## THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On this day in 1999, the Sounds hit a team-record six home runs in a contest at Tim McCarver Stadium against the Memphis Redbirds.

**Today's Game:** The Sounds and Tides wrap up their final regular season matchup with a late afternoon contest at Harbor Park. Josh VanMeter's go-ahead two-run blast put Nashville up for good in a 5-4 win last night. Right-hander Jason Alexander gets the start for the Sounds. He'll face right-hander Ryan Watson.

**Jason Alexander:** 30-year-old Jason Alexander returns to the mound after starting in the series opener. The right-hander is 2-1 with a 5.08 ERA (28.1 IP/16 ER) in six starts with Nashville. He also made three appearances between the ACL Brewers and Double-A Biloxi on rehab assignment earlier this season. Alexander did not factor into the decision in Tuesday's 10-8 win, giving up five runs (all earned) on nine hits in 5.0 innings. He began 2023 on the injured list with a strained right rotator cuff. Alexander made three rehab starts before being optioned on July 7. He was later outrighted off the Brewers 40-man roster on July 24. The Menlo College product split the 2022 season between Milwaukee and Nashville. In his MLB debut season, Alexander went 2-3 with a 5.40 ERA (71.2 IP/43) across 18 appearances and 11 starts. He was signed by the Brewers on November 28, 2021 as a free agent. Alexander went undrafted but was signed by the Angels on June 21, 2017.

**Ryan Watson:** 25-year-old Ryan Watson gets the start for the Tides in the series finale. The right-hander is 4-3 with a 5.02 ERA (61.0 IP/34 ER) in 20 appearances and nine starts with Norfolk. He tossed 3.0 scoreless innings to start the night against Nashville on Tuesday, but was not around for Nashville's rally and eventual 10-8 win. It is his sixth appearance this month. As it stands now, Watson has his lowest monthly ERA (3.21), just under his 3.63 mark he set in April. The former Auburn Tiger boasts a 2.81 ERA (32.0 IP/10 ER) at Harbor Park compared to a 7.45 ERA (29.0 IP/24 ER) away from Norfolk. This is Watson's third season in affiliated baseball. He was originally drafted by the Dodgers in the 39th round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Auburn (AL) High School but did not sign. He was then signed as a non-drafted free agent by Baltimore on June 4, 2020.

**2023 Standings:** The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in the second half of 2023: First: 6 (Tied), Second: 9, Third: 9, Fourth: 2, Fifth: 0, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0, Eighth: 0, Ninth: 0, Tenth: 0.

**Measured in VanMeters:** Infielder Josh VanMeter hit his fifth home run with a go-ahead two-run blast in the ninth inning that proved to be the winning runs in a 5-4 triumph. VanMeter has reached in each of his last nine games and has recorded a hit in seven of his last eight. Since July 16, the Fort Wayne, Ind. native is batting .348 (8-for-23) with two homers, six RBI, 15 walks and 10 runs. Dating back to his return from the injured list on June 21, VanMeter leads Triple-A in walks (31) and ranks third in on-base percentage (.495). Among players to appear in at least 25 Triple-A games this season, his .470 OBP is the fourth-best at the level.

**Wicho Cranks it to 11:** Infielder Luis Urias extended his on-base streak to 11 games with a double in his final at-bat. During the streak, Wicho has a .456 on-base percentage and .991 OPS with 13 runs, 12 hits, three homers, eight RBI and 13 walks.

**Vamos Vieira:** Thyago Vieira added his fourth save of the season, holding Norfolk without a run in the ninth. After having a rocky month of June, Vieira has bounced back with a 1.35 ERA (6.2 IP/1 ER) and 0.90 WHIP across six July appearances.

**What a Win Means:** With a victory in today's series finale, the Sounds can get their first series win against a team over .500 this season. Nashville's last series win came before the All-Star break, taking three of five from Columbus from July 4-9. Entering the day, Nashville sits two games back from first-place Buffalo (16-9) in the International League second half standings.

**Arms Race:** The series features the two top teams of the International League's ERA leaderboard in Nashville (4.49) and Norfolk (4.50). Nashville leads the circuit in fewest home runs allowed (98), fewest walks allowed (374) and WHIP (1.43). Norfolk paces the league in wins (62), saves (28), fewest runs allowed (464) and opponent batting average (.248).

**The Future Brew Crew:** Nashville currently has three players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 7 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 11 prospect and right-handed pitcher Justin Jarvis is the No. 30 prospect.

**How Sweet It Is:** Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 654-563 record during an eight-season span.

**LAST OUTING:** Alexander fought through a tough few innings in the series opener on July 25, dealing with a lot of traffic on the basepaths (9 H, 3 BB) and departing the game after five frames with five runs allowed. Alexander did not factor into the decision in Nashville's come-from-behind 10-8 victory.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** Alexander has six career appearances (4 starts) against Norfolk, posting a 2-1 record and 3.21 ERA (28.0 IP/10 ER) with 21 strikeouts. In two starts against the Tides this season, he is 0-0 with a 4.66 ERA (9.2 IP/5 ER).

### 2023 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Placed on Milwaukee's 60-day injured list with a strained right rotator cuff on February 18... started rehab assignment at Arizona complex on June 9, making two starts
- Assignment transferred to Double-A Biloxi on June 20... after one start, moved to Nashville on June 25
- On June 30 at Memphis, earned win with 5.1 innings and one run allowed... was first since August 19, 2022 (G1) at Jacksonville
- Took no decision in Nashville's wild 15-14 walk-off win on July 5...was activated and optioned to Nashville on July 8... removed from Milwaukee's 40-man roster and outrighted to Nashville on July 24
- Did not allow a home run through first eight outings of season (33.0 IP total, 25.1 with Nashville), finally surrendering a blast in the third inning of the July 25 contest at Norfolk (solo to Coby Mayo)

### 2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Went 2-3 with a 5.40 ERA in 18 games (11 starts) over four stints with Milwaukee...went 2-3 with a 4.82 ERA as a starter (56.0 IP) and 0-0 with a 7.47 ERA as a reliever (15.2 IP)
- Went 8-2 with a 2.84 ERA in 13 games (10 starts) with Nashville... won six of first eight games (six starts) with the Sounds, posting 2.66 ERA (40.2 IP/12 ER) over span
- At time of promotion on June 1, led International League with six wins
- Made his Major League debut on June 1 at Chicago-NL, tossing a quality start (7.0 IP, 2 ER) in an extra-inning loss... was first Brewer with quality start in MLB debut since Brandon Woodruff in 2017

- His older brother, Scott, has pitched in the Major Leagues for Kansas City (2015-17), Los Angeles-ML (2018-21) and San Francisco (2022)
- His oldest brother, Stu, pitched in the Marlins organization from 2004-09
