RENO TAKES GAME ONE

Round Rock fell by a final score of 4-1 on Tuesday night to Reno. The Aces jumped on the board early when a single from 2B Kolten Wong scored DH Kyle Garlick in the top of the first inning. Reno increased their lead to 3-0 in the fourth inning thanks to a double off the bat of RF Brett Johnson that sent Wong and LF Bryson Brigman across home plate. Round Rock posted their lone run of the night in the fifth. LF Dustin Harris worked a two-out walk before moving to second base on a wild pitch then scoring thanks to a single from DH Andrew Knapp. Garlick blasted a solo home run in the seventh frame to give the Aces a 4-1 advantage. The Express put three runners on base during the bottom of the ninth inning with two walks and one single, but a double play and strikeout ended any comeback hopes and sealed the 4-1 final.

STEADY SAMPSON

RHP Adrian Sampson is scheduled to make his eighth start of the season on Wednesday. In his last four starts. Sampson is 4-0 with a 2.35 ERA (6 ER/23.0 IP) with six walks and 16 strikeouts. This season, lefties are batting .219 (14-64) against him while righties are hitting .317 (26-82).

IT HAS BEEN A WHILE

Round Rock has lost back-to-back games for the first time since April 17-18. The Express are 14-7 since they lost seven consecutive games from April 11-18. The E-Train have won their last three

TAKE A KNAPP

Express C Andrew Knapp finished yesterday 2-for-2 with an RBI and three walks. Through his first 30 games this year, he is slashing .354/.452/.535 with six doubles, four home runs, 19 RBI, 19 runs scored, 19 walks and only 30 strikeouts. He is second in the Pacific Coast League in batting average, first in onbase percentage and eighth in OPS.

AVERAGE AGE

Prior to the start of the series with Reno, the five scheduled starters that Round Rock named have an average age of 30.5. The average age of players in the Pacific Coast League is 27.7 years old.

STOLEN BASES

Express OF Dustin Harris stole his 12th base of the season on Tuesday. He is now fifth in the PCL in swiped bases and is one of only 12 players with 10 or more stolen bases. The lefty has stolen 41 percent of the total swiped bags for Round Rock this year. The Express and Aces have collected the least amount of stolen bases in the PCL as Round Rock has stolen 29 while Reno has only taken 21. Tacoma leads the league with 85 stolen bags.

SHREVE IS A SURE THING

Round Rock LHP Chasen Shreve retired all four batters he faced on Tuesday and collected a strikeout. He has not allowed an earned run in his last 5.1 innings and five outings. He has posted a 2.31 ERA (3 ER/11.2 IP) for the E-Train this season.

RUNNERS IN SCORING POSITION

The Express went 1-for-16 with runners in scoring position on Tuesday night and left 12 men on base for the game.

ALCS EXPRESS REUNION

Round Rock was previously a member of the Houston Astros organization from 2019-2020. EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win

campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.

Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
