Syracuse Mets RHP Brandon Sproat (1-1, 3.31) vs. Worcester Red Sox RHP Hunter Dobbins (0-0, 10.80)

Go Fourth – The Worcester Red Sox – winners of four in a row (both overall and at home) and winners of 9 of their last 10 games - play game four of their 7-game series against the Syracuse Mets at Polar Park tonight at 6:05 pm as the WooSox look to build on their 3 games to 0 advantage in the series thus far. The Sox swept a make-up doubleheader yesterday afternoon by identical, 5-4 scores on the heels of a 5-0 Worcester shutout victory on Tuesday night in the series opener. Tonight's game is live on NESN and can be heard on NASH 98.9 FM and the rest of the WooSox Radio Network. The teams continue the series with three more games over the weekend...tomorrow (Friday) at 6:05 pm, Saturday at 4:05 pm, and Sunday at 1:05 pm.

Four Below to Four Above – Since April 13th the WooSox have won 9 of their last 10 games to go from a season-low 4-games below .500 (4-8) to their current season-high of 4-games above .500 (13-9). They have also moved from 8th-place in the division and 6½-games behind to their present standing of 4th-place and just 3½-games behind 1st-place Jacksonville who have a 17-6 record.

A Ten Rating – As mentioned, Worcester is 9-1 in their last 10 games thanks to their current 4-game winning streak (April 20-23) along with a season-high 5-game winning streak also during this impressive stretch from April 13-18. The WooSox are hitting .319 during these 10 games (106-for-332) with 35 2B, 14 HR, and 72 runs scored while Sox pitchers are 9-1 with a 3.62 ERA (33 ER in 82 IP) giving up 37 runs and 12 HR.

Home Run Derby – The WooSox have maximized their use of the long-ball all season as 17 of their total 24 HR on the year have come with runners on base. Worcester batters have belted seven solo HR, twelve 2-run homers, two 3-run blasts, and three grand slams. The last four Sox homers have all been 2-run shots since Tuesday night as Yamani Grandal, Marcelo Mayer (two of them), and Nathan Hickey have done the damage in this series each with 2-run homers. Mayer, who leads the International League with 26 RBI, is tied for the IL lead with his 6 HR and all have come with runners on base...four 2-run homers, one 3-run shot, and 1 grand slam.

Baker's Dozen – The WooSox are 3-0 thus far on their season-long 13-game homestand that runs through Sunday, May 4. This current 7-game set vs. Syracuse continues through Sunday afternoon, followed by an offday on Monday, and then a 6-game series vs. the Toledo Mud Hens next week/weekend.

Record Breakdown - Worcester is 13-9 overall this season...6-4 here at Polar Park and 7-5 on the road. They have also played the same amount of day games (7-4 in those) as night games (6-5 in those) thus far. During the remaining four games vs. Syracuse, they will play two more night games and two more day games.

Where Things Stand – Worcester (13-9) comes into play tonight alone in 4th place in the International League East division and 3½-games behind Jacksonville who is atop the league with their 17-6 record.

Where The WooSox Rank – Worcester is 2nd in the International League in Team Batting (.265), they lead the 20-team league in both runs scored (123) and doubles (52), and are tied for 3rd in HR (24). Worcester pitching is 7th in the 20-team International League with a 3.90 Team ERA and they pace the league with 5 shutouts.

Take Home a Dozen or More – This current 13-game homestand is the longest in terms of games for Worcester this season. The WooSox do have another double figure homestand from July 29 – August 10 that will be 12-games including six vs. Lehigh Valley and six vs. Buffalo. Worcester has played seven extended homestands of 12 games or more - featuring two series each - during their first four years of existence. They have had four winners and three losers during their seven “long” homestands in WooSox history (the first two of which included Syracuse)...

This Season vs. Syracuse – The WooSox have taken a 4 games to 1 lead over the Mets in the season-series thanks to their three victories the past three days. The clubs met for what was originally to be a 3-game weekend series to begin the 2025 season here at Polar Park from March 28-30. Syracuse spoiled Worcester's home-opener on March 28 with a 4-3 victory, the clubs were rained out the next day, and then played a single game on March 30 with the WooSox gaining a split of the series with a 12-0 rout.

Last Season vs. Syracuse– The WooSox won the 2024 season-series over Syracuse by a 13-11 margin going 5-4 vs. the Mets here at Polar Park and finishing 8-7 in Syracuse. Worcester pitchers posted a 5.07 ERA with 29 HRA vs. Syracuse last year while Sox batters hit .250 with 27 HR. The WooSox out-scored the Mets, 133-122 in the 24 games.

All-Time vs. Syracuse - Pawtucket/Worcester leads the all-time series over Syracuse by a 485-465 count.

