**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Yard Goats, 6-4, to clinch a series win. Hartford took a 2-0 lead in the second on a two-run single by GJ Hill. **Charlie Szykowny** lifted a solo homer in the top of the fourth to close the score to 2-1. In the bottom of the fourth, Hill doubled in two runs for a 4-1 Yard Goats lead. **Bo Davidson** hit an RBI single and a run scored on a double-play groundout in the fifth to close Richmond within a run. **Scott Bandura** reached on a single that scored **Jonah Cox** in the sixth to even the score, 4-4. In the seventh, Szykowny gave the Flying Squirrels a 5-4 lead with a single. **Maui Ahuna** pushed the lead to 6-4 in the top of the ninth, his second homer in the last two games. **Darien Smith** entered in the fourth and threw a career-high 5.2 scoreless innings, holding Hartford to three hits with no walks and three strikeouts.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies, in their first six-game road series of the year. This week marks Richmond's first visit to Hartford since August 29-September 3, 2024, when they won four-of-six. Facing the Yard Goats in the final series of the 2025 season and the final series at The Diamond last September 9-14, the Flying Squirrels won the first five games before dropping the finale.

**STRONG START:** The Flying Squirrels' 10-game win streak, which was snapped on Thursday, was the longest in franchise history, surpassing an eight-game win streak from May 5-13, 2021, also beginning with the second game of the season. The 12-2 start is the best in team history through 14 games, passing the 10-4 start in 2018. Richmond has won all three series it has played so far this year.

**RELENTLESS:** In their 12 wins this year, the Flying Squirrels have come from behind in eight of them. In five of the wins, Richmond has taken the lead in the eighth inning or later. On April 4, they scored two in the ninth for an 11-9 win at Erie. In last Tuesday's home opener, they never trailed but jumped ahead in the bottom of the eighth for a 3-2 win over the Curve. Last Thursday, they scored two in the eighth for another 3-2 win against Altoona. Last Saturday, the Curve scored two in the top of the 10th before the Flying Squirrels walked off with three in the bottom of the 10th. On Wednesday in Hartford, the Flying Squirrels scored five runs with two outs in the ninth to win 13-11.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have the best record in the Eastern League and are tied for the best record of all 150 teams across Major League Baseball and Minor League Baseball, tied with High-A Hickory of the Carolina League. The Richmond offense leads the Double-A level in batting average (.304), hits (151), doubles (37), RBIs (96), OPS (.885) and HBP (18). They also lead the Eastern League in total bases (240) and SLG (.484). In eight road games this year, the Flying Squirrels are batting .323 (100-for-310) and have scored 72 runs (9 runs per game).

**THE YARD GOATS** are 5-9 on the season, last in the Northeast Division. They opened the season 3-1, including taking two-of-three at home against the Baysox, before dropping four-of-five entering this series. In 2025, the Yard Goats went 69-68, third-best in the Northeast Division. Hartford's roster features three players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 prospects, including LHP Griffin Herring (No. 12), 2B Roc Riggio (No. 15) and C Cole Messina (No. 23). MLB.com's top-30 Rockies prospects list features four Hartford players, including Herring (No. 9), Riggio (No. 10), Messina (No. 21) and LHP Konner Eckton (No. 26).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Logan Martin** makes his third Double-A start and his second this week against the Yard Goats. It is also his third appearance as a member of the San Francisco Giants organization. In the first game of the series on Tuesday, Martin allowed a run in the first before holding Hartford scoreless for the rest of his outing, totaling 4.1 innings with four strikeouts. He made his Double-A debut on April 8 at CarMax Park, allowing three runs on two hits in four innings against the Curve. Martin was acquired by the Giants from the Kansas City Royals in a trade on November 11, 2025 for right-handed pitcher Mason Black. A native of Peducah, Ky., Martin finished his collegiate career at the University of Kentucky and was selected by the Royals in the 12th round of the 2023 MLB Draft. He spent all of last season with High-A Quad Cities, going 8-4 with a 3.45 ERA in 22 starts. For the year, he ranked second in the Midwest League in wins. *For more on Martin, see page two.*

**FOR HARTFORD:** Right-hander **Connor Staine** makes his third appearance of the season and his second of the series. On Tuesday against the Flying Squirrels, he allowed five runs over three innings in a loss. He made his season debut on April 8 at Reading and allowed three runs over 2.2 innings out of the bullpen with five walks. In his first Double-A season last year, Staine went 3-8 with a 4.91 ERA in 25 starts. He made one start against the Flying Squirrels, which came in the final game at The Diamond on September 14, and allowed two runs over 6.1 innings in a no-decision. Staine was selected by the Rockies in the fifth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of the University of Central Florida.

