YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the SeaWolves, 10-6. Richmond opened a 6-0 lead in the second inning. Justin Wishkoski hit a two-run homer, Luis Toribio drove an RBI double, Ismael Munguia belted a two-run homer and a run scored on an error. In the fourth, Munguia hit an RBI single to open a 7-0 lead. Ben Malgeri cut the score to 7-1 with an RBI single in the fourth. In the top of the fifth, Jimmy Glowenke brought in a run with fielder's choice. Munguia added another RBI single with a second run scoring on an error to extend the lead to 10-1. The SeaWolves scored two in the seventh, two in the eighth and one in the ninth to pull the score to 10-6. Dylan Cumming started for Richmond and allowed one run over six innings and five strikeouts, his longest Double-A start, and picked up his second straight winning decision.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels face the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, in the finale of a six-game series. This is the final series between the two teams this year. The Flying Squirrels were swept in a six-game series at UPMC Park back in May. The SeaWolves won four-of-six at The Diamond from May 28-June 2. The Flying Squirrels are looking for a series split with a win.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** are 2-3 in the series after going 4-1 in their previous five games from last Wednesday through Sunday, which followed losing a six-game losing streak from August 14-20. In their last 12 games since August 18, the Flying Squirrels are batting a league-best .277 (113-for-408) and averaging 9.4 hits per game (113 total) and averaging 5.3 runs per game (64 total), also best in the Eastern League. In their last 12 games since August 18, the Flying Squirrels have homered 12 times after hitting six homers in their previous nine games from July 27-August 17.

**THE SEAWOLVES** clinched the Southwest Division's first-half title with a 38-29 record to book their third consecutive postseason appearance. They are in second place in the division standings in the second half. Erie's roster includes three of Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects, including RHP Jackson Jobe (No. 1), INF Hao-Yu Lee (No. 11) and RHP Troy Melton (No. 12). Jobe is rated by Baseball America as having the best control, best changeup, best slider and best fastball in the Tigers system. He is also rated by Baseball America as the No. 5 overall prospect in baseball. MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects list includes four Erie players, including Jobe (No. 2), Lee (No. 8), Melton (No. 12) and RHP Eric Silva (No. 29).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Nick Morreale makes his seventh Double-A appearance and his sixth start of 2024. In the series opener against the SeaWolves on Tuesday, he pitched a Double-A-high five innings and allowed two runs in a losing decision, lowering his Double-A ERA to 1.83. As a starter with Richmond, Morreale has a 1.83 ERA (2 ER/19.2 IP). He combined for eight scoreless innings in his first two Richmond starts on August 3 at Altoona and August 10 against Hartford. Morreale was promoted to Double-A on July 26 after spending parts of four seasons in High-A with the Eugene Emeralds. This year, he went 3-3 with a 3.89 ERA in 25 bullpen appearances for Eugene. Morreale was selected in the 14th round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Georgetown University. For more on Morreale, see page two.

FOR ERIE: Left-hander Carlos Pena makes his 17th start of the season and his fourth against the Flying Squirrels. He started Tuesday's series opener and took a no-hit bid into the sixth inning. He finished his outing with six scoreless, one-hit innings and struck out six. Pena first faced Richmond on May 8 at UPMC Park and threw four scoreless innings. On May 31 at The Diamond, he allowed two runs over six innings in a loss. He has gone 1-1 with a 1.13 ERA (2 ER/16.0 IP). Pena began the season with High-A West Michigan and posted a 2.84 ERA in two outings. He signed with the Tigers in March 2019. He spent all of last year in the Midwest League and went 5-6 with a 3.11 ERA in 24 games (21 starts).

