ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Matt Gorski launched his ninth home run in his last 16 games as the Indianapolis Indians were defeated by the Omaha Storm Chasers, 4-1, on Friday evening at Victory Field. Heading into the sixth, the contest was tied 1-1 after Logan Porter roped an RBI single off Indians starter Domingo Germán in the top of the first inning. Gorski, however, responded with a solo home run to even the score in the third. The Storm Chasers secured the lead on a three-run blast, courtesy of Brian O'Keefe, to put Omaha ahead and cap the scoring.

AT THE VIC: Last night's loss was Indy's fourth on the homestand, marking the first time in five home series that the Indians have been handed a loss at Victory Field. The Indians won each of their first three homestands (4-2 vs. Memphis, 5-1 vs. St. Paul, 4-2 vs. Buffalo) before splitting last homestand with the Toledo Mud Hens, 3-3. Indianapolis' first series loss at home comes on the heels of their first road trip with more than one win, splitting a six-game series at lowa from May 21-26.

APRIL FLOWERS, MAY SHOWERS: The Indians went 11-17 in the month of May, their worst record in the calendar month since going 11-18 in May in 2003. They alternated months with winning and losing records in 2023, finishing below .500 in April, June and August with winning records in May, July and September. The 2024 Indians are on the same trajectory, going 12-10 in April ahead of May. Despite the losing record, the Indians led the International League in batting average (.273) while ranking among team leaders in hits (2nd, 252), triples (2nd, 8), total bases (3rd, 411), on-base percentage (5th, .361) and RBI (T-5th, 147) in 28 May games.

GOOD GRACIOUS, GORSKI: Matt Gorski, a native of Fishers, Ind., capped a scorching-hot month of May with a double and his ninth home run in his past 16 games last night. The slugger has hit the cover off the ball since May 16, batting .316 (18-for-57) with 16 runs, three doubles, two triples, nine home runs, 25 RBI, a .364 on-base percentage and .912 slugging percentage. In that time, he leads professional batters in RBI, total bases (52), home runs (T-1st with Aaron Judge) and extra-base hits (T-1st, 14).

MAY PLAYER OF THE MONTH: Matt Gorski was today named the Indians' May Player of the Month. His nine home runs in May are the third-most by an Indians batter in a single month since 2005 and are the most since Michael Ryan launched 10 in July 2007. In 23 May games, he led International League leaders with 28 RBI and three triples while ranking among qualifiers in home runs (T-1st, 9), slugging percentage (2nd, .720), extra-base hits (T-3rd, 15), total bases (T-3rd, 59), runs (T-4th, 21) and OPS (5th, 1.050).

BACK ON THE STREAK: After having his 27-game on-base streak since April 18 snapped on Wednesday night, Jake Lamb has reached base safely in three games since. He has now reached base safely in 41 of 43 games with Indianapolis this season, ranking third among International League leaders with a .331 batting average (51-for-154) while also leading team leaders in on-base percentage (.416) and hits.

TONIGHT: The Indians continue a seven-game homestand vs the Omaha Storm Chasers, Triple-A affiliate of the Kansas City Royals, tonight at 6:35 PM ET. Continuing the series for Indianapolis today will be LHP Nick Dombkowski (1-0, 3.86), making his second career start against the Storm Chasers after tossing 3.0 two-run innings with four strikeouts to earn the win in the series-opener on Tuesday. Countering for the Storm Chasers will be RHP Jonathan Bowlan (5-2, 5.57), who took the loss on Tuesday after surrendering nine runs (seven earned) in 2.2 innings. In his first career start vs. Indy, he earned the win with 6.0 two-run innings on Sept. 16, 2023.

NICK TAKES THE HILL: Nick Dombkowski is set to make his first start of the season today vs. Omaha. In 10 appearances between Double-A Altoona and Indianapolis this season, he is 4-1 with a 2.63 ERA (7er/24.0ip) with 16 strikeouts, including earning the win on Tuesday vs. Omaha. He made eight starts in 2023, going 1-3 with a 4.45 ERA (16er/32.1ip) and 24 strikeouts compared to a 4-3 record with a 3.25 ERA (19er/52.2ip) and 34 strikeouts as a reliever with Altoona.

WELCOME, FELLOWS: Right-handed pitcher Drake Fellows was promoted from Double-A Altoona today after beginning the season with High-A Greensboro. He's been an effective arm in the Pirates farm system this season, going 2-0 with a 2.96 ERA (9er/27.1ip) and 29 strikeouts in nine appearances (two starts) between the two levels this season. He stunned Double-A batters in five appearances (two starts), logging a 1.59 ERA (3er/17.0ip) and 18 strikeouts in May. On May 17 at Akron, he fanned a career-high seven batters across 4.0 shutout frames. Fellows traded to Pittsburgh from San Diego in the three-team deal that saw Joe Musgrove to the Padres and Endy Rodríguez to the Pirates from New York (NL).

THIS DATE IN 1997: The Indians won 3-0 and 4-0 in a doubleheader sweep over Nashville at Victory Field, which led the American Association Eastern Division at the time. Scott Klingenbeck tossed 6.0 scoreless innings in Game 1 and Scott Service earned his seventh save of the year in the 3-0 win. In the nightcap, right-hander Brett Tomko improved to 6-3 with 6.0 three-hit innings and Felix Rodriguez finished off the 4-0 win. Eric Owens and Tim Belk each had multiple hits in the opener, with Belk driving in a run on the only home run of the day. Pat Watkins and Aaron Boone led the offense with multi-hit games to end the twin bill.
