CARDS LEAD SUSPENDED GAME IN 4TH INNING: Before the skies opened on Thursday night and caused game three of the series to be suspended, the Cardinals got out to a 4-2 lead thanks to a two-run homer by **RJ Yeager** in the bottom of the 3rd inning. **Jacob Buchberger** and **Jeremy Rivas** also drove in runs for Springfield, and **Tekoah Roby** matched a season high with 8 strikeouts in just 4.0 IP. The Cardinals and Travelers will pick up the suspended game at 5:15 pm on Friday and play a seven-inning game following its completion.



DPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Juan Mercedes** makes his fourth start of the season for the Travelers in game two...Last pitched on Saturday, April 20 against Frisco at Dickey-Stephens Park, allowing 4 R (3 ER) on 7 H with 2 K over 5.0 IP...He did not factor in the decision, an 8-4 Arkansas loss...Did not start against the Cardinals in the three-game series in North Little Rock in early April...Spent the majority of last season with the Travelers, going 2-1 with a 6.60 ERA in 12 appearances (10 starts)...Opponents batted ..296 against him...In two starts against the Cardinals last season went 1-0 with a 3.86 ERA in 2 appearances (1 start)...Made his first 4 appearances last season (all starts) with High-A Everett and went 1-0 with a 3.43 ERA...Spent most of the 2022 season with Everett going 7-8 with a 4.51 ERA in 22 appearances (21 starts), racking up 124 K with just 30 BB in 107.2 IP...Pitched exclusively as a reliever with Low-A Modesto in 2021 and went 7-4 with a 5.54 ERA in 34 appearances, striking out 88 batters over 63.1 IP... First season in the US was 2018 after spending two seasons in the Dominican Republic, the same year Seattle signed Julio Rodriguez...24 years old

CARDINALS, TRAVELERS CLASH FOR SECOND TIME IN FOUR WEEKS: The Arkansas Travelers (Double-A, Seattle Mariners) make their first of two trips this season to Hammons Field for a six-game series. The Cardinals swept a three-game series in North Little Rock to start the 2024 campaign and went 7-5 against the Travelers at home last season.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

CARDS OFF TO BEST TEXAS LEAGUE START SINCE AT LEAST

2005: With a 14-3 record over their first 17 games, the Cardinals are off to the Texas League's best 17-game start since at least 2005, before which the day-by-day standings are not archived.

BEST MILB RECORD RESIDES IN SPRINGFIELD: At 14-3 through 17 games, the Cardinals enter play on Friday evening with the best winning percentage in all of Minor League Baseball. No other team has less than four losses, with two other teams (Carolina Mudcats and Eugene Emeralds) at 14-4.

TAKE ME TO CHURCH: Cardinals outfielder **Nathan Church** was named Texas League Player of the Week after a big series in Amarillo. The UC Irvine product went 9-for-25 with 2 HR and 8 RBIs to go along with 6 BB. Church leads the Texas league in hits with 24, and also ranks in the top 10 in batting average, RBIs, total bases, and runs scored. In 79 plate appearances this year, he has struck out just 5 times.

REDMOND TIES FRANCHISE RECORD FOR HOME RUNS: With

his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on Tuesday night, Cardinals slugger **Chandler Redmond** tied the franchise record for most home runs in Springfield's 20-year franchise history. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with **Xavier Scruggs** (2010-13). **Redmond** already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 204.

WE'RE GDING STREAKING!: Although Noah Mendlinger's 0-for-4 outing on Tuesday night snapped his 10-game hitting streak, there is a pair of Cardinals who are riding sizeable streaks. With a sixth-inning single on Wednesday afternoon, Nathan Church extended his hitting streak to 9 games, and has hit safely in 15 of the 16 games he has played in so far this season. Jacob Buchberger extended his own streak to 7 games with a single in the fourth inning.

COMEBACK CARDS: Of the Cardinals' 17 games so far this season, they have fallen behind first in ten of them. Of those 10 games, the Cards have won 9, making them 9-1 when their opponent scores first. Amazingly, the Cardinals have fallen into a 1-0 hole after the top of the 1st inning in six of their eight games at home. Springfield, of course, has come back to win all six of those games.

BIRDS' BATS TOP TEXAS LEAGUE: Springfield's lineup sits atop the league in several offensive categories. Through 17 games the Cardinals lead the Texas League with a .284 batting average, a mark that also leads all of Double-A; the Bowie Baysox are next with a .273 average. The Cards also lead the Texas League in OBP (.378), OPS (.786), RBIs (98) and runs scored (108). Springfield has also been particularly productive hitting situationally, with a league-high 11 sacrifice flies this season. The Cards' OBP is ahead of the next-best mark by 20 points (Tulsa Drillers, .358)

GRINDIN': Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats. The Cardinals have struck out just 122 times in 17 games, the fewest in all of Minor League Baseball. The Cardinals have K'd three less times than the next team on the list, the Spokane Indians. The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers have the fewest K's outside of Triple-A playing all 18 games, with 128. The Cards are averaging just 7.2 K's per game.

VICTIMS OF THE LONG BALL: Despite an overall solid season so far in which the Cardinal pitching staff has posted a 4.09 ERA, the Birds have fallen victim to the home run ball early in the 2024 season. Springfield pitchers have allowed 20 HR so far this year, tied for the most in the Texas League with the Amarillo Sod Poodles.

FAMILIAR FACES: Of the 28 players on the Cardinals' Opening Day roster, 13 donned a Springfield uniform in 2023. Of the newcomers, only two Cards, **Bryan Torres** (Richmond, 2021) and **Matt Lloyd** (Chattanooga, 2021-22), have Double-A experience. Slugger **Chandler Redmond** returns for another season in Springfield after coming up one home run shy of the Springfield franchise record in 2023 with 31 longballs.

Cardinals skpper **Jose Leger** is back for his fourth year as manager in Spring-field.
