NOTES AND NUGGETS

2ND HALF SLUGGERS

While Omaha has had a slow start to the 2nd half, a couple of hitters have had a hot start offensively to the back half of the season.

✦ **Carter Jensen** joined Omaha for the 2nd half and despite a slow start, he leads the club with 8 homers and 22 RBI since arriving and ranks 2nd with 49 total bases, with 12 of 21 hits going for extra-bases ... his 13 walks lead the team, while batting .244 (21-for-86) with the Storm Chasers.

✦ **Dairon Blanco** is hitting .269 (21-for-78) since June 24 ... like Jensen, 12 of his 21 hits have gone for extra-bases, with 7 doubles, 1 triple and 4 home runs ... his 42 total bases are 3rd on the team this half.

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

The Storm Chasers are not near the league lead in stolen bases, but Omaha has one of the highest success rates on the basepaths in the Minors.

✦ Omaha has successfully stolen 129 bases this year, and only been caught 24 times ... 129 steals rank 6th in the International League and 10th in Triple-A.

✦ 129-for-153 in steal attempts is a 84.3% success rate, tied for the best stolen base rate at the Triple-A level and tied 5th-best among the 120 full-season Minor League teams (1st: New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 86.5%, 90-for-104).

WHAT A RELIEF

While Omaha's starting pitching has struggled at times in 2025, the bullpen has stepped up to help win games for the Storm Chasers.

✦ Omaha's relievers have combined for a 4.85 ERA (252 ER in 467.2 IP), while the starting pitchers have pitched to a 6.02 ERA (288 ER in 430.1 IP) ... the starters rank 19th of the 20 teams in the IL in ERA, while the bullpen ranks 14th ... the relievers are 4th in the league in K/9 (10.06) and K/BB (2.28).

✦ The bullpen has combined for 21 scoreless efforts, including back-to-back games Tuesday and Wednesday, for 8.0 consecutive scoreless innings against the Bats ... these were the first 2 scoreless games from the bullpen in July.

✦ Omaha's 2nd-longest scoreless bullpen effort this year came against the Bats, 13.2 innings from May 7 to 10 at Louisville Slugger Field, with 3 hits and 1 walk allowed with 23 strikeouts.

LOUISVILLE SLUGGER

Since last year, **Drew Waters** has had more success against the Louisville Bats than any other International League player.

✦ In 20 games against the Bats between 2024 and 2025, Waters is hitting .419 (31-for-74) with 14 extra-base hits (7 doubles, 2 triples, 5 homers) and 16 RBI.

✦ Waters has .494 on-base percentage and .770 slugging percentage, for a 1.264 OPS against the Bats ... all of those marks are the highest among 38 players with at least 60 plate appearances against the Bats since 2024.

✦ When Louisville came to Werner Park in April, Waters was the International League Player of the Week, going 10-for-26 (.526 average) with a league-best 20 total bases, including hitting for the cycle on April 2 ... ended the 2024 regular season with 4 straight 3-hit games in Louisville, named the IL Player of the Week.

NEVER GONNA GIVE YOU UP

Dallas Keuchel made his Storm Chasers debut July 12, becoming the latest player with significant Major League service time to appear in a game for Omaha in 2025.

✦ With 10 years and 30 days of MLB service, Keuchel is the 2nd most-experienced MLB pitcher to play for Omaha this year, trailing only **Rich Hill** (14 years, 141 days MLB service), who made 9 Omaha starts ... Keuchel is the 11th player to appear in a game for the Chasers this year with 4 or more years of MLB service (through 2024).

✦ **Joey Krehbiel**'s Omaha debut last Thursday makes him the 15th player to appear in a game for Omaha this year at the age of 30 or older ... by comparison, Omaha had 9 players in their 30's appear in a game both last year and in 2023.

JETTING OFF WITH JENSEN

Carter Jensen has been one of the hottest hitters in the Minors since the calendar flipped to July, after a slow start to his time in Triple-A.

✦ Among 761 Minor League hitters that have taken at least 70 plate appearances in July, Jensen ranks 7th in OPS (1.132) and 8th in slugging percentage (.703).

✦ In 18 July games, Jensen hit .318 (20-for-64) with 4 doubles, 7 homers and 21 RBI, with 13 walks ... his 21 RBI last month were tied for the 6th-most in the IL.

ALL QUIET ON THE OMAHA FRONT

The Omaha Storm Chasers played from behind nearly all week in Syracuse last week, having led for just a few innings in the 6-game sweep by the Mets.

✦ After leading for 18 of 27 innings in Buffalo out of the MLB All-Star Break, Omaha led for 7 of 54 innings last week in Syracuse ... the Mets led for 42 of 54 innings.

