MIDLAND, TX — After the Northwest Arkansas Naturals' offense was potent so much of the week, things came to a quiet Sunday, as the Midland RockHounds took the series finale, 3-1 Sunday afternoon.

- Starting pitcher **Angel Zerpa** turned in one of the best starts of his career, a much better outing than the numbers on the surface indicate. The lefty came one away from tying his career high, as he struck out nine, while throwing a career-best 6.2 innings on 94 pitches. It was the longest outing he's ever compiled, his first time throwing over 90 pitches, also the first time he had pitched into the seventh inning.
- Despite a strong start, Zerpa was tagged by Midland for two runs in the third inning and one more in the sixth, as they scattered eight hits across the Venezuelan, while he only walked one.
- Offensively, the Naturals could only muster six hits, including two from leadoff hitter **Maikel Garcia**. **Seuly Matias** reached base three times, drawing two walks and singling. **Jake Means** produced the lone run of the afternoon, as he led off the eighth inning with a solo home run, his third of the season.
- Zack Phillips** relieved Zerpa in the seventh and pitched 1.1 scoreless innings through the end of the game to keep the deficit at two runs, but the Naturals could not close the gap despite bringing the tying run to the plate in the ninth.
- Despite the loss, Northwest Arkansas won the series at Midland, 4-2, while ending the two-week road trip with a split, winning six and losing six.

THIS DAY IN NATURALS HISTORY

The Naturals are 4-7 all-time when playing on May 31

On May 31, 2016, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals beat the San Antonio Missions, 4-1 at Arvest Ballpark in the third game of a five-game win streak. Eight of nine Naturals hitters in the starting lineup had a hit, including four two-hit games. In his fifth Double-A game, second baseman **Corey Toups** hit his first home run, a solo shot that gave the Naturals an early lead, which the team did not relinquish. Center fielder **Terrance Gore** went 2-for-3 with a walk and run scored, also stealing three bases, swiping second after singling in the fourth, then he stole second and third after walking in the eighth.

FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in *Advanced Rookie* Burlington (2019) and *High-A* Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 16 of the Naturals' 27 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- Nine of the Naturals' 27 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: **Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Michael Massey, Jake Means, Drew Parrish, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter** and **Ángel Zepa**.

WHAT YOU KNOW ABOUT PITCHING DEEP?

In the month of May, Naturals starting pitchers have thrown 106.2 innings of the staff's 210.1 total (50.6%), up from 44.3% of the team's April innings.

- As a staff, the Naturals 4.32 ERA in the month of May ranks 2nd in the Texas League, with 12 of 24 starts lasting 5.0 innings or longer and 19 of 24 going 4.0 innings or more.
- In 24 May games, Naturals starting pitchers have a 4.06 ERA (48 ER in 106.2 IP) with 127 strikeouts (10.75 K/9) and a .218 opponents' average.
- Two-time Texas League Pitcher of the Week Drew Parrish has thrown 6.0 innings or more in each of his last EIGHT outings, including four scoreless: 6.0 IP on 4/26 vs. AMA & 5/26 @ MID and 7.0 on 5/7 @ SPR & 5/13 vs. WCH.

EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring six runs or more, the Naturals are 20-3, while when scoring five runs or less, just 2-19.
- The Naturals are 17-4 when recording 10 hits or more, but when they get nine hits or less, are just 5-18.
- The Naturals are 21-7 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 1-15 when out-hit by their opponent.
- When the Naturals score first, they are 16-7, whereas 6-15 when the opponent scores first.

ONE RUN GOES A LONG WAY

The Naturals are 2-10 in one-run games this season, meaning 10 of their 21 losses this season have been decided by just one run.

- Five of the Naturals' last six losses have been by just a run, as well as seven of 12 losses in the month of May.
- The Naturals have had the winning run at the plate in five losses this season (all one-run losses) and had the tying run at the plate or on base in 11 losses this season (including eight of their one-run losses).

TUCKER BRADLEY: PROFESSIONAL HITTER

Tucker Bradley has acted as a second leadoff hitter for much of 2022 for Northwest Arkansas, batting 9th in the order in all 32 games he's started, but that is a spot he has thrived in.

- Bradley ranks among the top hitters in the Royals organization, with the third-highest batting average (.317) among qualified hitters in the system, also ranking third in slugging (.542) and OPS (.925), while fourth in on-base percentage (.383). He also ranks tied second in triples (3), seventh in hits (38) and total bases (54) and tied seventh in extra-base hits (14).
- Two of Tucker's five home runs this year have been grand slams, the first two of his pro career. He extended the Naturals' lead in the fifth inning on April 23 in Frisco with his first grand slam, then broke a scoreless tie to give the Naturals the lead in the fifth inning on May 13 vs. Wichita.

Yo, You WANNA SEE SOME REAL SPEED?

Through 43 games, the Naturals have stolen 62 bases in 73 attempts (average 1.41 steals/game, 84.93% success rate) and pulled off a double steal 10 times.

- 62 steals ranks third in the Texas League, sixth in Double-A and tied 28th in the Minors.
- Maikel Garcia's** 16 steals (in 18 attempts) ranks third in the Texas League and tied seventh in all of Double-A, while **Nate Eaton's** 12 steals (in 13 attempts) ranks tied eighth in the Texas League.

