LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones earned their third-straight win, 2-0, on Tuesday night in Wilmington...RHP **Jack Wenninger** (5.0+ IP, 2 H, 8 K), LHP **Ryan Ammons** (2.2 IP, 4 K), and RHP **Eduardo Herrera** (1.1 IP, 4 K) combined on a two-hit shutout with 16 strikeouts...The shutout was the 12th of the year for Brooklyn's pitching staff, setting a new single-season franchise record...Wenninger earned his first High-A victory, while Herrera earned his second save...The Cyclones scored the game's two runs on a fielder's choice throwing error and a 1B **Junior Tilen** RBI single in the top of the third...CF **Nick Morabito** picked up a pair of hits for the Cyclones...RHP **José Atencio** suffered the loss for Wilmington despite earning a quality start with 7.0 innings of two-run ball...Both runs were unearned.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES' HISTORY: On August 14, 2002, New York Mets first-round pick LHP **Scott Kazmir** makes his professional debut in Aberdeen, allowing one hit and striking out four over 2.0 innings...In 2004, **Ambioris Concepción** set the single-game franchise record with three doubles vs. Aberdeen...The feat has been matched five times...On the same day, RHP **Franklin Núñez** became the fourth former Cyclone to appear in the Major Leagues when he debuts with 1.1 innings for the Tampa Bay Devil Rays...In 2013, Brooklyn erased a 1-0 eighth-inning deficit, tying the game on a SS **Gavin Cecchini** sacrifice fly and taking the lead on a wild pitch and DH **Matt Oberste**'s RBI single in a 3-1 victory vs. Hudson Valley...In 2018, RF **Ross Adolph** went 2-for-3 with a two-run triple and a solo home run en route to New York-Penn League All-Star Game MVP honors in a 7-1 triumph for the South Division All-Stars over the North at State College's Medlar Field at Lubrano Park...In 2022, the Cyclones scored two runs in the top of the ninth to defeat Wilmington on the road, 6-5...**Matt O'Neill** provided the go-ahead, pinch-hit two-run home run for the 900th win in franchise history.

A DOZEN DONUTS: Brooklyn's 2-0 win at Wilmington on Tuesday night marked the team's 12th shutout of the year, setting a new single-season franchise record...The Cyclones tied the 2023 squad's franchise record with its 11th shutout in July 14's 5-0 win at Wilmington...The Cyclones have blanked Wilmington in their last two matchups and have thrown 21 consecutive scoreless frames against them dating back to the fifth inning on July 13...The 12 shutouts are two behind Rome (14) for the most in the South Atlantic League.

NONE SHALL PASS: The Cyclones' bullpen has been near perfect since Sunday's doubleheader vs. Hudson Valley...Brooklyn relievers have not allowed a hit in 10.0 consecutive innings with 17 strikeouts since SS **George Lombard Jr.**'s two-out single in the eighth inning on Saturday night...RHP **Eduardo Herrera**, LHP **Ryan Ammons**, RHP **Jordany Ventura**, and RHP **Alan Perdomo** combined to retire 22 hitters in a row from one out in the ninth inning on Saturday until one out in the eighth inning on Tuesday.

TO SMITH-EREENS: UT **D'Andre Smith** has been blasting the ball across the diamond since returning from the 7-day injured list on July 22...The 23-year-old is hitting .260/.275/.340 in 14 games since being reinstated but has hit another gear since the calendar flipped to August...In eight games this month, Smith is batting .370/.393/.519 with a .912 OPS, two runs scored, a double, a home run, and three runs batted in...The former fifth-round pick is third in the South Atlantic League in batting average (.370) during August (min. 25 PA)...Smith is currently 7-for-18 (.389) during a five-game hitting streak since the opening game of last Wednesday's doubleheader vs. Hudson Valley.

WENN IN BROOKLYN: RHP **Jack Wenninger** suffered the defeat in his first start at the High-A level, but has quickly figured things out at the classification since...After tossing 5.0-plus innings of shutout ball for his first High-A win on Tuesday, the 22-year-old is a 1-0 with a 1.31 ERA (3 ER in 20.2 IP) and one hold in his last five appearances (four starts) since July 14 at Wilmington...Wenninger has surrendered 15 hits and nine walks while striking out 27 in that span...The Barrington, Ill. native is fourth in the South Atlantic League in ERA (1.31) and sixth in batting average against (.192) in that time.