TODAY'S START

- Bosacker is making his **3rd Triple-A start** and **7th Triple-A appearance** today, on his 3rd stint with Omaha in 2025 ... this is his **11th overall start** and **20th appearance in the Minors this year** ... this is his first start since June 6 vs. Iowa.
- He opened the year with Northwest Arkansas (AA), and has previously been with the Storm Chasers from May 17 to 26 and June 5 to 9, most recently, assigned to Omaha on July 18.
- Was called up for a spot start in Omaha on May 17, pitched out of the bullpen the next week and was sent back to Double-A for one start before re-joining the Storm Chasers for another spot start on June 6 ... he has made 3 appearances out of Omaha's bullpen (5.2 IP) since the All-Star break.
- Playing his 3rd professional season this year, all have come in the Royals organization.
- Among 31 Royals Minor League pitchers that have thrown at least 150.0 innings since 2023, Bosacker ranks 3rd in ERA (3.28), 5th in WHIP (1.18) and 6th in BB/9 (2.67).

LAST OUTING: WEDNESDAY, JULY 30 vs. LOUISVILLE

Made his 3rd straight relief appearance with Omaha since joining the Storm Chasers out of the All-Star break, his shortest outing of the year, first time throwing less than 2.0 innings and fewer than 35 pitches ... pitched a scoreless 7th inning, working around a leadoff double from Ryan Villeda.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- Earned the win in his Double-A debut, pitching the 2nd game of the season for the Northwest Arkansas Naturals (AA), on April 5 @ Tulsa (LAD) ... allowed 2 earned runs over 5.0 innings with 4 strikeouts.
- Threw at least 5.0 innings in his first 8 starts, including his first 7 starts for NWA.
- Made his Triple-A debut May 17 vs. Columbus (CLE) ... kept the Clippers to 2 runs over the first 5.0 innings, but loaded the bases without getting an out in the 6th, was charged with the loss.
- After starter John Gant could not get out of the first inning on May 23 @ Salt Lake (LAA), worked 3.0 scoreless innings of relief, retiring 9 of 11 batters between the 4th and 6th, with a pair of hits and pair of strikeouts.
- Made a spot start for Omaha June 5 vs. Iowa (CHC), Game 2 of a doubleheader against the Cubs, pitching into the 5th inning and allowing just 2 runs.
- After the spot start against Iowa, returned to Double-A on June 10 and made 5 appearances out of the Naturals' bullpen in a long relief role, allowing 5 ER in 25.0 IP (1.80 ERA) over 5 relief outings between June 13 and July 11 ... pitched behind starter Steven Zobac in the first 4 appearances, then threw 7.0 innings of relief on July 11 vs. Midland (ATH) after starter Ben Kudrna only pitched 1.0 innings.

CAREER NOTES

- 2024**

 - Let all Royals minor leaguers with a 2.45 ERA (34 ER in 124.2 IP) and 13 wins across 24 games (18 starts) split between the Columbia Fireflies (A) and Quad Cities River Bandits (A+) ... totaled 7 quality starts between the two levels.
 - Recognized as the 2024 Quad Cities (High-A) Pitcher of the Year, going 7-1 with a 1.97 ERA (11 ER in 50.1 IP) over 9 starts ... worked one scoreless outing, but never allowed more than 2 earned runs as a starter for the River Bandits.
 - Named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Month in August after going 5-0 with a 1.80 ERA (6 ER in 30.0 IP), 20 strikeouts and just 5 walks in 5 starts.
 - August 15 @ Beloit (MIA), he struck out a career-high 12 batters in 7.0 innings of scoreless work, retiring his first 20 batters faced, until a two-out single in the 7th inning.
 - Closed out the regular season with a career-best 34.0 consecutive innings without allowing a home run, from July 21 through his final outing of the regular season on September 5 ... did not allow a long ball over his final 7 starts.
 - Started Game 2 of the postseason for Quad Cities and held the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (MIL) to just 2 runs over 5.0 innings, but the River Bandits suffered a walk-off loss to be swept in the Division Series, 2-0.

- 2023**

 - Made his professional debut on August 14, 2023 with the ACL Royals, his first of 2 relief appearances in the Arizona Complex League to begin his pro career.

COLLEGE (XAVIER UNIVERSITY, 2020-2023)

- Spent parts of three seasons over four years at Xavier University ... appeared in 33 games (26 starts) and went 12-8 with a 4.16 ERA (77 ER in 166.0 IP) with 160 strikeouts.
- Started his collegiate career in the COVID-shortened 2020 season, missed the entirety of the 2022 season due to injury.
- Played his best baseball in the BIG EAST as a senior in 2023, where he worked a 3.49 ERA (38 ER in 98.0 IP), going 8-3 as a full-time starter, receiving All-BIG EAST honors.
- Was committed to transfer to Oklahoma State for his final season of collegiate baseball, but was selected by the Kansas City Royals in the 13th Round of the 2023 MLB Draft and chose to forgo his final season of collegiate eligibility and instead play professionally.

- 2019:** Graduated from Monticello High School in Minnesota, where he was a Four-year varsity letterman as right-handed pitcher ... 2018 All-Conference selection as a sophomore and junior and named to the 2018 WWBA 17u National Championship All-Tournament Team.

- Is an avid duck hunter, who often shares Instagram stories (@ethanbosacker) alongside his brother, Campbell Bosacker, showcasing their harvest.
