TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and El Paso Chihuahuas (San Diego Padres) get ready for game five of the six-game series tonight at Dell Diamond. First pitch is slated for 7:15 p.m. CT.

ANOTHER E-TRAIN WIN

The Express picked up an 8-2 win over the Chihuahuas on Friday night. The E-Train plated two runs on four hits in the bottom of the first inning. 2B Justin Foscue led off with a base hit and later scored on DH Cody Freeman's single up the middle. LF Trevor Hauver drove Freeman in with a single and the Express led 2-0 after one. El Paso got a run back in the top of the second. C Rodolfo Durán sent 3B Mike Brosseau around with a single up the middle cutting the Chihuahuas deficit to 2-1. In the top of the third, El Paso LF Trenton Brooks tied it up at two apiece with an RBI single. Round Rock reclaimed the lead in the bottom of the frame on C Cooper Johnson's base hit that sent 1B Blaine Crim around for a 3-2 lead. Express DH Justin Foscue belted a two-run homer in the bottom of the fourth, extending the Round Rock advantage to 5-2. Hauver led off the fifth with his second hit of the night and Johnson got aboard with a walk. 3B Alan Trejo cleared the bags with a three-run round-tripper to make it 8-2 where the score stood final as the Express earned the victory.

PLASSMEYER ON THE BUMP

LHP Michael Plassmeyer is scheduled for his 14th appearance and fourth start. In his three starts this year, Plassmeyer owns a 3.00 ERA (3 ER/9.0 IP). Since May 4 in eight appearances and two starts, the left-hander is 2-0 with a 2.42 ERA (7 ER/26.0 IP) while posting 11 walks and 27 strikeouts.

THE WINS ARE PILING UP

The Express collected their first three-game winning streak since they won five consecutive games from April 19-24. With a win tonight or tomorrow, Round Rock will collect their first series win since April 15-20 at Reno. It would be their first home series win since April 1-6 vs Toledo. With a win tonight, they will be at the .500 mark for the first time since May 8 (18-18).

THE OFFENSE IS FEELING IT

Since May 23, the Round Rock offense leads all of Triple-A in runs scored (145) with an average of 7.6 runs per game in the last 19 contests. In June, the Express offense continues to pace the PCL in home runs (20), runs (88) and OPS (.907). Round Rock has recorded multiple home runs in seven games this month. They owned just 10 multi-homer games on May 31.

LIMITING THE LONG BALL

Round Rock pitchers recorded their 28th game this season without surrendering a home run. They've allowed a league-low seven home runs in 15 games since May 27, all of which came from the Salt Lake Bees. The last home run they allowed at Dell Diamond came May 18 vs Oklahoma City.

FREEMAN KEEPS IT GOING

INF Cody Freeman extended his hitting streak to 14 games which is the second-longest active streak in Triple-A. He also owns a 17-game on-base streak dating back to May 23.

BIG LEAGUE EXPERIENCE

In total, 22 of the 31 players on the Opening Day roster have logged Major League service time in their careers, including 14 of the 18 pitchers on the staff, Barlow (Rangers), RHP Caleb Boushley (Brewers, Twins), RHP David Buchanan (Phillies, Reds), RHP JT Chargois (Twins, Dodgers, Mariners, Rays, Marlins), Dunning (White Sox, Rangers), RHP Codi Heuer (Cubs, White Sox), RHP Adrian Houser (Brewers, Mets), Latz (Rangers), Pennington (Rangers, Royals), LHP Michael Plassmeyer (Phillies), Robert (Rangers), RHP Hunter Strickland (Giants, Mariners, Nationals, Mets, Rays, Angels, Brewers, Reds, Angels) and Winn (Rangers). EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2025 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's third season with the E-Train. In 2024, Davis secured his 800th win as a manager on July 12 at Reno. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided the E-Train to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games from August 8-23.

Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 744-665 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