MORABITO BITE: OF **Nick Morabito** has been outstanding throughout the 2024 season...The McLean, Va. native is tied for seventh in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (49)...With two swipes (39) last Thursday, he broke OF **Omar De Los Santos'** single-season franchise record of 37, which was set last year...Since making his SAL debut on May 7, Morabito has led the league in hits (86), is second in stolen bases (38), tied for second in games played (75), fourth in batting average (.286), sixth in runs scored (50), and 10th in on-base percentage (.362)...The former second-round selection is fourth in the SAL in stolen bases (38) and seventh in batting average (.286) for the season...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.309), stolen bases (49), on-base percentage (.400), and hits (117)...He is also tied for second in runs scored (64), third in total bases (146), tied for third in triples (4), fourth in OPS (.785), and tied for fifth in walks (50).

vs. WILMINGTON: The Cyclones play their final in-division road series of 2024 against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks have two of Washington's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: RHP **Jarlin Susana** (4) and OF **Robert Hassell III** (13)...Hassell is with the club on a Minor League rehab assignment...The Cyclones are 7-9 against the Blue Rocks this season, but just 3-7 at Frawley Stadium...Since moving to the full-season level in 2021, Brooklyn is 49-47 all-time against Wilmington (.510).

THE TONG SONG: RHP **Jonah Tong** has been magnificent for the Cyclones in the last few weeks...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native is second in the circuit and third among all High-A pitchers in strikeouts (93)...The 93 strikeouts are also tied for ninth in the circuit overall...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 80.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is first in FIP (2.13), fourth in strikeout rate (35.2%), seventh in strikeouts (129), and eighth in strikeout-to-walk rate (24.9%).

OMAR-I-GONE: OF **Omar De Los Santos** rejoined Brooklyn's roster on June 24 from Double-A Binghamton...The 24-year-old powered a walk-off solo home run in the bottom of the ninth vs. Rome on July 28 and five of his last six home runs have tied the game or provided Brooklyn the lead...Since the All-Star break, Omar is tied for second in the league in triples (2), tied for third in home runs (5), tied for seventh in extra-base hits (8), eighth in slugging (.523), and tied for ninth in total bases (33)...Despite spending a month at Double-A, De Los Santos is still tied for fifth in the South Atlantic League for the year with 35 stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's then-single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT **Jaylen Palmer's** (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (72) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos is second in the South Atlantic League (72) and is tied for fifth across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (144).

LONG ARM OF THE LAW: RHP **Justin Lawson** tossed a career-high 4.0 innings to earn his second win in Game 2 of August 4's doubleheader at Aberdeen...The 23-year-old allowed just two hits and one walk, striking out four...Lawson has not allowed an earned run in his last 13.0 innings dating back to July 21 vs. Jersey Shore...Since June 15 at Hudson Valley, the Winfield, La. native has composed a 2-2 record and a pristine 0.70 ERA (2 ER in 25.2 IP), earning two saves...No South Atlantic League reliever with 20.0 or more innings pitched since June 15 has a lower ERA than Lawson (0.70).

TAKING KELLUM 123: OF **Kellum Clark** snapped out a 1-for-37 funk at the plate with a three-hit game on July 6 at Hudson Valley and has been on a tear offensively since...The 23-year-old has seven multi-hit efforts in his last 25 games...Since July 6, he has been hitting .294/.368/.329 with nine runs scored, three doubles, three runs batted in, 10 walks, and three stolen bases over the 25 games.

IT'S A WALK-OFF: For the fourth time in 10 home games, Brooklyn earned a walk-off victory thanks to 3B **Jacob Reimer's** two-run single in the bottom of the seventh in Game 1 of Wednesday's double-dip with Hudson Valley...In the Cyclones' previous home game, on July 28 vs. Rome, 3B **Jeffrey De Los Santos** blasted a game-tying two-run home run in the ninth before LF **Omar De Los Santos** followed with a walk-off solo shot in a 7-6 triumph...The back-to-back jacks marked just the second time Brooklyn had accomplished the feat in 2024...SS **William Lugo** and CF **Stanley Consuegra** clubbed consecutive home runs in the sixth inning on May 18 at Bowling Green...It was also Brooklyn's second walk-off home run of the season...3B **Nick Lorusso** smacked a game-ending solo home run in the bottom of the ninth in a 4-3 win vs. Asheville on April 14...The Cyclones also earned walk-off wins in the last 10 home affairs on July 19, via C **Chris Suero's** game-winning bases-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 10th vs. Jersey Shore and, again, on July 24, courtesy of SS **Wilfredo Lara's** walk-off single in the bottom of the 10th vs. Rome...Since the start of the 2023 season, the Cyclones have suffered 18 walk-off losses, accumulating 14.75% of all defeats, including 26.47% of all road losses, while earning 12 walk-off wins...30 of Brooklyn's 240 games since the start of the 2023 season have ended in a walk-off (12.50%)...The Cyclones have also earned 24 wins in their last at-bat.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have five of the Top 30 per BA: INF **Jesus Báez** (10), RHP **Jonah Tong** (17), INF **Jacob Reimer** (22), RHP **Jack Wenninger** (27), and RHP **Calvin Ziegler** (30)...Báez is currently on the 7-day injured list and Ziegler is on the full-season IL...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (10), Báez (14), OF **Nick Morabito** (19), Reimer (20), and Wenninger (30).

