The Round Rock Express and Sacramento River Cats (San Francisco Giants) get ready for the series finale on Sunday afternoon. Round Rock RHP Jack Leiter is slated to take the mound against San Francisco Giants rehabber LHP Blake Snell. First pitch is scheduled for 3:05 p.m. CT.

BACK IN THE WIN COLUMN

The Express hung on for a 6-3 win over the River Cats on Saturday night in game five of the series from Sutter Health Park. The E-Train have taken four of the five games played in the set. Round Rock started things off with three in the first inning. Singles from SS Jonathan Ornelas and CF Derek Hill allowed C Sam Huff to come up and double as the E-Train led 2-0. LF Dustin Harris singled to score Huff and it was a 3-0 lead. The E-Train plated another run in the sixth frame. With Hill on third base, RF Sandro Fabian grounded out to extend the lead to 4-0. In the seventh, Texas Rangers rehabber DH Justin Foscue drilled a two-run homer for his first hit on this rehab assignment and the Express held a 6-0 lead. Sacramento answered in the home-half of the seventh. A wild pitch allowed CF Grant McCray to score from third base. 2B Donovan Walton kept things rolling when he singled home RF Brett Auerbach to cut the lead at 6-2. C Logan Porter singled to score Walton and the E-Train lead was trimmed to 6-3. Texas Rangers rehabber RHP Josh Sborz and Express RHP Grant Anderson each threw a scoreless inning to secure the win as the score stood final.

BACK TO JACK

Round Rock RHP Jack Leiter is scheduled to make his 11th appearance and 10th start of the year. Leiter has posted 11.8 strikeouts per nine innings this year and is coming off 7.0 innings of scoreless baseball on Tuesday against Sacramento where he struck out eight. Despite having a 1.44 WHIP for his career, he owns a 1.20 WHIP this season.

STELLAR SAMPSON

Express RHP Adrian Sampson became just the second pitcher in the PCL to reach eight wins and just the 10th in the minors to accomplish the feat. His 10 strikeouts set a new single-game high in the minors. It's just the second time he's tossed more than 10 strikeouts in a game. He posted 11 strikeouts on June 2, 2019 against the Kansas City Royals while he pitched for the Rangers. In 193 games and 169 starts in the minors, Sampson had never had more than eight strikeouts in a game.

FOSS BOMB

Texas Rangers rehabber DH Justin Foscue extended his on-base streak to 39 games at the Triple-A level, dating back to August 18, 2023. He went 1-for-4 with a home run, two RBI and a run scored yesterday. Foscue is 1-for-7 with a home run, two RBI, two runs scored, five walks and zero strikeouts in his three games. In 128 Triple-A games over the last two years, Foscue has 92 walks and 74 strikeouts.

SERIES VICTORY

Round Rock collected their first series win since May 14-19 against Reno back at Dell Diamond. The E-Train were 0-3-1 in their last four series with a record of 8-16 in that span.

ON THE HORIZON

Today marks the final game of the first half. Round Rock will open-up a nine-game homestand on Tuesday with six against the El Paso Chihuahuas (San Diego Padres) and three against the Sugar Land Space Cowboys (Houston Astros).

ALCS EXPRESS REUNION

The 2023 ALCS between Houston and Texas featured 22 players that appeared in a game for the Express. The Express reunited as the Rangers Triple-A affiliate in 2021 after spending eight seasons as the club's top affiliate from 2011-2018. Round Rock was previously a member of the Houston Astros organization from 2019-2020. From the Rangers, LHP Cody Bradford (2023), OF Evan Carter (2023), C Mitch Garver (2022, 2023), OF Travis Jankowski (2023), INF Josh Jung (2021, 2022), RHP Jose Leclerc (2016, 2018, 2022), LHP Martin Perez (2011, 2012, 2013, 2015, 2018), RHP Josh Sborz (2022, 2023), INF Josh Smith (2022), OF Leody Taveras (2021, 2022, 2023) appeared in the ALCS. For the Astros, RHP Bryan Abreu (2019), INF Jose Altuve (2019), INF Yordan Alvarez (2019), RHP Ronel Blanco (2019), RHP Cristian Javier (2019), OF Chas McCormick (2019), OF Kyle Tucker (2019), RHP Jose Urquidy (2019), LHP Framber Valdez (2019) appeared in the series and also played for the E-Train.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.

Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
