RISPY BUSINESS: In a series where Somerset has scored just 9 runs across the first 4 games, the Patriots have just 2 hits (2-for-17) with RISP. Going back to Sunday, the Patriots are 3-for-30 with RISP (5 games). The Patriots didn't have any RISP on Thursday and none of their hits with RISP this series have brought home runs.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT: All 4 games of this series have been decided by 3 runs or less. During the month of May, 15/22 games the Patriots have played have been decided by 3 runs or less. In total, Somerset has had 26 of their first 42 games decided by 3 runs or less, going 14-12 in these games. Out of 10 games played between Portland and Somerset this season, 7 have been decided by 3 or fewer runs. The Patriots are 13-3 in games decided by 4+ runs.

DANGER ZONE: The Patriots took over sole possession of first place in the Eastern League exactly one month ago today. They broke a tie with Portland when they won 15-3 on April 28th. From that day until the first game of this series, the Patriots went 16-5 over a three-week stretch, leading the Eastern League by as much as 4 games (5/4). Now only a half game over Hartford, the Patriots are in danger of potentially ending the day in 2nd place.

NO LUCK VS. THE LEFTIES: On Thursday, the Patriots dropped to 4-8 in games started by left-handed pitchers, which is already more losses than they have in games started by righties (23-7), in less than half the amount of games. Somerset is hitting .222 with a .677 OPS and 10 HR vs. LHP and they're hitting .239 with a .772 OPS and 47 HR vs. righties.

- Named 2022 Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for 4/25-5/1, after he threw seven scoreless one-hit innings vs. Portland on May 1 with six strikeouts.
- Spent bulk of 2021 with High-A Hudson Valley, going 4-4 with a 2.57 ERA and ranking third on the Renegades' pitching staff with 70.0 IP and 73 K.
- He was named the High-A East Pitcher of the Week, when he started against Aberdeen and struck out a career-high 10 over six scoreless innings with 3 H and 1 BB. He would pitch one more game for Hudson Valley, before earning a promotion to Double-A Somerset on 8/1/21, ending the season with eight starts and 46.2 IP, where he collected a 5.01 ERA.
- Would have been Rule 5 eligible this season had the Rule 5 Draft not have been cancelled due to logistics complications caused by the MLB lockout.
- Appeared in this first two MLB Spring Training games in 2022, combined for 4.2 IP, 2 R, 6 H, 5 K, 3 BB (1.93 ERA).
- Spent entire 2019 season with Low-A Charleston, toting a 3.58 ERA over 100.2 innings spread across 22 appearances that included nine starts.
- In 2017, he pitched in three games for Short-season Staten Island, before injury that prompted Tommy John surgery and caused him to miss the remainder of the 2017 season, plus 2018.
- Made his pro debut in 2016 splitting his season with DSL and GCL Yankees.

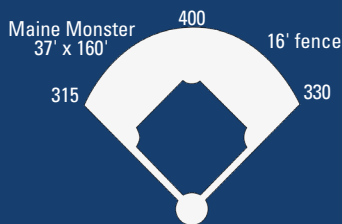

COACHING STAFF



DAN FIORITO ★ MANAGER

Born and raised in Yonkers, NY, Dan Fiorito enters his sixth season with the Yankees organization and his first as Somerset's manager. Fiorito is also the Yankees' Roving Upper Level IF/OF Instructor. He served as the manager of High-A Hudson Valley in 2021, after making his managerial debut in 2019 with the GCL Yankees East. Fiorito also had been slated to manage the Yankees' former short-season Single-A affiliate, Staten Island in 2020, before the minor league season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. He served as the defensive coach at the Yankees' former Single-A Charleston affiliate in 2018, after making his professional coaching debut as defensive coach with the Yankees' former Rookie-level Pulaski affiliate in 2017.

His playing career began when he was signed by the Yankees as a non-drafted free agent in 2012. Over four seasons as an infielder in the Yankees system, he batted .240 (264-for-1102) with 107 runs, 52 doubles, six triples, seven home runs and 98 RBI in 322 career minor league games. Fiorito played three years at Manhattanville College (Purchase, NY) and is a 2008 graduate of Fordham Prep (Bronx, NY).



GERARDO CASADIEGO ★ PITCHING COACH

Gerardo Casadiego will begin his first season in Somerset and 10th in the Yankees organization. He held the same position in Hudson Valley last season, where the Renegade staff ranked second in the High-A East division in strikeouts (1,308, sixth in MiLB) and third in ERA (4.12). The Venezuela native has also previously served as the pitching coach for former Rookie-level Pulaski (2017-2019), DSL Yankees 1 (2014-2015) and DSL Yankees 2 (2016).

JAKE HIRST ★ HITTING COACH

Jacob Hirst will serve as hitting coach in his first season with Somerset and fourth with the Yankees organization. He was the hitting coach for Hudson Valley in 2021, when the Renegades' batters ranked second among High-A East clubs in triples (33) and OBP (.341), third in doubles (217) and fourth in home runs (156), batting average (.255), slugging percentage (.446) and OPS (.787). The Iowa native served the same role with the GCL Yankees West (2019-2020).



AARON BOSSI ★ DEFENSIVE COACH

Aaron Bossi begins his first season with Somerset after making his coaching debut in the same role with Hudson Valley in 2021. His prior experience for the organization was assisting rehabbing players at the minor league complex from 2017-2019. The St. Louis, MO native was signed as a non-drafted free agent by the Yankees on June 24, 2016 as a catcher/infielder. He played in 22 games for the GCL Yankees East in 2016.
