HATCHER, ORTIZ BLAST OFF, FRISCO EXPLODES IN 12-7 VICTORY:

The Frisco RoughRiders prevailed over the Springfield Cardinals 12-7 on Saturday night from Riders Field, snapping a four-game losing streak in front of 10,142 fans. Springfield (31-25) struck first in the top of the third when R.J. Yeager clipped an RBI double, Carlos Linarez rolled an RBI groundout and Darlin Moquete roped an RBI single to put the Cardinals up 3-0. Frisco (32-23) then answered in the bottom of the third when Jax Biggers smashed a two-run single, advancing to third on a missed catch error by catcher Carlos Linarez to cut the deficit to 3-2. Tucker Mitchell then shot an RBI single to tie the game at three. In the bottom of the fifth, Sebastian Walcott plopped a lights-aided RBI double into shallow left to capture a 4-3 lead. Josh Hatcher then drilled a three-run homer to lift the Riders in front 7-3. In the bottom of the sixth, Mitchell laced an RBI single to expand Frisco's ledger to 8-3. Next half inning, Springfield stepped closer when JJ Wetherholt hit an RBI single, trimming the lead to 8-4. Frisco exploded for its second four-run frame of the night. Cam Cauley drilled an RBI double and Abimelec Ortiz cranked a three-run blast, stretching the Riders lead to 12-4. The Cardinals responded in the bottom of the ninth, when Moquete homered, Jeremy Rivas lifted an RBI double and Joshua Baez roped an RBI single to shave the deficit to 12-7. Riders reliever **Gerardo Carillo** then induced a groundout to second before first baseman Frainyer Chavez threw out Rivas at third to end the game. Frisco reliever Larson Kindreich (2-1) secured the victory, toss-ing 2.1 innings while allowing one run. Springfield starter Pete Hansen (3-2) suffered the loss, allowing seven runs across five frames.

CAULEY ON THE LINE:

Over his last 26 games, Cam Cauley has hit .307 (27-for-88)/.380/.523/.903 with eight doubles, three home runs and 17 runs scored. Over his last 11 games, he is batting .378 (14-for-37)/.477/.595/1.072 with seven runs scored.

RISP-ECT THIS:

The Riders have struggled with runners in scoring position in this series against Springfield, but exploded last night. In the first four games, they went just 2-for-30 with runners at second, third or both. Yesterday, the Riders went 7-for-14 with RISP while scoring 12 runs, including two three-run home runs.

OH, WHAT A RELIEF IT IS:

The Riders have been strong out of their bullpen as of late. In this series, the Frisco bullpen has allowed just nine runs over 24.1 innings (3.33 ERA). Dating back to Saturday, May 31st, the Riders bullpen has allowed just nine earned runs in their last 28.2 innings (2.83 ERA). Overall this season, Riders bullpen arms own a 4.32 ERA, sixth in the Texas League.

NO SWING AND A MIESES:

RoughRiders outfielder Luis Mieses has been fantastic at the plate. Mieses is second in the Texas League in slugging percentage (.532), fourth in OPS (.885) and tied for fifth with 20 extra-base hits. He won Texas League Player of the Week last week, hitting .364 (8-for-22)/.462/.955/1.417 with four doubles and three home runs. In his last 16 games, he is hitting .296 (16-for-54)/.387/.704/1.091 with seven doubles, five home runs and 11 RBIs. On a eight-game hitting streak, he is hitting .300 (9-for-30) with a 1.150 OPS with an extra-base hit in every game except one.

SAVE TONIGHT:

On Thursday night, Janser Lara became the 11th different Riders pitcher to record a save in 2025. Frisco is the only team in Minor League Baseball to accomplish the feat this season. Current Triple-A Round Rock pitcher Robby Ahlstrom and Gavin Collyer are tied for the lead in saves (four) for the Riders and Skylar Hales has recorded two saves. Frisco's 18 saves are tied for the second-most in Minor League Baseball.

OVER THE WALL-COTT:

Rangers top prospect Sebastian Walcott has been displaying the power as of late. In his last 21 games, he has blasted six home runs while slashing .250/.347/.548/.895 with seven doubles, 15 RBIs, 19 runs scored and 12 walks to 16 strikeouts. Last Friday, he became the fifth Texas League teenager since 2005 to record a multi-homer game, joining the company of Keibert Ruiz (2018, 2x), Fernando Tatis Jr. (2018, 3x), Alex Verdugo (2016) and Mike Trout (2011). This season, his walk rate of 12.5 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 21.6 percent, a career low. His 15 doubles lead the league and his 23 extra-base hits also pace the league.

DOUBLE-A DOUBL-A RON:

Aaron Zavala has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. After a dreadful start, batting just .077 (2-for-26) through 10 games, he is hitting .317 (38-for-120)/.432/.500/.932 over his last 34 games. He leads the Texas League in walks (37) and is second in OBP (.420) while leading the league in walk rate (19.7 percent). In his last 11 games, he is hitting .349 (15-for-43)/.404/.512/.916 with a double, two home runs and four RBIs.

-Born in Bryan, Texas, but grew up in La Grange, Texas (La Grange didn't have a hospital). At La Grange High School, he starred in football, basketball and baseball and became the first player drafted from LGHS since **Homer Bailey** in 2004.

-Committed to University of Houston before signing with Pittsburgh. His uncle Jody was an All-American at Houston and was drafted by Detroit in 1987.

-Was drafted by the Pirates in the CB-B round of 2014.

-Allowed just three run through first three 5.0-inning starts.

-Made spot start with Triple-A Round Rock on May 3rd, allowing just two runs over five innings while striking out four and walking one.

2024 SEASON

-Spent time between Double-A Tennessee and Triple-A Iowa

2023 SEASON

-Split time between Double-A Midland and Triple-A Las Vegas. Against Frisco in 2023, he made three appearances out of the bullpen (3.1 IP, 5 H, 4 R, 2 ER, 3 BB, 3 K), allowing a home run to Dustin Harris.

2021-2022 SEASON

-After electing free agency in Nov. of 2020, signed with the A's organization 18 days later.

-Missed the entire season and most of 2022 with "Tommy John" Surgery. Returned to make three starts with Midland that season.

2020 SEASON

Was called up from the Taxi Squad to the MLB roster in 2020 for three days and was sent back down without making an appearance.

2019 SEASON

-Finished the season as the No. 11 prospect in the Brewers organization by MLB.com.

-When he made his Triple-A debut with San Antonio, it was 1.5 hours from hometown, so he had 40-50 friends and family there. "I have never had a feeling like that heading out to the mound."

-With Double-A Biloxi, won Southern League Most Outstanding Pitcher after leading the league in ERA (2.20), opponent batting average (.192) and tying for the lead in wins (11).

2014-2018 SEASON

-In December of 2015, he was traded to Milwaukee from Pittsburgh along with Keon Broxton in exchange for Jason Rogers.