It's GONNA BE MASSEY

Since the calendar flipped to May, second baseman **Michael Massey** has been one of the top hitters in the Texas League, batting at a .366 (34-for-93) average with a .992 OPS across 23 games, while driving in a league-best 28 runs, also tied for the league lead this month with his 34 hits.

- On Sunday, Massey snapped a season-high seven-game hitting streak, with two or more hits in the first five games against Midland, but was named the league's Player of the Week for the second time this year.
- Michael has reached base in 35 of 42 games he's played this year, with already 16 multi-hit games, including 11 in May.
- The second baseman leads not just the Texas League, but all of Double-A with 44 runs batted in, raking 4th in MiLB as well, seven back of Omaha's Vinnie Pasquantino (51) ... he also ranks second in the Texas League in hits (57), fifth in batting average (.328), seventh in total bases (95) and doubles (14) and tied ninth in extra-base hits (22).
- He is scattered all across the Royals' organizational leaders, ranking first in batting average and hits, tied first in doubles, second in runs batted in, extra-base hits, total bases and slugging percentage (.546), tied third in home runs, fourth in OPS (.922) and runs scored (30), and sixth in on-base percentage (.376).
- Massey's turnaround at the plate truly began April 22, when he entered the day hitting just .213 and proceeded to homer in three consecutive games, April 22 to 24 in Frisco ... he went from having no home runs through the first 11 games of the season, to having eight in his last 30e, leading the Naturals in homers.

GAR-SEE YA ON BASE

Shortstop **Maikel Garcia** has reached base in 38 of the 42 games he has played in this season, reaching base twice on 28 occasions, 14 multi-hit games.

- In 200 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 81 times (52 hits + 29 walks), for a .407 on-base percentage.
- Garcia has walked 29 times and struck out 32 times, a 1.10 K/BB rate.
- The shortstop places among the Texas League leaders in several categories, ranking third in steals (16), tied sixth in walks (29), tied seventh in hits (52) and runs scored (35) ... he ranks among the Double-A leader in steals (tied seventh) and runs scored (tied ninth)
- His 14-game hitting streak between April 27 and May 12 is the longest on the Naturals this year and tied for the 15th-longest in club history ... it is also tied for the second-longest in the Texas League this season ... in those 14 games, he hit .397 (23-for-58) with six doubles and a .970 OPS.

PUSHIN (P)ORTER

Catcher **Logan Porter** has quietly flown under the radar as one of the top hitters in the Royals system so far in 2022.

- Among qualified Royals minor league hitters, Porter has the highest on-base percentage (.449), and ranks second in batting average (.327) and OPS (.939) and fourth in slugging percentage (.490).
- Porter has reached base in 27 of 30 games he's played this season, with hits in 21 of 30 and 12 multi-hit games, including nine in May.
- In the month of May, Porter is hitting .358 (24-for-67) with a team-best 1.046 OPS, tied for the team lead with four homers and he had driven in 12 runs and drawn nine walks.

Players of the Week (2)

- April 25 to May 1: 2B Michael Massey ... hit .417 (10-for-28) across six games with a league-best 19 total bases and nine runs batted in, while tied for the Texas League lead with 10 hits. His 1.221 OPS ranked third among players with at least 20 at-bats, while his .417 average tied for second among that same group.
- May 23 to May 29: 2B Michael Massey ... hit a league-best .481 (13-for-27) across six games in Midland, while tied for the league lead with 19 total bases. He drove in nine runs as well, doubling three times with one home run, a go-ahead grand slam on May 24 and collected multiple hits in each of the first five games of the series.

Pitchers of the Week (2)

- May 2 to May 8: LHP Drew Parrish ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 7 @ Springfield ... held the Cardinals to just two hits and one walk while striking out four. He retired the first eight he faced and the final five, with five 1-2-3 frames.
- May 9 to May 15: LHP Drew Parrish ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 13 vs. Wichita ... held the Wind Surge to just three hits and no walks while striking out nine. Between the second and sixth innings, he retired 13 straight batters, retiring the side 1-2-3 in the first inning, as well as the third through sixth.

- Christian Colón returns to the organization as the Naturals Assistant Hitting Coach in 2022, following a 12-year professional career.
- He was the Royals first-round pick in the 2010 MLB Draft, scored the winning run in the 2014 AL Wild Card game and had the game-winning hit in the title-clinching Game 5 of the 2015 World Series.
- After being drafted in 2010, Colón ascended to Northwest Arkansas by 2011 and between 2011, 2012 and 2014, played 202 games for the Naturals ... In 2011, Colón led the Texas League in sacrifices (21), while leading the team in at-bats (491) and hits (126). His 21 sacrifices that season are the most a Naturals player has ever recorded in a single season, while 28 overall are tied for the club record.
- During his playing career, he made stops in Miami (2017) and Cincinnati (2019-20) ... spent 2021 with the Rich Baseball-owned Buffalo Bisons (Triple-A, Toronto) before announcing his retirement.
- He also played in parts of four seasons in the Puerto Rican Winter League.
- Christian lives in Cave Springs, Ark. (15 minutes North of Arvest Ballpark) with his wife, Kayla, and three daughters, Marley, Mia and Lucy.
