CHIHUAHUAS BITE IN GAME TWO

The Chihuahuas took yestersay's day game by a final of 12-4. DH Jake Cronenworth walked and scored on a LF Tirso Ornelas single for a 1-0 El Paso lead. Ornelas opened the fourth with a double. C Rodolfo Duran singled to send Ornelas home. El Paso broke it open with a three-run inside-the-park home run from SS Clay Dungan and the Chihuahuas led 5-0. In the fifth, 2B Nate Mondou belted and RBI single. Duran drew a bases-loaded walk and Ornelas came in to extend the El Paso lead to 7-0. Round Rock got on the board in the sixth. 1B Justin Foscue's double down the left field line scored SS Jonathan Ornelas. 3B Cody Freeman and RF Kellen Strahm both recorded RBI singles and the Express trailed 7-3. El Paso CF Forrest Wall walked and stole second. 1B Trenton Brooks smoked a single and Wall came home for an 8-3 Chihuahuas lead after six. In the seventh, Wall recorded a double and Rosario scored from second, making it 9-3, 1B Jake Burger got on with a single in the eighth. CF Sam Haggerty grounded out and scored Burger to cut into the 9-4 El Paso lead. Rosario hit a sacrifice fly in the bottom of the eighth and Duran's two-run double sent it to a 12-4 final score.

HOUSER ON THE HILL

Express RHP Adrian Houser will make his sixth start for the E-Train on Thursday. Houser owns a 1-2 record and a 7.36 ERA (21 ER/25.2 IP). His last outing came in game one of a doubleheader with Sugar Land on May 3. Houser took his second loss on 4.0 innings while allowing four runs and five hits with a strikeout and a walk.

HEATING UP

In the last seven days, Round Rock is batting .290 (58-200) which ranks second in the Pacific Coast League. The E-Train have belted nine homers in that span while slugging .490. They are 2-4 in the last six games but have outscored opponents 33-32 in that stretch.

CODY'S COOKING

INF Cody Freeman has recorded a league-best 11 hits in the past week. Freeman leads the Express with a .327 (34-104) average that ranks seventh in the PCL. He's recorded at least two hits in four of his last five games and an RBI in all five.

FOSS IS HOT

INF Justin Foscue sits atop the PCL with a 1.300 OPS in May. In five games this month, he is slashing .333/.411/.504 with a double, two home runs, five RBI, five runs scored, five walks and one strikeout. The infielder leads the club in hits (36), RBI (19), walks (21), runs scored (20) and total bases (59). He also ranks 10th in the league in on-base percentage (.411).

BACK UP TO THE BIG LEAGUES

Express INF Ezequiel Duran was recalled to Texas today after OF Kevin Pillar was placed on the 10-day Injured List with lower back inflammation. Duran slashed .345/.390/.673 with six doubles, four home runs, four RBI, 13 runs scored, four walks and 13 strikeouts.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2025 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's third season with the E-Train. In 2024, Davis secured his 800th win as a manager on July 12 at Reno. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided the E-Train to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games from August 8-23.

Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 744-665 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