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** The Flying Squirrels have turned 85 groundball double plays this year, which is the most in the Eastern League. Richmond pitcher **John Michael Bertrand** has induced 19 double plays this year, which is the most in the minor leagues. The Flying Squirrels turned four double plays on July 27 against Binghamton, which is tied for the most in a game this season in the league. They matched that feat with four double plays in the first four innings at Harrisburg on August 16 with Bertrand pitching. Those four double plays were tied for the most induced by a pitcher in the Eastern League dating back to 2005, which is the first year those statistics are readily available. It has been accomplished by three other Richmond pitchers, including **Daryl Maday** in 2010, **Clayton Blackburn** twice in 2014 and **Garrett Williams** in 2019. Bertrand's 19 GIDPs this year are tied for the fourth-most in a season in franchise history, trailing 27 by **Craig Westcott** in 2012 (second-most in the Eastern league since at least 2005), 21 by **Clayton Tanner** in 2010 and 20 by **Mike MacDonald** in 2010.

**BERICOTO BASHING:** In his last 60 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .294 (70-for-238) with five homers, 12 doubles, 14 walks and 33 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he had not homered in 34 games before belting a two-run shot on August 9 off the scoreboard in left-center at The Diamond. Bericoto homered again last Friday.

MUN-SHOTS: In his 23 August games, Ismael Munguia batted .353 (30-for-85), third-highest in the Eastern League, with three homers, five doubles and 14 RBIs, adding five stolen bases. He had at least one hit in 18-of-23 games played last month. Last year, he hit .282 over 75 games with the Flying Squirrels. In his Richmond career, Munguia is batting .292 (132-for-452) in 115 games, which is the third-highest career mark in franchise history (min. 450 PA). In his last seven games since August 24, Munguia is batting .400 (10-for-25) with three homers and nine RBIs. He has seven RBIs in his last three games since Thursday.

**GO, DIEGO, GO!:** Diego Velasquez is batting .393 (11-for-28) in his last seven games dating back to August 22, including a four-hit game that day against Altoona. He has four hits in his last two games played with three RBIs. Among Giants full-season Giants minor leaguers this season, Velasquez is ranked third in batting average (.282), third in hits (107), tied for fourth in stolen bases (21), tied for seventh in triples (4), eighth in OBP (.359), ninth in OPS (.741), ninth in total bases (145), and 10th in SLG (.382).

**HOWELL AT THE MOON:** Carter Howell has collected 14 hits in his last nine games since August 21, batting .368 (14-for-38) with a double, seven runs scored. In his last two games since Thursday, he has five hits. In the Eastern League this season, Howell is ranked first in doubles (30), tied for first in triples (6), tied for third in hits (115), fourth in extra-base hits (39), tied for sixth in total bases (166) and 10th in batting average (.281).

**FAMILIAR FACES:** Erie's roster includes two former Flying Squirrels relief pitchers. **Matt Seelinger** pitched for the Flying Squirrels in 2021 and went 3-1 with a 3.07 ERA in 36 appearances. He was also part of the only nine-inning no-hitter in Richmond franchise history on May 13, 2021 at FNB Field in Harrisburg, recording an out in the eighth inning. He spent parts of the 2022 and 2023 seasons in the Eastern League with Reading. He signed with the Tigers in June and joined the SeaWolves. **Eric Silva** began this season with the Flying Squirrels, going 4-2 with a 4.35 ERA in 28 games with two saves. He was swapped to the Tigers at the trade deadline on July 31 in exchange for Mark Canha and joined the SeaWolves.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked 10th among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,543), just shy of the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013).

BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: This season, 12 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is the most in a season in franchise history. In 2014, 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including Joe Panik, Adam Duvall, Andrew Susac, Matt Duffy, Jackson Williams, Edwin Escobar, Hunter Strickland, Chris Dominguez, Gary Brown, Brett Bochy and Chris Heston. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are Erik Miller (2023 Flying Squirrels), Landen Roupp (2022-23), Kai-Wei Teng (2022-23), Nick Avila (2022), Randy Rodriguez (2022-23), Mason Black (2023), Gerson Garabito (2021), Spencer Bivens (2023), Raymond Burgos (2023), Hayden Birdsong (2023-24), Parker Dunshee (2023) and Grant McCray (2024). Dating back to 2022, 21-of-the-last-23 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers) and Dunshee (Braves) being the only exceptions. Last year saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** Two of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 11) and SS **Diego Velasquez** (No. 26). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, LHP **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features two Richmond players, including Velasquez (No. 17) and LHP **Jack Choate** (No. 21).
