## FROM THE CROWS NEST

 $\textbf{EYEING THE SERIES WIN:} \ Despite an early 3-0 \ lead, a four-run fifth \ lifted the Daytona Tortugas past the Bradenton Marauders 7-3 on Saturday night.$ Braylon Bishop launched Bradenton's first homer of the year with a towering drive to left. Yordany De Los Santos also tacked on another with an RBI double to left. Daytona rallied six runs over the game's final five innings, and their bullpen combined for seven shutout innings en route to their first win of the year. Bradenton looks for the series win in today's rubber match. The Marauders return to Bradenton for their home opener on Tuesday.

MEET MUETH: Pirates no. 10 prospect (MLB Pipeline) Zander Mueth gets the ball for the final game of the series. The right hander started 2024 with the FCL Pirates and posed a 1.58 ERA over 51.1 innings. In seven starts with Bradenton last year, he registered a 3.97 ERA and limited opposing hitters to a .110 batting average.

 $\textbf{OPENING WITH A W:} \ Early \ offense \ and \ stout \ pitching \ paced \ the \ Bradenton \ Marauders \ to \ a \ 6-2 \ Opening \ Day \ win \ over \ the \ Daytona \ Tortugas \ on \ Friday \ and \ Tortugas \ and \ Tort$ night. The victory marked their first to start a season since 2023 (3-2 W vs CLR). Offensively, Bradenton collected seven hits and took advantage of seven walks, two errors, and two hit batters throughout the night. On the hill, starter Clevari Téjada tossed four strong innings of one-run ball. Relievers Greiber Mendez and Inmer Lobo covered the final six innings without allowing a run.

WASTING NO TIME: MLB.com's No. 42 prospect and 2024 first-round pick Konnor Griffin went 2-for-4 with a walk and two stolen bases in his professional debut on Friday night. Both singles left the bat at 104 mph and 111 mph respectively. His first knock came on the first pitch he saw, while the second completed a 10-pitch at bat.

WELCOME TO 2025: After a 54-77 (29-37, 25-40) in 2024, the Bradenton Marauders open 2025 facing the same team they finished with in the Daytona Tortugas. Last season, Bradenton dropped the season series 4-7. They are seeking their first series win against the Tortugas since July of 2023 when they took five of six at Jackie Robinson Ballpark

RETURNERS: The 2024 Marauders roster features 26 returning players from the 2024 season: Pitchers Jacob Bimbi (IL), Danny Carrion (IL), Hunter Furtado, Owen Kellington, Tyler Kennedy, Inmer Lobo, Brennan Malone, Greiber Mendez, Zander Mueth, Peyton Stumbo, Noah Takacs, Clevari Tejada, and Joaquin Tejada... Catchers Derek Berg and Axiel Plaz... Infielders Carlos Caro, Yordany De Los Dantos, Ethan Lege (IL), Jhonny Severino, and Jeral Toledo... and Outfielders Braylon Bishop, Solomon Maguire, Andrew Patrick, Eddy Rodriguez, and Will Taylor.

TOP PROSPECTS & SPRING BREAKOUT: The 2025 roster features six of the Pittsburgh Pirates' Top 30 Prospects according to MLB Pipeline: Konnor Griffin (No. 2), Zander Mueth (No. 10), Jhonny Severino (No. 12), Yordany De Los Santos (No. 16), Tony Blanco Jr. [IL] (No. 21), and Axiel Plaz (No. 28). All six players played for the Pirates Spring Breakout Team on 3/14 in a 3-5 loss to the Philadelphia Phillies Prospects.

HORNER RETURNS TO CAPTAIN SHIP: Jim Horner returns to the Bradenton Marauders in 2025 for his second season as manager of the club, and sixth year in the Pirates organization. Prior to 2024, Horner managed the Florida Complex League Pirates (FCL) in 2023, served as a Minor League Assistant Field Coordinator in 2022 and a bench coach for Bradenton in 2021.

IT ALL BEGINS IN BRADENTON: Seven former Marauders were named to the Pirates Opening Day Roster (excluding rehab assignments), including four in the season's first starting lineup: Oneil Cruz (2019), Adam Frazier (2014), Ke'Bryan Hayes (2017), Jared Jones (IL - 2021), Mitch Keller (2016 18), Endy Rodriguez (2021), and Paul Skenes (2023). Thomas Harrington (2023) also made his Major League debut on 4/1 vs Tampa Bay, making him the 107th former Marauder to appear in a big-league game, not including rehab assignments.

MARUADER MASHERS: Last season, Bradenton led the Florida State League with 111 homeruns - marking the second most in franchise history behind 2023 when they launched 111. They have now registered 100+ homers in four of their last five seasons dating back to 2019, a benchmark they had never reached before then. Esmerlyn Valdez led all of Single-A with his 22 round trippers - the feat matched Dylan Busby (2019) for the most by a Marauder in a single season
