LAST TIME OUT: In a game that saw numerous back-and-forth swings, the Cyclones failed to capture Sunday's series finale in Aberdeen, as the IronBirds capped the six-game set with a chaotic 11-10 see-saw affair of a win...Entering the ninth inning, Brooklyn trailed 8-6, only to jump out in front, 10-8, after a four-run top half of the frame - headlined by a two-run go-ahead home run from RF **Karell Paz**...The Cyclones' lead was short-lived, though, as DH **Tavian Josenberger** provided the heroics for Aberdeen with a walk-off three-run home run on the first pitch following a 19-minute rain delay... Three Cyclones enjoyed multi-hit games, including LF **Nick Morabito** who notched a season-high tying four hits in five trips to the plate.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES HISTORY: On July 1, 2001, **Mike Jacobs** clubs the first grand slam in franchise history vs. New Jersey...In the same contest, **Noel Devarez** becomes the first player in Cyclones history to record a three-home run game...In 2003, Brooklyn defeated Staten Island on the road, 7-3, to earn the 100th win in franchise history...In 2007, RHP **Luis Mateo** (6.0 IP), LHP **David Wynn** (2.0), and RHP **Tyler Vanderheiden** combined on a six-hit shutout, as the Cyclones blanked Hudson Valley on the road, 3-0...In 2015, RHP **Tyler Badamo** (7.0 IP), RHP **Craig Missigman** (1.0), and LHP **Carlos Valdez** (1.0) united on a two-hitter in Brooklyn's 7-0 win at Hudson Valley.

TRAVELING CIRCUS: Starting with Tuesday's game in Aberdeen, the Cyclones will have just six home games over the next 28 days...Brooklyn's next full six-game home series will take place from July 23-28 vs. Rome...So far, Brooklyn is 1-5 in the stretch... The Cyclones will play three games at home vs. Hudson Valley from July 1-3 and another three vs. Jersey Shore from July 19-21 immediately following the All-Star break...Brooklyn is also amid their longest stretch without an off day during the 2024 season...After Sunday's series finale, the Cyclones will play Monday, July 1, through Saturday, July 6, with three games on Coney Island and another three in Hudson Valley before back-to-back days off on July 7 and 8.

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP **Josh Hejka** was transferred to Double-A Binghamton on Monday morning...The submariner earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 63 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka accumulated a 6-3 record with a 2.41 ERA (28 ER in 104.2 IP) and eight saves, walking just 25 and striking out 95.

ROSTER MOVE: RHP **Victor Castañeda** was also transferred to Triple-A Syracuse on Monday...In 17 relief appearances for Brooklyn, the 25-year-old collected a 4-2 record with a 6.61 ERA (23 ER in 31.1 IP), allowing 35 hits, walking 12, and striking out 35.

NICK SQUARED: OF **Nick Morabito** and IF **Nick Lorusso** have been two of Brooklyn's biggest offensive contributors as of late...The duo combined for five hits in Sunday's loss to Aberdeen...Lorusso is eighth in the South Atlantic League in slugging (.483), tied for eighth in total bases (114) tied for ninth in OPS (.850), 10th in extra-base hits (27), and tied for 10th in RBI (40)...Lorusso is third among New York Mets' full-season minor leaguers in OPS (.850) and slugging (.483)...He is also tied for fourth in extra-base hits (27), home runs (11), RBI (40) and triples (3), and fifth in total bases (114)...Morabito is tied for 10th in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (34)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 7, the former second-round pick is tied for third in the league in steals (23) and tied for eighth in runs scored (31)...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.332), on-base percentage (.436), and stolen bases (34)...He also is second in hits (83) and OPS (.860), third in runs scored (45) and fifth in walks (39).

THE TONG SONG: RHP **Jonah Tong** tied a career-high with 11 strikeouts over 6.0 innings of one-run ball in a no-decision on Wednesday night in Aberdeen...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the 21-year-old is fourth in the circuit in ERA (3.38) and tied for fifth in strikeouts (56)...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the year...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 60.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is second in FIP (2.20), third in strikeout rate (35.9%), sixth in strikeout-to-walk rate (25.8%), and tied for 10th in strikeouts (92).

