#15 Aaron Bracho #25 Jhonkensy Noel #30 Xzavion Curry SUNDAY: The Captains rode a six-run seventh inning to a come-from-behind 7-5 win over the Dayton Dragons. A grand slam by Jonathan Willems in the top of the sixth broke a 1-1 tie and gave Dayton a 5-1 lead. In the bottom of the seventh, three Dragons pitchers combined to allow six runs on one hit. The inning included three walks (one intentional), two hit batsmen, three wild pitches and one error. The error by first baseman Juan Martinez was the most costly play of the inning. With two outs, the bases loaded and the Captains trailing by one, Dayton second baseman Ivan Johnson made a diving stop on a **Julian Escobedo** grounder, but Martinez dropped the throw. Two runs scored to give the Captains the lead. The win gave the Captains a 3-3 series split with Dayton.

PLAYOFF PICTURE: The Captains enter today 2.0 game behind the Cedar Rapids Kernels for the second playoff spot in the High-A Central League (HAC). Lake County, the Great Lakes Loons and the Cedar Rapids Kernels are all separated by just 2.0 games. The Quad Cities River Bandits have clinched the top seed. The top two teams in the HAC earn playoff bids (regardless of division).

TIEBREAKER WATCH: The Captains can clinch a playoff spot if they A) finish with an equal or better record than the Cedar Rapids Kernels AND B) finish with a better record than the Great Lakes Loons. The Loons own the headto-head tiebreaker over the Captains (15-9). The Captains did not play Cedar Rapids this year, but would own the second tiebreaker over the Kernels (best winning percentage over the final 20 games).

RUNNERS STRANDED: The Captains struggled with runners in scoring position last series. Lake County batted .107 (6-for-56) with men in scoring position and left 41 runners aboard.

SLUMPING: The Captains' offense has the league's lowest team batting average (.186) in September. Six Captains hitters with 20+ plate appearances this month have batting averages under .200.

Christian Cairo: Slashing .294/.379/.471 (.850 OPS) with two homers and three doubles in 15 games since being promoted from Low-A Lynchburg on August 24.

Jhonkensy Noel: Slashing .313/.382/.613 (.994 OPS) in his first 21 games with the Captains since being promoted from Low-A Lynchburg on August 17. Across three levels this year (Rookie, Low-A & High-A), Noel leads all Cleveland minor leaguers in batting average (.355), wRC+ (171), OPS (1.044), slugging percentage (.641), BABIP .399) and ISO (.286).

Quentin Holmes: While Holmes is only hitting .190 in nine September games, he also has an .917 OPS in that span. Holmes is slashing .190/.393/.524 in that stretch with seven walks and five steals. Last Friday, Holmes hit his first home run since June 11.

José Tena: Tena is hitting .194 (7-for-36) over his last 10 games with 14 strikeouts and two walks. Joe Donovan: Donovan is 3-for-28 (.107) over his last 10 games. Two of his three hits are home runs. Raynel Delgado: Delgado is 3-for-29 (.103) in his last eight games.

NEW BLOOD: 3B Jhonkensy Noel joined the Captains on August 17. The 20-year old led all of Low-A (minimum 160 PA) with a .393 batting average and a 190 wRC+, while hitting 11 homers. INF Christian Cairo and OF Jonathan Rodríguez joined the Captains on August 24. Cairo led Low-A Lynchburg with 37 walks and held a .364 on-base percentage, which led all Hillcats (minimum 200 PA). Rodríguez slashed .314/.363/.450 with the Hillcats, good for an .812 OPS

LAST TIME OUT: Coulter earned the win last Tuesday and held Dayton to just one unearned run over five innings. After hitting Jacob Hurtubise with a pitch to lead off the game, Coulter set down 11 batters in a row. He allowed just three more baserunners on two hits and another hit batsman. The lone run against Coulter came in the first when Hurtubise stole second, reached third on a throwing error by the catcher and scored on a ground out. The Captains beat Dayton, 6-1.

2019: Across 18 appearances Coulter compiled 36.1 innings out of the bullpen in the Arizona league and finished the season with a 2.23 ERA. After allowing at least one earned run in his first four appearances Coulter found his rhythm in July, only giving up one earned run eight appearances and 14.1 innings in the month. He began to stretch his arm out in August finishing the season with three straight appearances in which he threw three or more innings.

BEAR DOWN: Coulter had an up and down career at Mercer where he finished with a career 4.74 ERA. He bounced back and forth between a starting role and the bullpen where he accumulated five saves across his four-year career, including three as a senior in the first three games of the Bears season. His best season came as a senior. After starting the year in the bullpen he was moved to the rotation where he made 11 consecutive starts before bouncing back to the 'pen to finish the season. He completed the 2019 season with a career best 3.90 ERA.

THREE SPORT STAR: While at Buford High School Coulter starred as a basketball player and runner on the cross country team as well as the diamond. In 2015 he led the Wolves to a state championship his senior season.
