Today is a special **Capital City Market Kids Day: Conservation Carnival**, with postgame Kids Run the Bases, as the Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, and Great Lakes Loons, High-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers, play the finale in a six-game series. The Nuts have lost the first five games of the series, setting the franchise record with 11 consecutive losses.

Last Night: Loons 12, Lugnuts 8. Great Lakes third baseman **Chase Harlan** went 4-for-5 with a double and two home runs, helping the Loons build an 11-1 lead and then hang on tight in front of a Saturday night crowd of 6,912. **Jared Sprague-Lott** went 2-for-3 with two singles, two walks and three runs scored, **Carlos Franco** drilled two doubles and knocked in three, and **Nate Nankil** knocked his 2nd home run of the year in the loss.

On the Air: Adam Jaksa and Jesse Goldberg-Strassler, the Nuts' broadcast tandem since 2019, deliver the call on **MLB TV**, **Bally Live** and mlb.streamguys1.com/lansing.

On Deck: The Lugnuts embark on a two-week Ohio road trip, first to Dayton, then to Lake County, leading into the All-Star Break. The next home game: 19 days away.

LUG-NOTES

On Losing: We're in uncharted territory; the previous Lugnuts team record for consecutive defeats was ten, occurring twice before, most recently from June 27-July 7, 2013. (Last year's Lugnuts lost nine straight, from August 17-27.) During the current 11-game losing streak, the Lugnuts are batting .216/.309/.295 with three home runs and nine steals, averaging 3.4 runs on 7.2 hits per game; the pitching staff has a 7.66 ERA, allowing 19 home runs and a .312 opponent batting average. It is not the longest losing streak in the Midwest League this season. That belongs to West Michigan, which lost 14 games from April 25 through May 10 amid a stretch of 25 losses in 27 games.

A'round the A's Org.:

- Begin with the Single-A Stockton Ports, who received three doubles (and five RBIs) from teenager **Breyson Guede**, two triples from **Max Durrington**, and one home run from **Gavin Turley** to beat Rancho Cucamonga, 11-1. Rancho's only run was unearned.
- 2026 Lugnut **Jackson Finley** was brilliant, striking out nine batters in 5 2/3 innings, and the Double-A Midland RockHounds collected exactly one hit, a double from 2024-25 Lugnut **Ryan Lasko**, driven in by 2024 Lugnut **Luke Mann** for a 1-0 win over Wichita.
- The Triple-A Las Vegas Aviators also won, 1-0, though they collected five hits. 2025 Lugnuts **Tommy White** and **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer** combined for the only run of the game.
- 2023 Lugnut **Jack Perkins** whiffed five Angels in five innings, allowing two runs, but the A's lost, 5-2.

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster has four players on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of A's prospects: No. 16 (**Steven Echavarria**), No. 18 (**Zane Taylor**), No. 23 (**Nate Nankil**) and No. 30 (**Nathan Dettmer**). Baseball America's recent re-ranking of A's prospects puts Echavarria at No. 16, Zane Taylor at No. 18 and **Nathan Dettmer** at No. 21.

Big League Nuts: 2023 Lugnut **Junior Pérez** made his MLB debut for the Chicago White Sox on June 18, becoming the 206th all-time Lugnut to reach the Majors and the sixth this season (**Daniel Susac**, **Eduardo Rivera**, **Henry Bolte**, **Gage Jump**, **Kade Morris**). There are nine current Lugnuts on the Athletics: Bolte, Jump, **Lawrence Butler**, **Joey Estes**, **Hogan Harris**, **Jack Perkins**, **Tyler Soderstrom** and **Colby Thomas**.

All-Star Phase 2: Two starters are locked in to the 2026 MLB All-Star Game, **Shohei Ohtani** and **Ernie Clement**, as the top overall vote-getters in each league. Among the finalists for votes to determine the remaining starters, 2019 Lansing Lugnut **Alejandro Kirk** opposes the A's **Shea Langeliers** for A.L. starting catcher while 2017 Lugnut **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.** opposes the Yankees' Ben Rice for A.L. starting first baseman. Look for Guerrero to make his 6th All-Star Game appearance, second in Lansing history behind only **Carlos Beltrán** (nine All-Star nods).

Pitcher's Best Friend: The Lugnuts lead all of High-A in turning double plays, with 79 in 72 games.

Cooperstown Bound: An original 1996 Lugnut as a member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** went on to be voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series during a 20-year MLB career. On July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown.

2019: Hagen Danner notched his second two-HR game of the year, Griffin Conine swatted a two-run shot, and the host Lugnuts beat Lake County, 9-4. Danner knocked solo home runs down the left-field line in the third inning and down the right-field line in the fourth inning, erasing an early 2-0 deficit.

2025: Jared Dickey cracks a two-out, two-run, go-ahead home run in the bottom of the eighth to beat Dayton, 4-3..
