YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost their seventh straight game, falling to the SeaWolves, 8-3. After a leadoff single by Carter Howell, Victor Bericoto drove an RBI double on the third pitch of the game to give Richmond a 1-0 lead. After Carson Ragsdale retired 10 straight batters, Trei Cruz hit a solo homer in the fifth to tie the score. Later in the inning, Chris Meyers gave the SeaWolves a 2-1 lead with a solo homer. Ragsdale allowed two runs over five innings in his start. In the sixth, Carlos Mendoza scored on a double steal and Cruz added an RBI double to open a 4-1 lead. Jairo Pomares hit his first Double-A homer, a solo shot, in the seventh to close the score to 4-2. In the bottom of the seventh, Ben Malgeri hit a two-run homer and Hao-Yu Lee singled in a run to extend the Erie lead to 7-2. Cruz scored on a balk in the eighth. In the top of the ninth, Andy Thomas scored on a wild pitch to close the score to 8-3.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels face the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, in the finale of a six-game series at UPMC Park. Richmond and Erie have met in the Southwest Division Series each of the last two seasons. Erie has won each of those series, including en route to winning the franchise's first Eastern League championship last season. This series is the first this year between the Flying Squirrels and SeaWolves. Erie comes to Richmond for six games from May 28-June 2. The Flying Squirrels return to Erie for six games from August 27-September 1.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have dropped 11-of-12 dating back to April 28, including 10-of-11 in the current road trip to Akron and Erie. The lone win in that stretch came last Friday in a shutout at Akron. In the previous series at home, the Flying Squirrels picked up their first series win of the year, taking four-of-six against the Baysox. The current losing streak is the longest for the Flying Squirrels since they lost seven consecutive games from May 25-June 1, 2023.

**THE SEAWOLVES** are the defending Eastern League champions. This year, they are in second place in the Southwest Division standings. They went 2-3 in last week's series against the Baysox in Bowie, with the series finale being canceled due to rain. After starting the season 9-4, the SeaWolves have gone 8-7 in their last 15 games since April 21. Erie's roster includes two of Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects, including RHP Troy Melton (No. 10) and 2B Hao-Yu Lee (No. 12). Three Erie players are on MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects, including Melton (No. 11), Lee (No. 14), and OF/INF Trei Cruz (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Matt Frisbee makes his seventh appearance and his sixth start of the season. He started the series opener on Tuesday against the SeaWolves and allowed three runs over three innings in a loss. It was his fourth straight start with a loss. In his Eastern League career dating back to 2021, Frisbee has gone 2-4 with a 5.18 ERA (24 ER/41.2 IP) in his 14 games against the SeaWolves, including eight starts. In his Richmond career, Frisbee is 17-18 with a 5.00 ERA (144 ER/259.0 IP). He is ranked fourth in Flying Squirrels franchise history in career strikeouts (251) and third (min. 150 IP) in K/9 (8.72). On May 13, 2021, Frisbee threw six perfect innings in a combined no-hitter with Joey Marciano, Matt Seelinger and Patrick Ruotolo, the first nine-inning no hitter in Flying Squirrels franchise history and the second overall no-hitter in team history. On August 10, 2022 at Portland, Frisbee set a single-game franchise record with 13 strikeouts and allowed one hit, a fourth-inning single by rehabbing Red Sox outfielder Kiké Hernández, over six scoreless innings. Last year, Frisbee spent most of the season with Richmond, going 6-0 with a 4.54 ERA in 27 appearances, his first season working primarily as a reliever. Frisbee was selected by the Giants in the 15th round of the 2018 MLB Draft out of UNC Greensboro. For more on Frisbee, see page two.

FOR ERIE: Left-hander Lael Lockhart makes his sixth start of the season and his second of the series against the Flying Squirrels. In the series opener on Tuesday, Lockhart pitched four scoreless innings and struck out seven batters, lowering his season ERA to 2.35. In his last start prior to this series, he threw three innings and allowed three runs at Bowie on April 30. He was scheduled to start the series finale last Sunday afternoon at Bowie before the game was canceled due to rain. In his each of previous two starts on April 17 at Akron and April 23 against Harrisburg, Lockhart threw five innings and did not allow an earned run, combining for 13 strikeouts in 10 innings. Lockhart is in his second season with the SeaWolves. Last year, he went 5-2 with a 2.69 ERA in 18 outings (12 starts). In his career against the Flying Squirrels, Lockhart is 1-0 with a 0.73 ERA (1 ER/12.1 IP) in four outings (one start). Lockhart was selected in the ninth round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Los Angeles Dodgers out of the University of Arkansas. He was traded to the Tigers on May 26, 2023.

