TODAY'S GAME: The Curve are in the midst of their 25th anniversary season, continuing a six-game set with Akron.

LAST TIME OUT: Akron's Connor Kokx hit a go-ahead solo homer in the top of the ninth to steal a 5-4 win for the Ducks over the Curve on Friday night. **Matt Gorski** drove in three including a swatting his 15th homer of the season in the defeat.

FLAVA-FRAZ: Outfielder **Matt Frazier** matched his career-high with four hits and reached base in all five of his plate appearances in Altoona's 8-1 win over Akron on Wednesday, August 23. Frazier has a hit in a season-high 9 straight games in which he's batting: .395/.425/.605 with 2 2B, 1 3B, 1 HR and 5 RBI. After batting just .214 in June, Frazier bounced back with a .315/.398/.397/.795 mark in July, totaling a .356 OBP since July 1st. Frazier's 97 hits rank 8th in the Eastern League and his 59 runs scored rank 9th in the Eastern League.

HE'S HERE: Right-hander **Paul Skenes**, the No. 1 Overall selection in the 2023 draft has joined the Curve for his Double-A debut on Saturday, August 26. Skenes is the 5th player No. 1 overall selection to suit up for the Curve following RHP **Kris Benson** (1996 / 2002 rehab), RHP **Bryan Bullington** (2002, 2004 with Curve), RHP **Gerrit Cole** (2011 / 2012 with Curve) and C **Henry Davis** (2021 / 2022-23 with Curve). Skenes has thrown 4.0 innings scoreless innings with the FCL Pirates and Bradenton in his professional career and is ranked as the No. 3 overall prospect in MiLB by MLB Pipeline.

IT'S OFFICIALLY GEN Z: Infielder **Tsung-Che Cheng** owns the Eastern League's longest hit streak this season at 17 games (7/22 - 8/9), matching Kevin Newman for the seventh-longest in franchise history. Cheng batted .393/.415/.574/.989 with 5 2B, 2 HR, 9 RBI, 3 BB, 9 K and 3-3 SB during his streak. Cheng's 10 triples this season are the most in minor league baseball. In the month of August he has a hit in 15-of-21 games, batting .315 with an .776 OPS.

GET SHORTY: Righty **Aaron Shortridge** has turned in his best work of the season since the calendar flipped to the second half. Since June 28 he's recorded a 3.42 ERA, the best mark by a qualified Curve pitcher. In the month of August, Shortridge has earned a win in all four of his starts and recorded a 1.73 ERA (5 ER / 26.0 IP) with just five walks and 20 strikeouts. 8 times this season, Shortridge has turned in a quality start. The 26-year-old ranks 1st in the Eastern League with 23 starts, T-2nd with 9 wins, and 2nd with 120.1 IP.

NOT YOUR AVERAGE JOE: Signed as a minor league free agent on August 10 after six seasons in the Astros system, utility man **Joe Perez** matched his career-high with 4 hits on August 15 at Bowie. Perez homered twice in Altoona's series at Bowie last week and has reached base safely in each of his 12 games played with Altoona, batting .326/.404/.696/1.100 with 2 2B, 5 HR, 9 RBI, and 15 K's.

OUR OWN HOWLER: Left-hander **Jackson Wolf**, acquired from the San Diego Padres in the Rich Hill and Ji Man Choi deal, has continued to be one of Double-A's best strikeout artists this season. He's struck out 19 in four starts with Altoona in 18.0 innings giving him 124 this season between San Antonio and Altoona, the 9th-most strikeouts by a pitcher at the level.

THE BIG LEFTY: Lefty **Anthony Solometo** is the youngest pitcher to reach the Eastern League this season, doing so at 20 years, 6 months and 15 days when he made his debut on June 17 at Somerset. Solometo is the 13th player in franchise history to suit up for the Curve under the age of 21 and slots in as the 5th-youngest player in the team's history between C **Ryan Doumit**, who was 20 years, 4 months, 0 days old when he debuted on August 3, 2001, and LHP **Sean Burnett**, who was 20 years, 6 months, 18 days old when he debuted on April 4, 2003. Solometo leads all qualified Pirates minor leaguers with a 3.17 ERA and ranks 5th with 113 strikeouts this season. He is one of 8 players to play in the EL at age 20 or younger, Harrisburg has two of them: Brady House and James Wood. Jackson Holliday (BOW), Jasson Dominguez (SOM), Yanquel Fernandez (HFD), Blaze Jordan (POR) and Marcelo Mayer (POR) are the others in the league that are not permitted to drink alcohol.

STRIKEOUTS ARE ALL THE RAGE: Throughout the 2023 season, Altoona has been one of the league's most-difficult teams to strike out. Entering play on Saturday, August 26, Altoona has struck out 954 times, still the fewest among Double-A teams and 5th-fewest in minor league baseball. Altoona's franchise record for fewest strikeouts in a season is 811 achieved in 2003 when the Curve struck out an average of 5.75 times per game. The 2023 Curve are striking out an average of 8.32 times per game.

DUCKS ON THE POND: Rouglas Odor, the uncle of San Diego Padres infielder Rougned Odor, is back in the rubber city as Manager for a fourth season after previously coaching in Akron with the Aeros from 2011-2013 and later as the Hitting Coach in 2015-17. His squad features some top Guardians prospects according to MLB Pipeline: No. 6 INF Juan Brito, No. 19 RHP Tanner Burns, No. 20 OF Petey Halpin, No. 26 LHP Doug Nikhazy, No. 27 LHP Will Dion.