LAST TIME OUT: Picked up a fourth-consecutive no-decision last Thursday night vs. Hudson Valley...Game featured a pair of rain delays...Contest was halted due to rain for 12 minutes in the top of the fourth and for 35 minutes in the top of the eighth...Earned a quality start with 6.0 innings of two-run ball...Allowed three hits, walked three, and struck out seven...Induced a double play...Threw 80 pitches and 47 strikes (58.75%)...Relieved by RHP **Luis G. Moreno** to start the top of the seventh and the game tied at two...Cyclones trailed 3-2 entering the ninth and tied the game with back-to-back two-out singles from LF **Nick Morabito** and 2B **D'Andre Smith**... Renegades would defeat Brooklyn, 4-3, in 10 innings, scoring the go-ahead run on a double play.

PROSPECT RADAR: After a stellar 2023 season, De La Cruz was deemed the New York Mets' No. 39 prospect entering the 2024 campaign by *Baseball America*.

LEAGUE LEADER: Entering play on Wednesday, the 23-year-old is tied for fifth in the South Atlantic League in game started (19) and eighth in strikeouts (94).

HOME COOKING: De La Cruz has been outstanding on Coney Island in 2024...Through his first 9 appearances (8 starts) of the campaign, the southpaw is 1-2 with a 2.93 ERA (14 ER in 43.0 IP), 19 walks, and 52 strikeouts...De La Cruz has not seen the same level of success on the road...The 23-year-old holds a 2-4 mark in visiting parks, but yields a 5.80 ERA (26 ER in 40.1 IP), with 17 walks, and 42 strikeouts.

FELIP-IN' AMAZIN': The 23-year-old celebrated his birthday a day early by shutting out Hudson Valley on May 25 over 6.0 innings with a career-high 13 strikeouts...De La Cruz was one shy of the single game Brooklyn franchise record of 14 set by LHP **Mike Cox** (8/25/01 vs. HV) and RHP **Brad Holt** (7/24/08 vs. VER)...He was the first Cyclone to strike out 13+ hitters in a single contest since RHP **Rob Gsellman** accomplished the feat on August 24, 2013, at Vermont... De La Cruz is the sixth Cyclones pitcher ever to hit the 13 punchout threshold and the third to strikeout 13 or more in 6.0 or fewer innings.

WELCOME TO BROOKLYN: The 22-year-old joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie last year on August 22 and thrived over three starts...De La Cruz accumulated a 2-1 record with a 2.45 ERA (5 ER in 17.0 IP) with five walks and 17 strikeouts...The southpaw hurled quality starts in two of his three starts, including going all six innings in the lid-lifter of a doubleheader on August 31 at Greenville...After allowing a leadoff home run, De La Cruz retired 18 of the final 19 batters he faced, including sitting the last 11 down in order...The southpaw was credited with a complete game, the first for a Brooklyn pitcher since RHP **José Butto** accomplished the feat, tossing six innings in a seven-inning loss at Aberdeen in Game 1 of a twinbill on June 30, 2021...After making his SAL debut on August 23 at Asheville, De La Cruz ranked third in the circuit in WHIP (0.94), fifth in batting average against (.183), and sixth in ERA (2.65).

FLORIDA STATE FELIPE: De La Cruz was among the best strikeout artists in the Florida State League in 2023...Among FSL pitchers with 90.0 or more innings pitched, the 22-year-old led the circuit in strikeout rate (28.7%)...The southpaw also led the league in strikeouts-per-9 innings (11.36) and swinging strike rate (15.5%), while ranking 2nd in xFIP (3.68)...In 21 appearances (19 starts) with St. Lucie, De La Cruz was 3-6 with a 4.68 ERA (47 ER in 90.1 IP), 41 walks, and 114 strikeouts.