A Winning Tradition – The 2024 Worcester Red Sox went 79-71 to post a winning season for the fourth time in as many years of existence and for the third year in a row under manager Chad Tracy. Trace is only the second Red Sox Triple-A manager to ever post three consecutive winning seasons. Darrell Johnson did so from 1971-73 (the first two years when the Red Sox Triple-A club was in Louisville before moving to Pawtucket in 1973). Worcester finished 35-40 during the first half last year but then improved to 44-31 in the second half. Overall the 2024 WooSox went 40-34 at home and 39-37 on the road. The 2021 WooSox had a 74-54 record during their abbreviated inaugural season, the 2022 WooSox finished 75-73, and the 2023 club posted a 79-68 mark.

2024 WooSox Batters Led the Way – Worcester led all 20 International League clubs in a host of team offensive categories last season. The WooSox led the league with 869 runs scored (Scranton/Wilkes-Barre was next with 846 runs scored). The Sox also led the IL with 786 walks (Toledo was a distant 2nd with 676 walks). Worcester paced the league by a wide margin with an impressive .369 on-base pct. as the WooSox were the only team in the IL with an OBP of over .359 (Scranton/WB was 2nd at .358). Furthermore, Worcester had the 2nd best OPS in the league at .795 (Columbus was 1st at .804).

2024 Rankings – Worcester finished 5th in the IL in team batting with a .259 average. On the pitching side, the Sox were 10th in team ERA (4.84). Sox pitchers allowed the 2nd fewest HR in the league (141 HRA while Nashville had 139 HRA). Defensively, the WooSox were 11th with a .979 field pct. (107 errors in 5126 total chances).

Players Aplenty - The 2024 WooSox built on a pair of all-time Red Sox Triple-A records (previously set by the 2023 WooSox) as they made 281 player transactions during the 2024 campaign and set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players appearing in a single season. The WooSox used 84 different players in 2024 (37 position players and 47 pitchers) to better the mark of 79 players in 2023. Ironically, the 2021 WooSox broke a long-standing Red Sox Triple-A record when they used 72 different players to beat the 1995 Pawtucket Red Sox (during a strike year when replacement players were used for the first month+ of that season) and the 2006 PawSox who each employed 70 different players. When Chad Tracy made his Worcester debut in 2022, the WooSox quickly set a new record using 75 different players (that was immediately topped first in 2023 and again in 2024).

Sea Dog to Woofsters – A total of 22 different players were promoted from Double-A Portland to Triple-A Worcester last season.

PORTLAND SEA DOGS (AA) GAME RECAP – The Portland Sea Dogs (9-6) used a 4-run bottom of the 8th-inning to beat the Reading Fightin' Phils last night, 5-1. Jhostynxon Garcia delivered an RBI single to snap a 1-1 tie in the 8th. He had 2 hits and drove in the first Portland run as well. Blaze Jordan drilled a 2-run double to up the Portland lead to 4-1 and Drew Ehrhad (2 hits) added an RBI single to make the final, 5-1. Wyatt Olds (3-1) tossed 3 scoreless innings of relief to earn the victory.

WOOSOX PLAYER MOVES – The Boston Red Sox this morning recalled right-handed pitcher **Luis Guerrero** from Worcester and optioned right-handed pitcher **Josh Winckowski** to Worcester following last night's game against the Seattle Mariners.

Guerrero, 24, has pitched in eight games for the WooSox this season, recording a 5.23 ERA (6 ER/10.1 IP) with one save. Selected by the Red Sox in the 17th round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft, the right-hander made his MLB debut in 2024, allowing one run (zero earned runs) in 10.0 innings across nine appearances for Boston.

Winckowski, 26, threw 3.0 innings in last night's game against Seattle. The right-hander has pitched in six games for the Red Sox this season, posting a 3.86 ERA (5 ER/11.2 IP). He has also made two appearances for Worcester, striking out nine batters over 6.0 innings while allowing four runs (three earned). Originally selected by the Toronto Blue Jays in the 15th round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft, the Ohio native has posted a 4.20 ERA (113 ER/242.1 IP) with 195 strikeouts in 121 career games (21 starts) for the Red Sox (2022-25).

Since the start of the season (four weeks) the WooSox have sent RHP Hunter Dobbins (twice), RHP Robert Stock, C Blake Sabol, RHP Josh Winckowski, RHP Michael Fulmer, NF Nick Sogard, and RHP Luis Guerrero to Boston (although Stock, Sogard, Dobbins, and Winckowski are back with Worcester and Fulmer elected to become a free agent and signed with the Cubs following his outright assignment); RHP Quinn Priester was traded; and OF Corey Rosier and C Enderso Lira were sent to Double-A Portland (although Rosier rejoined the WooSox on April 20). All players involved are from the WooSox 2025 Opening Day Roster.
