafter in 2022, tallying a 2.25 ERA and 41 K in 24.0 IP. He then transferred from the Great Lakes Valley Conference to the SEC, with Mississippi. In what ended up being his final college season (2023), Rivas finished fourth in the SEC with 89 K and 10th with 68.0 IP, totaling a 5-5 record and 6.35 ERA. Rivas did not pitch in 2024, after sustaining a UCL tear during a preseason intrasquad game 2/2/24 - exactly two weeks before the season opener at Hawaii

PERSONAL: Full nCompeted in wrestling, football and baseball at Portage High School in Portage, Indiana... Selected by the Yankees in the 16th round (No. 481) of the 2024 MLB Draft and signed for \$150,000.
