YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Akron RubberDucks, 3-2, at Canal Park. The RubberDucks took a 2-0 lead in the first inning with a two-run homer by Micah Pries, the only two runs allowed by **Matt Frisbee** in his seven-inning outing. **Brett Auerbach** tied the game with a two-run homer in the top of the third. In the top of the fifth, **Brandon Martorano** hit a solo homer, his seventh of the year, to give Richmond a 3-2 lead. Akron loaded the bases with one out in the bottom of the seventh, but Frisbee struck out Bo Naylor and George Valera to escape the jam. The RubberDucks loaded the bases with one out again in the bottom of the ninth, but reliever **Chris Wright** got the second out with a pop up and struck out Braynan Rocchio to end the game.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series looking to gain ground in the standings against the division leading Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. This series is the second between the two teams this season. From May 3-8, the Flying Squirrels won the first three games against the RubberDucks in a series at The Diamond and dropped the final three for a split. After this week, the two teams will meet for one more six-game series, which will be August 23-28 at Canal Park.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won back-to-back games after losing nine of their previous 12. Last week, they lost four-of-six in a series at home against Hartford, their first series loss at home this year and second straight set dropped. The Flying Squirrels dropped out of first place in the Eastern League's Southwest Division on May 22. Thursday's loss dropped the Flying Squirrels back to third place in the Southwest Division. The Flying Squirrels have won four series, lost three and split one this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 506 strikeouts. Richmond pitchers lead the league with 199 walks issued.

THE RUBBERDUCKS have gone 16-6 since May 6. Prior to losing on Sunday and Tuesday, the RubberDucks had not lost consecutive games since dropping three straight against the Flying Squirrels at The Diamond from May 3-5. The hot stretch has moved Akron into first place in the Eastern League's Southwest Division, one game ahead of Erie and two in front of Richmond. The RubberDucks are the defending Double-A Northeast champions after picking up their sixth league title since 2003 last year. This year's Akron roster includes nine of MLB.com's top-30 Cleveland prospects, including RHP Daniel Espino (1 - on IL), OF George Valera (2), INF Braynan Rocchio (4), LHP Logan Allen (8), INF Jose Tena (9), RHP Tanner Burns (11 - on IL), C Bo Naylor (15), RHP Xzavion Curry (22) and RHP Ethan Hankins (24 - on IL).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Kai-Wei Teng** makes his 10th start of the season and his third against Akron. He last pitched last Thursday at The Diamond against Hartford and allowed three runs with seven strikeouts in a loss. On the year, Teng is 0-1 with a 4.50 ERA (5 ER/10.0 IP) against the RubberDucks. He faced them at The Diamond on May 3 and allowed three runs (two earned) over six innings with a season-high nine strikeouts. He also started the finale of that series on May 8 and allowed six runs (three earned) in four innings in a loss. Teng spent the entire 2021 season with the High-A Eugene Emeralds, going 5-6 with a 4.33 ERA in 21 starts. For the season, Teng led the High-A West with 142 strikeouts, ranked tied for second with 21 games started, tied for first with one complete game and sixth with 95.2 innings pitched. He also ranked fourth in the Giants system in strikeouts. Teng was originally signed by the Minnesota Twins out of Taiwan in 2017. During his second season in 2018, he was traded to the Giants along with outfielder Jaylin Davis in exchange for right-handed pitcher Sam Dyson. **For more on Teng, see page two.**

FOR AKRON: Left-hander Joey Cantillo makes his ninth appearance of the year and his eighth start. Last time out, he pitched five scoreless innings and allowed one hit with seven strikeouts in a no-decision against New Hampshire on Thursday. Cantillo faced the Flying Squirrels on May 6 at The Diamond and pitched five scoreless innings. After going 0-2 with a 5.73 ERA in his first three starts of the season, Cantillo has gone 2-0 in his last five appearances (four starts) and has not allowed a run, spanning 22.0 innings with 33 strikeouts and four walks. For the season, Cantillo is ranked tied for eighth in the league with 52 strikeouts. Cantillo was selected in the 16th round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the Padres out of Kailua High School in Hawaii. He was traded to Cleveland on August 31, 2020 along with Austin Hedges, Cal Quantrill, Josh Naylor, Gabriel Arias and Owen Miller in exchange for Mike Clevinger, Greg Allen and a PTBNL.

LOPSIDED: On the year, the Flying Squirrels have the worst run differential in the Southwest Division at -23 runs. In their last 14 losses dating back to April 27, the Flying Squirrels have fallen by an average of 6.4 runs. Of those 14 losses, four have been by 10-or-more runs, including a 10-0 shutout to the Baysox on April 27, a 12-1 loss at Harrisburg on May 15, a 12-2 loss at Altoona on May 17 and a 19-8 loss on May 22 at Altoona, which tied the franchise record for runs allowed in a game. Richmond has scored two-or-less runs in six of their last 14 losses.

