## RIDERS BEAT MISSIONS 6-3, TAKE SERIES:

The Frisco RoughRiders defeated the San Antonio Missions 6-3 on Sunday evening from Riders Field. Frisco (28-23, 72-48) used a two-run homer by **Abimelec Ortiz** in the home half of the fourth inning against San Antonio (23-27, 54-64) starter Henry Baez (3-1) to break the scoreless tie. **Kohl Drake** (1-1), making his second career Double-A start and his first at Riders Field, was dominant as he turned in 6.1 innings of scoreless, one-hit baseball. The lefty walked just one while fanning six. In the bottom of the sixth, **Maximo Acosta** and **Cody Freeman** executed a double steal that allowed Acosta to score. Ortiz capped off the frame with an RBI double that pushed the Frisco lead to 4-0. San Antonio picked up a pair of runs in the top of the seventh against **Dane Acker** to make it a 4-2 game. Lucas Dunn provided a bases-loaded, two-run single to open the scoring for the Missions. Frisco responded in the bottom of the eighth inning, giving a walk by **Cooper Johnson** and an RBI single from **Keyber Rodriguez** to push the lead back to four at 6-2. Acker tossed a scoreless eighth inning and handed the ball to **Skylar Hales**. The righty allowed a run on back-to-back doubles from Robert Perez Jr. and Joshua Mears in the top of the ninth, but picked up a groundout to clinch the 6-3 win. Offensively, Ortiz paced the RoughRiders with three hits and three RBI. Freeman also collected a two-hit night.

## MISSION ACCOMPLISHED:

The RoughRiders dominated the San Antonio Missions all season and the Riders have had plenty of head-to-head success against the Missions over the years. In 2023, Frisco went 13-11 against San Antonio and have gone 61-29 against them since they rejoined the Texas League in 2021, including 34-9 at the Wolff. In the 24 games this season, Frisco went 20-4. The Riders had a 2.93 team ERA, outscoring the Missions 124-80. **Aaron Zavala** drove in 15 runs over his 20 games against the Missions, while **Cooper Johnson** has hit 5 home runs in 13 games, batting .308/.449/.692/1.141.

## REHAB CITY:

After **Jacob deGrom** made his first rehab start for the RoughRiders on Thursday, that put Frisco at eight rehabbers this season. The hitters include **Josh Jung** and **Nathaniel Lowe** while **Cody Bradford**, **Dane Dunning**, **Josh Sborz**, **Jacob Latz** and **Tyler Mahle** make up the pitchers. In 2018, the RoughRiders had 12 rehabbers, the most in franchise history. This season marks the highest volume of rehabbers since 2018.

## PLEASE DON'T HIT ME ONE MORE TIME:

The Riders pitching staff has been a strength this season, but they have struggled over their last 12 games. During that stretch, Springfield and San Antonio have hit .296 (129-for-436) with 26 doubles, eight home runs and averaging 6.1 runs per game on the offensive side, taking seven of 12 games. Frisco's bullpen had a 7.69 ERA (45ER/52.2 IP) and has allowed 74 hits over 52.2 innings while blowing leads in five of their seven losses. The Riders lost back-to-back series for the first time all season before taking their last series against San Antonio. They are now 7-11 in their last 18 games.

## HOMER HAPPY:

On August 16th, the Riders hit a season-high four home runs with **Luis Mieses** capping the night with his second for a walk-off home run. It was Mieses's third multi-home run game of his career. The RoughRiders have hit 12 home runs in the last nine games, with those 12 home runs being third in the Texas League this week. Frisco is still just seventh in the Texas League in home runs this season with 88 across their 120 games (on pace for 101, which would be for the fifth-fewest in the 21 seasons of the franchise).

## RISP-ECT THIS PLEASE:

Over the last 30 games, the Riders are fourth in the Texas League with a .737 OPS, second with a .260 batting average and are sixth with 4.6 runs per game. Holding them back, Frisco is just batting just .217 (60-for-277) with runners in scoring position over their last 30 games.

## HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 40-22 at Riders Field this season. At home this season, Frisco has a +69 run differential, a 4.12 ERA and is averaging 5.6 runs per game with a .763 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 32-26 with a 3.22 ERA, but a +21 run differential while averaging 3.9 runs per game and owning a .638 OPS (10th in the league). **Cody Freeman** has 10 of his 14 home runs at home while **Abimelec Ortiz** has hit 10 of his 11 homers at Riders Field. Ortiz is batting .314/.406/.543/.949 at home as opposed to .138/.202/.204/.406 on the road.

## WE'RE GOING DANCING:

The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

### ABOUT BEN

-Played high school baseball at Shenendehowa (N.Y.) High School and was drafted by Toronto in the 26th round of the 2016 June draft following his senior yr, but did not sign. He was a catcher and a pitcher in high school. He was a 1st Team All-State Catcher, but was drafted as a pitcher.

-Went to the University of Binghamton for three seasons (same field he won a NYS Class AA Championship at in HS). At BU, he went 13-7 with a 2.62 ERA over three years. In final year, went 9-4 with a 2.76 ERA over 15 starts while striking out 108 in 88.0 innings to 27 walks.

-Twin brother, Ian, was selected by Atlanta in the 1st round (3rd overall) of the 2016 June draft and played a key role on the Braves' 2021 World Series championship team. Ben attended the Braves' 2020 postseason games played at Globe Life Field.

-Father, Bob, played baseball at Siena.

### 2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation, though he made his Double-A debut in relief on Opening Day (4/5) with a scoreless inning, striking out three side.

-Made best start of the season against Amarillo on April 24th, throwing six innings, allowing just two earned (two-run home run in the first inning by Tim Tawa).

-Struck out career-best eight at Amarillo in game two of the doubleheader on May 16th.

### 2023 SEASON

-Opened the season on the Injured List while recovering from "Tommy John" surgery.

### 2022 SEASON

-Returned to Hickory (A+) and went 5-3, 3.51 ERA (16 ER/41.0 IP) over 9 starts before experiencing discomfort in his right elbow during outing on 6/9 at Bowling Green. He underwent season-ending "Tommy John" ligament replacement surgery on 6/15/22

### 2021 SEASON
