FROM THE CROWS NEST

CLEVARI TOES THE RUBBER: Right hander Clevari Tejada will toe to rubber for the Marauders in game five of the series for his team-leading 22nd start. Over a career-best 84.1 innings this season, Tejada has pitched to a 4.80 ERA and completed five innings or more six times. Last Saturday vs Daytona, he completed four innings of four-run ball. Over his five outings in July, Tejada was dominant, allowing just four earned runs over 19 innings of work (1.89 ERA). However, the right hander has struggled in August, allowing 13 ER over his four outings (8.16 ERA). Tejada's fastball saw a major uptick in velocity in July, as he averaged 94.9 miles per hour and topped out at 96.9 - good for his hardest pitch of the season. 12 of his 13 hardest thrown pitches this year have come during his last five outings. Tejada's slider has been a plus offering to both left-and-right-handed hitters, as opposing batters at just 8-for-47 against it (.170, 41.2% Whiff). His splitter has also surrendered just nine hits this season (.196) and has generated a 35.8 percent whiff rate. Overall this season, Tejada has seen an increase in swing-and-miss (19.3% K, +2.5% from 2024) and decrease in walks (9.6% BB, -1.9% from 2024).

FLY FLY AWAY: The Marauders earned a dominant 16-5 victory over the Tortugas last Thursday night, marking their largest single-game run total this year. Bradenton collected 15 hits, drew eight walks and also took advantage of six Daytona errors. In the process, they also matched a season high with three homers, their tenth such output this season. It also marked the ninth time in franchise history they had brought home 16 or more, and the first time since 2023 when they pushed across 18 versus Fort Myers. Overall, their 98 longballs this season are the most in the Florida State League and Single-A, as they've now passed San Jose (California League, 95). 153 of their 557 total runs have been generated via the long ball (27.4%). They're 36-29 when leaving the yard at least once, and 21-37 when not homering at all. They've seen six players launch 9+ home runs this season, more than any other team in the FSL (A. Plaz, Y. De Los Santos, K. Griffin, J. Severino, E. Florentino, E. Rodriguez).

BURNING THE BASE PATHS: The Marauders have tied their franchise record with 222 stolen bases this season (2023). Yordany De Los Santos has played a massive role as he stole 51st base ont Friday night, adding to a career-best mark (34 between FCL/Single-A in 2024). He is now tied with Daytona's Kyle Henley for the most in the league - the two are the first FSL players to steal 50 since Seth Stephensen (LAK -62) and Emaarion Boyd (CLR -56) reached the threshold in 2023. In the process, De Los Santos also passed Jesus Castillo (39 - 2023), for the most single-season stolen bases by a Marauder in franchise history. Him and Henley are tied for seventh in Single-A. Moreover, De Los Santos sits only behind Konnor Griffin (64) for the most swipes in the Pittsburgh Pirates system. They are the ninth and tenth 40+ stolen-base seasons in Pirates-MilB history. The two are approaching Rich Thompson for the most in a season by a Pirates minor leaguer since 2005 when he stole 58 that season between Double-A Altoona and Triple-A Indianapolis

WELCOME TO THE STRETCH RUN: As we approach the end of the second half, Bradenton is 27-30, currently 4.0 games (5.0 including tie-breaker) behind the Threshers for the FSL West's final playoff spot (also up 3.0 games up on Dunedin). With eight games to go, the Marauders are eyeing their berilliud the Thissiles for the Crease is mind playor spot (also up 0.0 games of properties). The Marauders currently lead their season series with Dunedin 8-7 and will face the Blue Jays at LECOM Park for six games to complete the regular season.

ELECTRIC EDWARD: Bradenton Marauders outfielder **Edward Florentino** was named Florida State League Player of the Month for his dominant performance in July. He remains the only Marauders player to be honored this season by Minor League Baseball. Over the 23-game stretch, Florentino slashed .301/.433/.663 with 16 stolen bases and 17 walks. His eight home runs and 23 RBI were the most of any player throughout the Florida State League and Single-A. Florentino was also one of three Single-A players, and the only in the FSL, to tally 15 or more walks and ten or more extra-base hits. Florentino is the Pirates No. 5 ranked prospect according to MLB Pipeline and was promoted to Single-A Bradenton on June 21.

TONY TATERS: Pirates No. 30 prospect (MLB Pipeline) **Tony Blanco Jr.** demolished two homers during the Marauders previous homestand. On July 30, he sent a fastball 415 feet to left field, that cleared the confines of LECOM Park. The ball left his bat at 118.9 miles per hour, marking the hardest-hit ball in Single-A at the time, clearing the next closest batted ball by 4.4 mph. Three nights later, he also demolished a walk-off three-run homer that left the bat at 119.8 mph - the hardest-batted ball in Mil.B this season. Only three batted balls at the Major-League level have been hit harder this season. He joins Oneil Cruz (122.9 mph) and Vladamir Guerrero Jr. (120.4 mph) on the list. Only him and Cruz (122.9 mph) have left the yard with such batted ball quality. He was activated and assigned to Single-A Bradenton on Saturday, July 19 at Jupiter.

Right hander **Clevari Tejada** will toe to rubber for the Marauders in game five of the series for his team-leading 22nd start. Over a career-best 84.1 innings this season, Tejada has pitched to a 4.80 ERA and completed five innings or more six times. Last Saturday vs Daytona, he completed four innings of four-run ball. Over his five outings in July, Tejada was dominant, allowing just four earned runs over 19 innings of work (1.89 ERA). However, the right hander has struggled in August, allowing 13 ER over his four outings (8.16 ERA). Tejada's fastball saw a major uptick in velocity in July, as he averaged 94.9 miles per hour and topped out at 96.9 - good for his hardest pitch of the season. 12 of his 13 hardest thrown pitches this year have come during his last five outings. Tejada's slider has been a plus offering to both left-and-right-handed hitters, as opposing batters at just 8-for-47 against it (.170, 41.2% Whiff). His splitter has also surrendered just nine hits this season (.196) and has generated a 35.8 percent whiff rate. Overall this season, Tejada has seen an increase in swing-and-miss (19.3% K, +2.5% from 2024) and decrease in walks (9.6% BB, -1.9% from 2024).
