LAST TIME OUT: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats held off the Bowie Baysox by a score of 7-6 in the series finale on Sunday. New Hampshire ended the road trip with a winning record after winning seven of 12 games over the past two weeks. Trevor Schwecke collected a game-high three hits and drove in the first three runs of the game with a solo homer and a two-run double. In the 4th, Will Robertson and Riley Tirotta went back-to-back with solo homers. After Robertson's sac-fly in the fifth and his RBI single in the seventh, New Hampshire's lead stood at 7-3 after the top of the 7th. Bowie pulled within two on a two-run single by Donta Williams in the bottom of the 7th and in the bottom of the 9th, Bowie cut New Hampshire's lead down to one after Greg Cullen drew a fourth consecutive walk with nobody out. Right-hander Grayson Thurman entered the game with the bases loaded and nobody out and proceeded to strike out the next two batters and induce a force out to end the game.

MAJOR WILL POWER: After homering on Sunday, OF Will Robertson is tied with Damiano Palmegiani for the team-lead in home runs at 19. The 25-year-old hit five homers on the road trip, including his first multi-homer game of the season on Wednesday at Bowie. Robertson is fourth in the league in slugging percentage (.488) and fifth in extra base hits (47). He is batting .306 (57-for-186) in the second half and 11 of his 18 homers this season have been hit in the second half.

GETTING TIROTTA IN HERE: IF Riley Tirotta is 13-for-31 (.419) in the month of September with six extra base hits, three home runs and 11 RBI. The 25-year-old is tied for second in the league in hits and RBI this month.

GET SCHWECKED: UTL Trevor Schwecke recorded his fourth multi-hit game and his third 3+ hit game of the Bowie series with a 3-for-4 afternoon with three RBI on Sunday. The 25-year-old finished the series going 12-for-21 and he leads the league in hits this month with 14. Schwecke is batting .424 in the month of September.

RODEN ON A ROLL: OF Alan Roden is 11-for-28 (.393) to start the month of September after hitting .326 in the month of August. The Blue Jays No. 7 prospect has collected hits in 17 of his last 20 games and has 13 multi-hit performances in 41 games played. Roden is hitting .325 since joining the team on July 19.

CJ COMMANDING THE SHIP: RHP CJ Van Eyk makes his third start at Double-A this season. The 24-year-old threw four innings and allowed three runs (one earned) on four hits and one walk with one strikeout on 48 pitches in a no-decision at Bowie on Wednesday. The former top 10 Blue Jays prospect is in his first season back after Tommy John surgery kept him out all of 2022. The Tampa native's last full season was in 2021 when he struck out 100 over 80.1 innings with High-A Vancouver.

SIZING UP SOMERSET: Somerset is coming off a series split against Erie in its final home stand of the regular season. The Patriots have been the best team this season with a 79-52 overall record and they have scored the most runs and hit the most home runs so far this season. They currently lead the Northeast Division in the second half with a record of 37-26 and have already clinched a postseason berth after winning the first half. The Yankees Double-A affiliate is looking to win the Eastern League for a second year in a row.

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (September 12, 2018) - The Fisher Cats improved to 5-0 in the post-season, taking a 2-0 lead in the EL finals with a 6-1 win at Akron. New Hampshire took the lead for good with three runs in the third inning. Jon Berti drove in a pair with a single and Cavan Biggio added an RBI groundout to make it 3-1. Jon Harris allowed one run in 5.1 innings for the win. He struck out seven batters.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Toronto (80-64) lost the first game of the series with Texas 10-4. Cavan Biggio homered and drove in two runs for the Blue Jays, but a grand slam by Jonah Heim in the top of the seventh was the big blow for the Rangers...Buffalo (70-66) will play at Scranton-Wilkes Barre this week. They trail Durham by three games in the IL standings with two weeks to play...Vancouver opens the best-of-five Northwest League Championship series tonight at Everett. The Agua Sox (Mariners) won the second half after the Canadians won the first half. Everett last won the NWL title in 2010. Vancouver won three straight 2011-13 and again in 2017 (all under the Blue Jays banner)...Dunedin finished the season on Sunday with a 62-70 record.
