## PORTLAND WALKS TO SUNDAY VICTORY OVER CATS:

Chavez Young ripped a three-run double in the top of the sixth inning to give the Fisher Cats the lead, but the Portland Sea Dogs rallied for a 12-6 win on Sunday at Hadlock Field. Johan Mieses hit his second home run of the game, and fourth of the series for Portland, in the bottom of the sixth inning to tie the game at 6-6. Then the Sea Dogs (5-1) took advantage of eight walks by Fisher Cats relievers in the last of the eighth inning to secure a fifth straight win in the series.

## GROSHANS PLATES FIRST:

Jordan Groshans followed an Otto Lopez single in the top of the first inning with a double, plating his first run at the Double-A level. It was also his first extra base hit. New Hampshire had a 3-0 lead Sunday after an RBI double by Demi Orimoloye and an error on a dropped third strike.

**HOME SWEET HOME:** Tonight is the first of 60 scheduled home games at Delta Dental Stadium for the Fisher Cats. New Hampshire moved into the new ballpark to open the 2005 season, after claiming the Eastern League title in the inaugural season at Gill Stadium in Manchester. The Fisher Cats have been affiliated with the Toronto Blue Jays since 2004, and won three titles (2004, 2011, 2018).

**WELCOME SOMERSET:** The Patriots join the Double-A Northeast League as a Yankees affiliate, with the team moving from Trenton. The team is located in Bridgewater Township, N.J.---in Somerset County. The team played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball from 1998 to 2019, with home games at TD Bank Ballpark since 1999. The Patriots won six Atlantic League titles.

**TRIVIA:** When was the last relocation in the Eastern League, and who was involved? Answer- The Colorado Rockies Double-A affiliate moved from New Britain to Hartford, Conn. for the 2016 season, although the Yard Goats did not play in the new Dunkin Donuts Park until 2017.

**ROSTER MOVES:** There have been roster moves involving relief pitchers. RHP Cre Finrock was placed on the IL Sunday, retroactive to 5/8. RHP James Dykstra transferred yesterday to Triple-A Buffalo, and RHP Andrew McInvale added from Adv. A Vancouver.

**BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY:** May 11, 2018 – In Harrisburg, Jordan Romano improved to 6-0 with 5.1 scoreless innings in a 5-0 win over the Senators. Cavan Biggio hit a three-run homer and Max Pentecost had a pair of hits.

**FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS:** Yesterday was an off day in minors (every Monday for Blue Jays affiliates). Toronto was also off. Tonight, the Jays are in Atlanta to start the third leg of a ten-game road trip against the Braves. Robbie Ray is the scheduled starter for Toronto.

**NOT THE START WE WANTED:** The 1-5 start for the Fisher Cats is the worst since the 2008 team opened with six consecutive losses. New Hampshire has not lost six consecutive games since 2014, when the team had a franchise-record 11 game losing streak (May 11-21).

**ON THE HILL: #4 Blue Jays Prospect (MLB.com)** RHP Simeon Woods Richardson makes his second Double-A start. He was staked to a big 5-0 lead at Hadlock in the first game of last Thursday's doubleheader. Woods Richardson faced just one batter over the minimum, with six strikeouts, over the first three innings. Portland got to him for three runs (one earned) in the fourth. He left after 76 pitches, 51 strikes. Was part of the July 2019 trade between the Blue Jays and Mets for Marcus Stroman.

RHP Shawn Semple starts the series opener for Somerset. Drafted by the Yankees in the 11<sup>th</sup> round of the 2017 draft (New Orleans). Made 26 appearances (20 starts) in 2019, including six starts with Trenton. Went 0-3 with a 5.00 ERA for Thunder, but did not face the Fisher Cats. The 25-year old is a native of the Garden State. Tossed four innings of shutout ball against Harrisburg, allowing just one hit and one walk while striking out five batters over his 61-pitch effort last Wednesday.

Went 3-2 with a 2.54 ERA in his six starts with Dunedin, with 29 strikeouts in 28.1 IP. Held FSL hitters to a .182 average. Finished the season with a combined 126 strikeouts in 106.2 IP.
