SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

ONE MORE TIME: Today marks the final game between the Shuckers and M-Braves at Trustmark Park in franchise history (since 2015)... The M-Braves will move to Columbus, Georgia for the 2025 season, remaining as the Double-A affiliate of the Atlanta Braves... Since 2015, the Shuckers have played 111 games at Trustmark Park with a record of 60-51, a .541 winning percentage.

<u>THAT OFFENSE IS ON FIRE</u>: The Shuckers have outscored the M-Braves 36-19 in five games this week split between Keesler Federal Park and Trustmark Park, a +17 run differential... The Shuckers are among the Double-A leaders this week in runs (3rd, 36), on-base percentage (4th, .397), doubles (T-5th, 11), OPS (7th, .810) and average (8th, .285).

<u>LATE INNING OFFENSE</u>: The Shuckers have combined to score 14 runs off the M-Braves bullpen in the first two games of their current three-game series, the second-most in Double-A... The Shuckers also hold a .379/.486/.517 slash line against the bullpen over 5.1 innings in this series.

SPARKS FLY ON THE FOURTH: OF Lamar Sparks tied the Shuckers single-game record [since 2015] with 5 hits in a 5-for-5 performance on Thursday... The five-hit game was the fifth in franchise history... Sparks joined OF Carlos Rodriguez, who achieved the feat on May 1 at Tennessee, as the second Shuckers player with a five-hit game this season... - Over five games against the M-Braves this week, Sparks is tied for the Double-A lead with 12 hits... Sparks is 12-for-22 with 2 doubles, a triple, home run and 5 RBI.

A PERFECT 10 (OR 12): The Shuckers joined the Montgomery Biscuits as the second team to score at least 10 runs at Trustmark Park this season with 12 runs on Thursday night... The game marked the most runs scored by the Shuckers at Trustmark Park since August 18, 2023, in a 12-3 win... It was the sixth time the Shuckers have scored at least 10 runs at Trustmark Park in franchise history (since 2015), with five of the six games coming after the start of the 2021 season.

<u>STARTING OFF ON THE RIGHT FOOT</u>: Over the past four games, the Shuckers starting rotation have combined to allow two earned runs in 17.0 innings, a 1.06 ERA... In 17 games against the M-Braves in 2024, the Shuckers pitching staff has a 2.36 ERA, including a Southern League-best (min. 10gp) 2.23 ERA from the starting rotation.

FIVE'S THE MAGIC NUMBER: Entering today, the Shuckers are 26-6 when they score at least five runs in a game, an .813 winning percentage... The Shuckers have won 14 of their last 17 games since June 1 when they've scored at least five runs, including wins in 10 of their last 11... The Shuckers have scored at least five runs in 17 of their last 29 games.

<u>TODAY'S STARTER // RHP JACOB MISIOROWSKI [2-3, 3.58]</u>: Misiorowski makes his team-leading 16th start of the season and his third against the M-Braves... Misiorowski has worked into the sixth in two of his last three starts, including a season-high eight strikeouts on June 25 against Pensacola.