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (6,054) and total attendance (139,242). Richmond is 10th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night is the largest crowd in all of Double-A this year and the largest of all non-Triple-A teams this season.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 61 home runs this season, which is second in the Eastern League behind Somerset (65). **Sean Roby** is third in the league with 12 homers on the season, with 10 coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 183 home runs.

BRETT'S BASHING: **Brett Auerbach** has homered in back-to-back games. He went deep in the Flying Squirrels' 22-7 win on Sunday over Hartford, one of a franchise-record seven homers in the game for the team. He hit a two-run homer on Tuesday at Akron to tie the game in a 3-2 win. Auerbach has picked up at least one RBI in seven-of-his-last-10 games since May 19, totaling 10 RBIs.

MARTY PARTY: Over his last 16 games played since May 11, **Brandon Martorano** has hit .339 (20-for-59) with five homers, three doubles, two triples and 13 RBIs. On May 11 at Harrisburg, he clubbed the second grand slam of his career. He returned to the lineup two days later and lifted the Flying Squirrels to a 6-5 win in extras with a sac fly in the 10th inning. On May 14 at Harrisburg, he homered twice for the first time in his career, knocking a go-ahead, three-run homer in the sixth and a solo shot for an insurance run in the ninth inning. He added a solo homer in last Sunday's series finale at Altoona. Martorano hit a go-ahead, solo homer on Tuesday at Akron in a 3-2 win.

TOASTY: **Frankie Tostado** is batting .349 (44-for-126) with seven homers, seven doubles and 21 RBIs over his last 32 games since April 22. From April 22-May 4, he posted a 10-game hitting streak, which was tied for the longest in the league this year at the time. On May 11, he tied a career high with four hits against the Senators. On the year, he has picked up at least one hit in 35 of his 42 games played. In the Eastern League, Tostado is ranked second in batting average (.329), 10th in SLG (.518), ninth in OPS (.887), second in hits (54) and fourth in total bases (85).

ROBUST: With two homers on Sunday, **Sean Roby** held his spot in third in the league with 12 home runs this season. He also set a new Flying Squirrels record with his third multi-homer game of the season. He has hit 10 homers at The Diamond this season, which is tied for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history with **Adam Duvall** (2013). Roby hit eight homers over a 15-game stretch from April 10-29. He had hit just one homer over a 16-game stretch from April 30-May 25 prior to knocking three in his last five games since Thursday.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Frankie Tostado** is ranked second in batting average (.329), 10th in SLG (.518), ninth in OPS (.887), second in hits (54) and fourth in total bases (85). **Sean Roby** is third in home runs (12). **Shane Matheny** ranked ninth in batting average (.302), fifth in OBP (.413), seventh in SLG (.538) and fourth in OPS (.951). **Ryan Walker** is first in wins (6) and **Solomon Bates** is tied for third (4). **Chris Wright** is tied for fourth in saves (5). **Taylor Rashi** is tied for sixth in games pitched (16).

WHERE THE DUCKS RANK: In the Eastern League, Will Brennan is seventh in batting average (.311), first in RBIs (39), 10th in OPS (.886), tied for seventh in doubles (12). Bo Naylor is sixth in OBP (.411) and fifth in walks (29). George Valera is seventh in walks (26) and fourth in runs (32). Jose Tena is fifth in hits (51), tied for sixth in triples (3) and eighth in runs (29). Nic Enright is second in saves (8).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **Will Wilson** (16), **R.J. Dabovich** (17) and **Chris Wright** (27). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." **Simon Whiteman** is listed as the system's "Fastest Baserunner." Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Dabovich (16), Wilson (21), **Brett Auerbach** (27) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (30). Harrison is *Baseball America's* No. 64 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 45 overall prospect.

MAY WRAP: The Flying Squirrels finished the month of May in third place in the Southwest Division, two games behind first-place Akron and a game behind second-place Erie. In their 26 games in May, the Flying Squirrels went 13-13. The pitching staff ranked 10th in the league with a 5.26 ERA and led the league with 116 walks. The offense hit .233 for the month, which ranked 11th in the EL but led the league with 36 homers. In May games, **Shane Matheny** ranked sixth in the EL in batting average (.329), sixth in OBP (.420), third in SLG (.629) and third in OPS (1.049). **Frankie Tostado** ranked tied for fourth in the league in homers (4) and seventh in batting average (.323), ninth in SLG (.566), tied for second in hits (32) and tied for second in total bases (56). **Brandon Martorano** was eighth in SLG (.575) and tied for sixth in runs (19). **Mike Gigliotti** ranked tied for fourth in stolen bases (8). **Taylor Rashi** was tied for third in games pitched (10). **Matt Frisbee** was 10th in innings pitched (26.2). **Bryan Brickhouse** ranked 10th in BAA (.217).
