- The force was strong in Cristian Feliz on Saturday night. Dunedin's first baseman belted two homers- including the go-ahead shot in the eighth- to propel the Blue Jays to a 6-5 win over Tampa at TD Ballpark.
- The Jays fell behind in the second, as Manuel Palencia poked an RBI single off starter Nolan Perry. Dunedin's starter bounced back by stranding runners on first and second, and then did the same in the third.
- Jean Joseph got the Blue Jays on the board, swiping home on a double steal in the bottom of the third.
- Tampa jumped ahead again in the fifth, 3-1, pushing across two runs against Keiner Leon an RBI ground out from Roderick Arias, and a solo homer from Dylan Jasso.
- Joseph delivered again in the fifth, popping his first homer of the season over the fence in left to make it 3-2.
- Tarpons starter Josh Grosz pitched into the sixth, striking out 12 in the process, but the Jays made some two out noise. After an error from Arias, Feliz ripped a two-run homer to right to put the Jays ahead 4-3.
- Jasso belted his second homer of the night in the seventh, a two-run blast, to put Tampa back ahead 5-4.
- Dunedin got the last laugh, as Feliz came to the plate in the eighth and hit a massive shot out of the ballpark to right another two-run, go-ahead homer that put the Blue Jays ahead for good.

SUPER 8TH

The Blue Jays eighth inning magic continued last night with Cristian Feliz's two-run go-ahead home run. With the blast, Dunedin has tallied 10 runs in the eighth inning in the last four games.

FANTASTIC MR. FELIZ

Cristian Feliz's two-homer performance last night marked the first by a Blue Jay this season. Feliz's second homer traveled 431 feet - the 5th longest homer in the Florida State League this season. Dunedin's last two-homer game came from Jace Bohrofen on August 16 last year.

HIGH FIVE!

After being held to four or fewer runs in 11 consecutive games, the Blue Jays have scored five or more in back-to-back contests. Dunedin is 10-2 when scoring five or more runs this season.

GOT YOUR NUMBER

Blue Jays pitchers have held Yankees No. 3 prospect Roderick Arias without a hit this week, as the middle infielder has gone 0-17 with 10 strikeouts.

SLIMMEST OF MARGINS

13 of the Blue Jays' last 14 contests have been decided by four or fewer runs. Dunedin has gone 4-9 in those games. Thursday night's 6-run win by the Tarpons marked Dunedin's first game decided by more than four runs in over two weeks (April 17 vs Clearwater). Eight of the team's first 11 games were decided by four or more runs.

K COUNTER

Three Tampa starters have racked up nine or more strikeouts this week, including Josh Grosz's 12 last night. Dunedin has struck out 61 times this week (over 12 per game). However, the Blue Jays' pitching staff has racked up 63 strikeouts.

IN THE ARIAS TONIGHT

Victor Arias ranks among the league's leading hitters in nearly every major rate stat. Arias is top 10 in average (6th - .323), OBP (7th - .413), SLG (8th - .477), and OPS (7th - .890). Arias has more multi-hit games (7) than hitless games (5), but has gone hitless the last two nights.

NO SUCH THING AS A FREE PASS

For the first time this season, the Blue Jays failed to draw a walk last night. Walks have come at a premium this week, as Tampa's pitchers have issued just eight. Dunedin has issued 13. The Tarpons are tied for the league lead in walks drawn with 128.

YOUNG GUN

Dunedin shortstop Arjun Nimmala is the second-youngest player in the Florida State league to open the season, at 18.5 years old (behind Daytona's Alfredo Duno at 18.2). Maykel Minoso joins Nimmala as the second 18 year old on the Blue Jays' roster.
