TODAY'S GAME: The Curve continue up yet another series with the Richmond Flying Squirrels. Altoona plays 18 of their

final 36 games against Richmond this year.

LAST TIME OUT: Matt Fraizer hammered his third homer of the season in a Curve uniform, but Altoona couldn't overcome an early 5-1 deficit in a 5-3 loss to Richmond.

ROAD Z: Infielder Tsung-Che Cheng has one of the most dramatic home/road splits of any Eastern League player. In 54 road games, Cheng is batting .255 with a .795 OPS, totaling 10 2B, 10 HR, 29 RBI and 22 BB. In 50 home games, Cheng is batting .181 with a .556 OPS totaling 6 2B, 1 HR, 18 RBI and 31 BB. Overall, Cheng has done a majority of his damage at the plate on the first pitch of his plate appearance where he's batting .370 with a 1.135 OPS in 46 at-bats that he's put the ball in play in an 0-0 count.

KERVIN AND THE GIANT PEACH: Infielder Kervin Pichardo had a 17-game on-base streak from July 23 - August 15, and has picked up right where he left off with hits in 3-of-4 games since. <u>Pichardo has reached base safely in 20-of-22 games since</u> July 23, during which he's hitting .306/.366/.565/.931 with 3 2B, 2 3B, 5 HR, 16 RBI and 2-2 SB.

YOU GUYS AGAIN?: Altoona and Richmond face off for another six-game series down the stretch of the season. The teams play 18 of their final 36 games against each other. The Curve are 9-5 against the Squirrels this season.

SIR SAMMY SIANI: Outfielder Sammy Siani has heated up at the plate since July 30 (17 games), he's batting: .318/.392/.439/.831 with 4 2B, 2 3B, 7 RBI, 3-4 SB. Siani scored a career-high 4 runs in Altoona's 8-7 win in 11 innings on Saturday, August 17 against Bowie.

SEND US HOME: The Curve picked up their sixth walk-off win of the season on Saturday, August 17 against Bowie when outfielder **Tres Gonzalez** plated the winning run after Bowie committed a throwing error on a bunt attempt. **Jase Bowen** slammed a walk-off three-run homer on Thursday night for the Curve for the team's first win of the week.

FATHER ABRAHAN: Catcher Abrahan Gutierrez has caught fire in August. Gutierrez picked up a hit in 8 straight games since from August 2-14, during which he batted: .333/.351/.417 with 1 2B, 1 3B, 6 RBI. Gutierrez has reached base safely in 29-of-39 games played with Altoona this year, 10-of-12 games in August.

PROVIDING RELIEF: Altoona's bullpen has had a revolving door of talent this year, though of late **Cy Nielson** and **Emmanuel Chapman** have performed the best. Nielson has struck out 16 batters in 10.1 innings since his call-up from Greensboro and Emmanuel Chapman has a 2.11 ERA (38.1 IP / 9 ER), 39 strikeouts and a .137 BAA in his last 15 appearances (3 starts).

SETTING THE TABLE: Outfielder Yoyner Fajardo has led off 33 times with Altoona this season and has become one of the league's best leadoff hitters. Fajardo has recorded .423 on-base percentage as the team's table setter and he ranks all over the league leaderboards since June 1: 5th in BA (.298), 2nd in OBP (.402), T-6th in 3B (3) and T-5th in SB (14).

THE SQUIRRELS THAT FLY: Dennis Pelfrey returns for his third season as Manager for Richmond. Pelfrey led Richmond to the postseason in 2023, their first appearance since 2014 and enters this season ranked second on the club's all-time Mana-gerial wins list. The Flying Squirrels are a touch light in the prospect department, but OF Wade Meckler (No. 14) is back in Runs Scored ...... 10th (468) the fold. INF Diego Velasquez is also here (No. 22) along with C Adrian Sugastey (No. 30).

THE FIRST IN FLIGHT: John Michael Bertrand returns to the mound for the Flying Squirrels on Thursday night. Bertrand has made 4 starts against the Curve this season, going 1-2 with a 5.82 ERA, he's struck out 22 batters in 21.2 IP. Bertrand is the second Flying Squirrel in team history to earn two EL Pitcher of the Week awards in the same season, first since Eric Surkamp in 2011. Bertrand was San Francisco's 10th round pick in 2022 out of Notre Dame and reached Richmond for 11 starts in 2023 where he recorded a 4.67 ERA. Bertrand began his college career at Furman where he pitched for three seasons before finishing at Notre Dame, his father Jim rowed collegiately at the University of San Diego and his brother JD was a linebacker and team captain for Notre Dame's Football team.