**GREAT SCOTT:** **Scott Bandura** has 12 RBIs over his last six games since Sunday, including 10 in the current series. In the final game of last week's series against the Curve, he went 2-for-3 with two doubles and drove in two runs. On Tuesday night in Hartford, Bandura went 3-for-4 with two doubles and drove in five runs, the most by a Richmond batter this season. On Wednesday, he hit a solo homer before clubbing a go-ahead, three-run double in the ninth. He added an RBI in Saturday night's win at Hartford. His 13 RBIs this season are tied for third in the Eastern League.

**JUST HOW WE DREW IT UP:** **Drew Cavanaugh** has reached base multiple times in seven-of-his-nine games started this season and ranks tied for sixth in the Eastern League in on-base percentage (.500). He has at least one hit and one walk in seven games and has hit at least one double in five games.

**COX ROCKS:** **Jonah Cox** has hit safely in all 12 games he has played to open his Double-A career. His 12-game hit streak is tied for the longest in the Eastern League this season, even with Jackson Hornung of New Hampshire. During the streak, Cox is batting .429 (18-for-42), which is third in the league, with five doubles and 11 RBIs. Cox is also tied for second in the EL with nine stolen bases this season. In his four games this week, Cox is batting .571 (8-for-14), second-best in the league, with a homer, three doubles, four RBIs, five runs and three stolen bases. His .667 OBP this week is the highest in the EL.

**CHUCK:** **Charlie Szykowny** hit his second homer of the season on Saturday night, part of his second three-hit game of the series. In his week's series, he is batting .435 (10-for-23) with three doubles, a triple, a homer, three RBIs and four runs scored. He has been one leg shy of the cycle twice this week.

**TOP SKIPPER:** Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 272 wins in his career, which is a new franchise record all-time wins record for a manager. He passed the record with Richmond's 6-1 win at Binghamton on May 23, 2025. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** In 2025, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in total (446,679) and average (6,768) attendance for the fourth consecutive season. The average attendance was the highest in the franchise's history. Tuesday's inaugural game at CarMax Park had been sold out for more than a month, marking the 16th consecutive home-opener to sell out for the Flying Squirrels. This season, the Flying Squirrels lead all 120 MiLB teams in average attendance (8,235).

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** In the Eastern League, **Jonah Cox** is tied for third in stolen bases (8), sixth in batting average (.395), tied for seventh in hits (15), 10th in RBIs (11) and 10th in OBP (.477). **Drew Cavanaugh** is second in OBP (.564), second in OPS (1.278), tied for second in doubles (6), fifth in SLG (.714), tied for fifth in runs (13) and seventh in batting average (.393). **Bo Davidson** is tied for fourth in homers (4). **Scott Bandura** is tied for second in doubles (6), tied for third in extra-base hits (8), tied for fourth in RBIs (12), tied for fourth in hits (16) and tied for ninth in total bases (27). **Charlie Szykowny** is tied for fourth in hits (16). **Dayson Croes** is tied for seventh in hits (15). **Turner Hill** is tied for first in triples (2) and tied for seventh in runs (12). **Jack Choate** is tied for first in wins (3). **Mitch White** is tied for fourth in wins (2). **Joe Whitman** is third in strikeouts (19), tied for sixth in innings pitched (13.2) and tied for eighth in WHIP (1.17). **Tyler Vogel** is first in saves (4) and tied for first in games pitched (6).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** Richmond's roster features three players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including **Bo Davidson** (No. 3), **Diego Velasquez** (No. 24) and **Joe Whitman** (No. 25). **Adrián Sugastey** is rated by Baseball America as the top defensive catcher in the Giants organization and **Jonah Cox** is rated as the top defensive outfielder. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features three Richmond players, including Davidson (No. 7), **Maui Ahuna** (No. 20) and Whitman (No. 26).

### THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

1957: The Richmond Virginians beat the Rochester Red Wings, 4-3, in 10 innings at Parker Field. Tommy Carroll won the game with a home run in the bottom of the 10th inning. **1971:** The Richmond Braves beat the Toledo Mud Hens, 3-1. Darrell Evans drove in all three Richmond runs, including a two-run, two-out homer in the seventh to break a 1-1 tie. Luis Tiant, who had signed a 30-day minor league contract days earlier, started in his Richmond debut and allowed one run over seven innings. **1989:** Kent Mercker picked up his first Triple-A win as the Richmond Braves beat the Toledo Mud Hens, 5-1, at The Diamond. He allowed one run over 5.2 innings. David Justice hit a two-run homer in the third. Mark Lemke had two hits and drove in a run. **1993:** The Richmond Braves beat the Rochester Red Wings, 6-5, at The Diamond. After trailing, 5-0, the R-Braves tied the score, 5-5, with homers by Javy Lopez, Jose Oliva and Tony Tarasco. Ryan Klesko knocked a pinch-hit, walk-off single in the ninth. **2018:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Bowie Baysox, 1-0, for the second straight day, marking the only consecutive 1-0 wins in franchise history.