BROOKLYN-BOUND BÁEZ: INF **Jesús Báez** clobbered his first High-A home run in Saturday's loss and is 6-for-21 with a pair of doubles, two runs scored, and a stolen base through his first five games at the High-A level...Báez is the No. 15 prospect in the Mets' organization according to *Baseball America* and No. 22 by MLB Pipeline...At 19 years old, Báez checks in as the youngest player on Brooklyn's roster and is the first player in franchise history born in 2005...In 64 games at the Single-A level, Báez accumulated a .262 average (66-252) with 25 extra-base hits, 10 home runs, 39 RBI, and eight stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native departed the Florida State League with the most total bases (112) in the circuit...Báez was also second in hits (66), tied for second in home runs (10), RBI (39), and extra-base hits (25), fourth in runs scored (40), sixth in

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: Brooklyn will play a home-and-home six-game series against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...Hudson Valley boasts four of New York-AL's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: LHP **Kyle Carr** (11), INF **Roc Riggio** (18), INF **Jared Serna** (19), OF **Jace Avina** (28)...The Cyclones took 4-of-6 from Hudson Valley in the first meeting on Coney Island (May 23-28), but the Renegades to 4-of-6 from Brooklyn in their last meeting in Wappingers Falls (June 11-16)...In 2023, the Cyclones went 6-6 against Hudson Valley on Coney Island and 8-4 at Heritage Financial Park...Dating back to 2001, Brooklyn trails the all-time series, 146-150 (.493).

slugging (.444), and tied for sixth in doubles (16)...Among full-season Mets farmhands, the infielder is tied for first in doubles (16), second in total bases (123), third in hits (72) and extra-base hits (28), tied for fourth in runs scored (43), home runs (11), and RBI (40), and fifth in slugging (.451).

OMAR-I-GONE: OF **Omar De Los Santos** rejoined Brooklyn's roster last Monday from Double-A Binghamton...In 13 games with the Rumble Ponies after being transferred on May 20, the 24-year-old was 3-for-22 (.136) at the plate with two home runs, three runs batted in, and two stolen bases...Despite appearing in only three games for the Cyclones since May 19 at Bowling Green, De Los Santos is still sixth in the South Atlantic League with 28 stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT **Jaylen Palmer's** (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (65) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos is tied for fourth across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (137).

LOCATION, LOCATION: The Cyclones have several players with intriguing home and road splits in 2024...INF **Nick Lorusso** has mashed at Maimonides Park...In 27 home contests, the 23-year-old is hitting .357/.439/.684 with a 1123 OPS on Coney Island with six home runs, 18 RBI, and 13 walks to 15 strikeouts...Lorusso leads all South Atlantic League qualifiers in home batting average (.357), slugging (.684), OPS (1123), and is second in on-base percentage (.439)...In 36 road affairs, Lorusso hits .196/.317/.341 with a .658 OPS, adding five home runs and 22 RBI with 25 walks to 42 K's...On the other hand, OF **Nick Morabito** is loving his time on the road...He is hitting .333/.429/.444 with a .873 OPS, adding two home runs, seven RBI, and 22 stolen bases...Since his SAL debut, the 21-year-old is tied for the most road hits in the circuit (36)...He is also tied for third in runs scored (23) while swiping seven more bases (22) than any other player in the league...In Brooklyn, Morabito has collected a .250/.314/.281 line with a .595 OPS, two extra-base hits, an RBI, and a stolen base over 15 games...INF **Junior Tilién** has also thrived at home posting a .300/.357/.420 mark with a .777 OPS, two home runs, and 13 RBI in 28 games...On the road, Tilién is hitting .164/.266/.245 with a .511 OPS, a home run, and seven runs batted in over 30 contests.

RUSTED IRON: RHPs **Dakota Hawkins** (6.0 IP) and **Josh Hejka** (3.0) combined on a three-hit shutout in Friday's 7-0 win at Aberdeen...The shutout was the eighth of the year for the Cyclones' pitching staff and the first since Hawkins (5.0 IP), RHP **Joey Lancelotti** (1.0), and RHP **Joshua Cornielli** (3.0) combined on the first nine-inning no-hitter in franchise history vs. Aberdeen on June 4...Four of Brooklyn's eight shutouts in 2024 have come against the IronBirds...The Cyclones also blanked Aberdeen on May 3 and 4 on Coney Island...Since the start of 2023, eight of the 'Clones 19 shutouts (42.1%) have been against the 'Birds...Hawkins and Hejka combined to retire the final 19 batters in order in Friday's contest and did not allow a walk in the game...It was the first time Cyclones' pitching did not allow a free pass in a contest since a 1-0 loss at Greenville in Game 1 of a doubleheader on August 31, 2023...It was the first zero-walk performance by Brooklyn in a nine-inning game since an 8-5 win at Asheville on August 26, 2023.