THE FIRST RUBBER ON THE ROAD: Doug Nikhazy takes the ball on Saturday night. Cleveland's 2nd round pick in 2021 out of Ole Miss, Nikhazy made his Double-A debut against Altoona on September 3, 2022 and allowed 7 runs in 1.2 IP. Nick Gonzales smashed a 2-run homer and Altoona knocked him from the game with 5 additional runs in the second. Nikhazy started against Altoona on May 11 this season and allowed 1 run in 4.0 innings and struck out 5. Nikhazy hails from Windermere, FL and attended West Orange HS where he coordinated the West Orange Dance Marathon that raised \$80,000 for a children's miracle network and was Student Body President and a National Debater in high school. Nikhazy played for USA Baseball in 2015 and helped Ole Miss reach the Super Regional in 2021 at Arizona where he struck out 10 in 5.1 IP in their lone win at the Super Regional.

2023: Made his professional debut on August 10 with the FCL Pirates and tossed a scoreless inning... Promoted to Bradenton on August 15 and made two starts, totaling 3.0 scoreless innings...

COLLEGE: Began his collegiate career at the Air Force Academy where he was one of the nation's best two-way players as a freshman... Batted .367/.453/.669 with 31 2B, 24 HR and 81 RBI in 100 career games at the plate... Went 11-4 with a 2.72 ERA in 33 games (15 starts) in two seasons on the mound... Was named the National Co-Freshman of the Year by Collegiate Baseball in 2021 an award he shared with future LSU teammate OF Dylan Crews... **Earned the 2022 John Olerud Award** given to the nation's best two-way player, a season in which he went 10-3 with a 2.73 ERA and struck out 96 batters in 85.2 IP and batted .314/.412/.634 with 10 2B, 13 HR and 38 RBI at the plate... Transferred to LSU for the 2023 season and focused solely on pitching... **Earned the 2023 Dick Howser Trophy given to the nation's best NCAA Division I player** for the 2023 season after he finished 13-2 in 2023 with a 1.69 ERA in 122.2 innings... Also voted the 2023 National Player of the Year by Collegiate Baseball and D1 Baseball... Named the 2023 SEC Pitcher of the Year, first LSU winner since Aaron Nola in 2013 and 2014... Was named the Most Outstanding Player at the 2023 College World Series after going 1-0 with a 1.15 ERA with 21 strikeouts in two starts in Omaha... Struck out 48% of batters he faced in SEC play...

SKENES CAREER NOTES

Features a fastball (96-100), curveball, slider, and change-up

CAREER TRANSACTIONS: Drafted by the Pittsburgh Pirates in the 1st round (1st overall) of the 2023 First-Year Player Draft out of LSU... Signed on July 18, 2023 for a bonus of \$9.2 million, the largest bonus ever given, breaking Spencer Torkelson's \$8.4 million dollar bonus in 2020...

CURVE CUTS: Paul Skenes... Attended El Toro High School in Lake Forest, CA where he was a three-year letterwinner and team captain as a senior... Grew up rooting for the LA Angels... Spent the first two seasons of his collegiate career at the Air Force Academy where he earned the 2022 John Olerud Award as the nation's best two-way player... Was a member of Cadet Squadron 9... Also saw time as a catcher at Air Force... Son of Karen and Craig Skenes; Craig works for a pharmaceuticals company, and Karen is a stay-at-home mom... has an older sister, Lauren, and a younger sister, Kristen... His uncles Mike and Pete served in the U.S. Navy and his uncle, Dan, served in the U.S. Coast Guard... Majored in military strategic studies while at Air Force... Chose to attend Air Force for "The opportunities it presents both while I am here and after I graduate. Also, the people I meet here are the best people to be around and will make me better." (h/t Air Force Sports Information)... Air Force Head Coach Mike Kazlauskys told NOLA.com in Spring 2023 "He will serve his country in some manner moving forward. It's just going to be a matter of when. Paul and I have spoken about that piece. We'll get him back in the military once his professional playing days are over. It's a big deal for Paul to be able to serve his country."... Had he remained at Air Force he would have had to fulfill his military service obligation following graduation, his only way to avoid that was to transfer before his junior season... After working at 93-95 mph and touching 99 with his fastball as a sophomore, Skenes averaged 98 mph and hit 102 with his fastball at LSU... Pledged to make a \$10 donation for every strikeout he recorded in 2023 at LSU to Folds of Honor, a nonprofit organization that provides educational scholarships to the spouses and children of military and first responders who have died or been disabled... Struck out an SEC single-season record 209 batters resulting in a \$2,090 donation... Became the first LSU player to be selected No. 1 overall since Ben McDonald was picked by Baltimore in 1989 (McDonald previously held the SEC single-season strikeout record)... He and OF Dylan Crews (No. 2 Overall - Washington) are the first college teammates to ever be selected in the top two picks of the draft... Was ranked as the No. 1 prospect in the 2023 Draft by MLB Pipeline, No. 2 by *Baseball America*... Was rated as having the "Best Fastball", "Best Breaking Ball", third in "Best Control" and fifth in "Best Changeup" in the 2023 college class by *Baseball America*... Was also rated as the "Best Athlete" among the 2023 college class by *Baseball America*...