**AWESOME APRIL:** The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans last month for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history, pending today's attendance. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and ranked third among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance, trailing only Dayton (7,923) and Worcester (7,453).

RISPY BUSINESS: In their last 15 games since April 25, the Flying Squirrels have hit .090 (8-for-89) with runners in scoring position, averaging 1.93 runs per game (29 total runs). On the current road trip to Akron and Erie, Richmond is batting .058 (4-for-69) with runners in scoring position and averaging 1.6 runs per game (18 total runs). In last week's series, the Flying Squirrels were shut out in the Tuesday opener and then scored their only runs on solo homers last Wednesday. Their only runs last Saturday came on a second-inning grand slam by Grant McCray. They did not have an at-bat with a runner in scoring position on Sunday in the finale at Akron. So far in the series in Erie, the Flying Squirrels went 0-for-8 with runners in scoring position on Tuesday night, 0-for-3 on Wednesday, scoring their only run in that game on an error, 0-for-6 on Thursday, 0-for-6 in Friday's shutout loss and 0-for-9 on Saturday. In the last six games since Sunday, Richmond is 0-for-33 with runners in scoring position.

**THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY:** There are three relievers on the active Richmond roster who hold a sub-2.00 ERA so far this season. Among Eastern League relievers (min. 15 IP), three Richmond pitchers rank in the top seven in ERA, including **Evan Gates** (2nd - 1.10 ERA - 2 ER/16.1 IP), **Wil Jensen** (3rd - 1.27 ERA - 3 ER/21.1 IP) and **Tanner Kiest** (7th - 1.76 ERA - 3 ER/15.1 IP). Jensen also leads the league in relief innings pitched (21.1).

HIT HUNTER: Over his last nine games since April 27, Hunter Bishop is batting .314 (11-for-35) with a homer, four doubles, one RBI, four runs scored and two stolen bases. That stretch has raised his season batting average from .210 to .247. Since May 1, Bishop has picked up multiple hits in four-of-six games, batting .333 (8-for-24). Bishop's .247 batting average is second among Richmond hitters this year.

**HOWELL HEATING UP: Carter Howell** is leading all Richmond hitters this season with a .267 batting average and a .370 OBP. In his last seven games since May 3, Howell is batting .333 (8-for-24) with two doubles, two RBIs, five walks and a .448 on-base percentage. His seven doubles this season are tied for third-most in the Giants organization.

**WE DON'T WANNA TALK ABOUT IT:** The Flying Squirrels' current seven-game losing streak is their longest since losing seven straight last season from May 25-June 1, 2023. It is tied for the fourth-longest losing streak in team history, with other seven-game losing skids in 2013 (twice), 2017 and 2018. The Flying Squirrels lost eight straight games from July 30-August 7, 2014. They've had two losing streaks hit double-digits in franchise history. From May 7-20, 2016, the Flying Squirrels lost 14 straight games. Richmond lost 15 consecutive games from April 14-May 3, 2015, which was tied by Altoona earlier this month for the longest Eastern League losing streak in the "digitized era," dating back to 2005.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Hayden Birdsong is 10th in ERA (2.49), tied for fourth in strikeouts (35), second in BAA (148) and seventh in WHIP (1.07). Ryan Murphy is first in games started. John Michael Bertrand is first in innings pitched (36.1). Carson Ragsdale is 10th in BAA (.209).

PROSPECT WATCH: Eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including Hayden Birdsong (No. 6), Reggie Crawford (No. 9), Grant McCray (No. 10), Vaun Brown (No. 11), Eric Silva (No. 22), Adrián Sugastey (No. 25), Ryan Murphy (No. 28) and José Cruz (No. 30). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm. Crawford is rated as having the best fastball and best slider. Seven players landed on MLB. com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 6), Crawford (No. 8), McCray (No. 13), Brown (No. 15), Victor Bericoto (No. 20), Sugastey (No. 24) and OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26).
