**Tonight's Game:** The Nashville Sounds and Indianapolis Indians play game two of a six-game series tonight. Indianapolis won game one last night, 6-3. Right-hander Caleb Boushley starts for the Sounds against left-hander Zach Matson for the Indians.

**Caleb Boushley:** 28-year-old Caleb Boushley starts for the Sounds tonight. The right-hander is 8-2 with a 2.97 ERA (75.2 IP/25 ER) in 14 starts with Nashville this season. He last pitched on June 23 against Gwinnett and got a no decision (5.0 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 1 BB, 3 K). Boushley is among International League leaders in wins (8, T-1st), starts (14, T-2nd), innings (75.2, 3rd), ERA (2.97, 3rd), WHIP (1.12, 3rd) and opponent average (.219, 4th). The Wisconsin native spent 2021 with Double-A San Antonio and Triple-A El Paso, going 2-3 with a 3.79 ERA in eight starts for the Missions and 3-8 with a 5.85 ERA in 16 games (15 starts) with the Chihuahuas. He was selected by Milwaukee in the Triple-A phase of the 2021 Rule 5 Draft. The Padres drafted Boushley in the 33rd Round of the 2017 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Wisconsin-La Crosse.

**Zach Matson:** 26-year-old Zach Matson makes a spot start for the Indians tonight. The left-hander is 0-1 with a 7.94 ERA (11.1 IP/10 ER) in eight games (three starts) with Indy this year. He also has 11 games (one start) with Double-A Altoona this year and is 2-1 with a 1.84 ERA (14.2 IP/3 ER). Matson began the season with Altoona and joined Indianapolis on May 24. He last pitched on June 24 in a start against Memphis and tossed 28 pitches (1.1 IP, 2 H, 2 ER, 0 BB, 1 K) in a loss. He has started this year on May 13 vs. Somerset, June 4 at Omaha, June 15 at Gwinnett and June 24. Matson was drafted by the Baltimore Orioles in the 24th round of the 2016 MLB First-Year Player Draft.

**2022 Standings:** The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in 2022: First: 64, Second: 11, Third: 3, Fourth: 2, Fifth: 1, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0, Eighth: 0, Ninth: 0, Tenth: 0.

**Superlatives:** Last night's loss dropped the Sounds to 24-13 at home...7-6 in series openers...19-11 vs. NL affiliates...2-24 when trailing after 8 innings...11-22 when the opponent scores first...14-25 when the opponent scores 4+ runs.

**One More Start in June:** Tonight is starter Caleb Boushley's fifth start in the month of June. In his four outings, he's 3-0 with a 1.50 ERA (24.0 IP/4 ER). He has limited opponents to only 16 hits and 10 walks to go along with 12 strikeouts. If Boushley gets to the minimum 30.0-inning threshold tonight, his 1.50 ERA would qualify as the 9th-lowest monthly ERA by a Sounds pitcher since the PCL era began in 1998. Kevin Tolar (0.56 ERA - August, 2002), has the lowest.

**Rare Miscues:** Last night the Sounds committed two errors, only the ninth time they have done so in 2022. Nashville leads all of Triple-A Baseball with a .987 fielding percentage. When not committing any errors, the Sounds are 30-17.

**Marky Mark is Back:** Infielder Mark Mathias went 3-for-3 with a run scored last night to extend his on-base streak to 19 games. During the 19-game streak, Mathias is hitting .344 (22-for-64) with 11 runs, 1 double, 4 home runs, 12 RBI and 13 walks. He is four games shy of matching Jonathan Davis (23 games) for the longest on-base streak by a Sound in 2022.

**It's A Small World:** Ethan Small was named the International League Pitcher of the Week (June 20-26) after turning in one of the best outings of his career last Saturday with a 10-strikeout performance. It was Small's third career double-digit strikeout game (also - 12, 6/12/21 w/ Biloxi vs. Mississippi and 10, 6/11/21 w/ Biloxi at Montgomery). It was also the second time in Small's career he went 7.0 innings (also - 6/18/21 w/ Biloxi at Rocket City).

**The Sad Man:** Reliever Connor Sadzeck continued his brilliant season out of the pen with another scoreless outing Sunday night (1.0 IP, 2 K), his third outing of the series. In 21 games with the Sounds, the right-hander is 1-1 with a 1.16 ERA (23.1 IP/3 ER) with 30 strikeouts. Opposing batters are hitting just .181 against him.

**Sweet's Managerial Watch:** Rick Sweet has 190 wins as Nashville's manager, good for 5th-most in franchise history. Don Money has the 4th-most wins in franchise history with 223.

**Earn It:** The Nashville pitching staff leads Triple-A with a 3.72 ERA. Buffalo checks in at second with a 3.98 ERA. The Sounds also lead Triple-A with eight shutouts.

**The Future Brew Crew:** Nashville has four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Brice Turang is the No. 4 prospect, left-hander Ethan Small is the No. 8 prospect, catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 20 prospect, right-handed pitcher Alec Bettinger is the No. 22 prospect and right-handed pitcher Dylan File is the No. 24 prospect.
