#### SIX-RUN SEVENTH SINKS JACKSONVILLE

Lorenzo Quintana's two-run home run in the top of the first was not enough as Jacksonville's fell 7-3 to the Memphis Redbirds Wedensday afternoon. The Jumbo Shrimp were in control for the majority of the game. Leading 3-1 after six full innings, Matthew Kent set a season-high in innings pitched with six strong innings. For the second day in a row, the seventh inning was not kind to the Jumbo Shrimp. Between Tuesday and Wednesday's seventh innings, Memphis has scored 10 total runs combined in the seventh inning this series.

#### **OCEAN'S ELEVEN**

The Jumbo Shrimp have won 12 of the past 17 games, outscoring their opponents during this stretch by a whopping 106-76 margin and compiling a 174-146 advantage in hits and 26-14 margin in home runs. Since this roll began on April 15, the Jumbo Shrimp are hitting .288/.365/.478/.843 as a team and rank fourth out of 120 Minor League Baseball teams in hits, tied for ninth in home runs and tied for 10th in runs.

#### THE CHICKS DIG IT

Jacksonville has popped 36 home runs thus far in 2022, ranking fourth in the International League. The home run power the Jumbo Shrimp have shown has been a rarity for teams on the First Coast in recent years; no Jacksonville team has finished outside the bottom 10 in either Triple-A (2021) or Double-A (2014-19) in home runs since 2013, when the Jacksonville Suns bashed 104 bombs to place 14th in Double-A. In fact, the last time a Jacksonville club ranked in the top 10 of its level in long balls was 2009, when the Suns cracked 110 homers. Heading into play on Tuesday, the Jumbo Shrimp have homered in nine consecutive games, their best such streak since at least 2018.

#### SHRIMP SPECKS

The Jumbo Shrimp have made just one error in their last eight games a span of 69.2 innings... With a 14-12 record, Jacksonville finished April with a winning record for the first time since going 14-10 in April 2013. The Jumbo Shrimp are now 1-2 in the month of May. However, they still have a winning record on the road and are just one-of-seven teams in the International League with a winning record on the road.

#### **CHARLES LE MAGNIFIQUE**

Charles Leblanc went 1-for-4 on Wednesday, continuing a fantastic start to 2022. The Laval, Quebic City native has reached base safely in 20 of his 23 games this year. On the season, Leblanc ranks second in the International League in batting average (.390), first in OPS (1.128), third in slugging percentage (.671), tied for sixth in home runs (6), third in on-base percentage (.457), and tied for fourth in hits (32) Among the 133 qualified hitters in the circuit, Leblanc leads the league in both wOBA (.486) and wRC+ (198).

#### THIS CUBAN IS CRUSHING MISSILES

Over his last 11 games, **Lorenzo Quintana** has gone 16-for-47 at the plate, slashing .340/.415/.617/1.032 with 4 doubles, 3 home runs, 11 RBIs and nine runs scored. This hot stretch has pushed Quintana up the International League leaderboards on the season; the native of Pinar del Rio in Cuba ranks in the top 20 of the league in slugging (5th; .646), batting average (7th; 341), OPS (4th; 1.035), home runs (T-6th; 6), RBIs (T-6th; 20), extra-base hits (T-7th; 13) and hits (T-10th; 28). Of the 133 qualified hitters in the International League, Quintana has posted the 14th-lowest strikeout rate (13.3 percent). He places fourth in both wOBA (.444) and wRC+ (171).

#### FRIK THE RED

Jumbo Shrimp infielder Erik González has collected at least one hit in 17 of his last 19 games. During that span, the Puerto Plata, Dominican Republic native is 34-for-78 at the plate, slashing .420/.448/.580/1.028 with eight doubles, one triple, one home run, 11 RBIs and 10 runs scored. Heading into play on Wednesday, González is ranked second in the International League in average (.393) and ranks first in hits (35).

#### **ROAD WARRIORS**

Heading into play on Wednesday, Jacksonville is currently 8-6 on the road. There are only three teams in the International League with eight road wins so far in 2022 (Jacksonville, Memphis, and St. Paul). There are seven teams with a winning record on the road and Jacksonville ranks sixth with an 8-6 record (.571).