SO LONG, STANLEY: OF **Stanley Consuegra** was transferred to Double-A Binghamton last Monday...Consuegra departs Brooklyn as the franchise's all-time leader in numerous offensive categories...Last Wednesday, the veteran surpassed UTL **Jaylen Palmer** (204) for the most games played in franchise history (209)...Consuegra also set the Cyclones' all-time doubles record (40) on June 8 vs. Aberdeen and the all-time hits mark (186) on May 29 at Jersey Shore...He is also the franchise's all-time leader in extra-base hits (81), home runs (35), RBI (121), and outfield assists (19)...Consuegra also holds the single-season mark for home runs (23), and extra-base hits (42), and is tied with INF **Ronny Mauricio** (63) for single-season RBI...Consuegra ended his time in Brooklyn with a bang, hitting .282/.389/.518 with a .907 OPS since May 17...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native had scored 16 runs and added eight doubles, six home runs, and 20 RBI...In that time, Consuegra was tied for fourth in the South Atlantic League in extra-base hits (14), tied for eighth in total bases (57), and ninth in slugging (.518).

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have four of the Top 30 per BA: **Jesús Báez** (15), **Kade Morris** (21), **Jonah Tong** (22) and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Báez (22), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his third-consecutive defeat last Tuesday night at Aberdeen...Yielded three runs on two hits in 2.2 innings...Walked a season-high four and struck out three...Plunked a batter...Threw 66 pitches and 34 strikes (51.52%)...Relieved by RHP **Victor Castañeda** with the bases loaded and two out in the bottom of the third and the Cyclones trailing 3-0... All three bequeathed runners were stranded...Brooklyn would drop the series opener to the IronBirds, 9-2.

CHANGE OF PLANS: Pintaro's final start for the Pioneer League's Glacier Range Riders (Kalispell, Mont.) was cut short due to great news...The 26-year-old tossed 2.0 innings of one-run ball against the Great Falls Voyagers on June 2 before being told by manager **Paul Fletcher** that he would not continue...Pintaro's day came to a close because his contract had been purchased by the New York Mets, officially signing the following day..."It was surreal. After the second inning I came to the dug-out and I heard him (Fletcher) say somebody get warm and I kind of gave him a look," said Pintaro to the *Daily Inter Lake*...In three starts for the Range Riders, Pintaro was 1-0 with a 4.40 ERA (7 ER in 14.1 IP), one walk, and 23 strikeouts...The Pelham, Ala. native had a 14.44 strikeouts-per-nine innings ratio in the MLB Partner circuit...Pintaro was teammates with 2024 BlueClaws INF **Chad Castillo** with the Range Riders.

REMEMBER ME?: Following the 2021 and 2022 collegiate seasons, Pintaro pitched for the Frederick (Md.) Keys of the MLB Draft League...During that time, the 26-year-old was a teammate of a few current and former Cyclones...In 2021, Pintaro pitched alongside RHP **Dylan Tebrake**, who was a member of the 2023 bullpen and is currently on Double-A Binghamton's 60-day injured list...During the 2022 season, the Shorter University alum was a teammate of RHP **Jordan Geber** (2023-24) who is currently with Double-A Binghamton and current Cyclones RHP **Jonah Tong**...In 25 games (17 starts) for the Keys, Pintaro was 3-9 with a 4.55 ERA (44 ER in 87.0 IP), 41 walks, and 108 strikeouts.

SHORTER STACK: Pintaro became the first Shorter University alum to sign a contract with a Major League team since becoming an NCAA program in 2013...During his time with the Hawks, the Alabama native was Gulf South Conference Pitcher of the Year in 2021 and 2022...Pintaro accumulated a 20-7 record with a 3.19 ERA (70 ER in 197.1 IP), 76 walks, and 286 strikeouts during those two seasons...Shorter is located in Rome, Ga. and its campus is located 3.7 miles southwest of the Rome Emperors' AdventHealth Stadium.
