SUNDAY: The Captains suffered their third straight loss to the Lansing Lugnuts with a 12-4 defeat at Classic Park. Lansing scored in seven of the nine innings on Sunday, only failing to score in the fifth and sixth. All four Captains runs came in the third inning when four consecutive Captains batters delivered extra-base-hits, highlighted by back-to-back homers by George Valera and Micah Pries. That outburst tied the game at 4-4, but Lansing went on to score eight unanswered runs to take the game.

LAST SERIES: The Captains lost four of six games to the Lugnuts at Classic Park. Lake County lost the last three games of the series to drop the series. The Captains were outscored in the series, 35-23 (-12 run

PLAYOFF PICTURE: The Captains enter today one game behind the Great Lakes Loons and Cedar Rapids Kernels for the second playoff spot in the High-A Central League (HAC). Lake County, Great Lakes, Cedar Rapids Kernels and the Dayton Dragons are all separated by just 2.0 games. The Quad Cities River Bandits currently hold the top playoff spot and are 11 games ahead of Great Lakes and Cedar Rapids. The top two teams in the HAC earn playoff bids (regardless of division).

LIFT OFF: The Captains' pitching staff has allowed the most home runs in the High-A Central League since July 1 (49). Lake County's offense has the third-most homers in the league in that span (40).

VALERA RAKES AND TAKES: George Valera is 6-for-21 with four homers and eight walks in August. Since July 1, Valera has more walks (31) than strikeouts (29) and a 22.3 BB% (up from 11.1 in May-June). For the season, Valera's 18.5 BB% is the second-base in the league, his .274 ISO is third-best and his 154 wRC+ is tied for third-best (all minimum 210 plate appearances).

ALL OR NOTHING: José Tena has a team-best 24 multi-hit games, compared to 24 one-hit games and 25 zero-hit games. 68.1% of Tena's hits have come in multi-hit games (56 of 81). He is hitting .577 (56-for-97) in multi-hit games and .133 (25-for-188) in all other contests.

HOME COOKIN' TASTES BETTER: The Captains are 22-14 at home, compared to 22-26 on the road. In their last two home series, however, the Captains are 4-8.

ALUMNI UPDATE: 2017 Captains RHP Justin Garza became the 102<sup>nd</sup> former Captain to reach the major leagues when he debuted for Cleveland on June 27. A record 10 former Captains have made their major league debuts this year – OF Ka'ai Tom (2016), RHP Luis Oviedo (2018-19), LHP Sam Hentges (2016), RHP Louis Head (2012-13), RHP Nick Sandlin (2018), INF Ivan Castillo (2014), Jean Carlos Mejia (2018), RHP Eli Morgan (2018), INF Ernie Clement (2018) and Garza. That breaks the record for the most former Captains to debut in a single year, besting the nine alumni that debuted in 2013 and 2016.

HIGH-A: The 2021 season marks the Captains' first as the High-A Affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. Lake County had been Cleveland's Low-A Affiliate for 17 seasons (2003-2019) and 18 years (2003-2020).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Coulter earned his second straight win last Tuesday, holding Lansing to two runs over five innings at Classic Park. Both Lansing runs came in the second inning on a two-run homer by William Simoneit. Coulter scattered four other hits, walked two and struck out four. He retired the last six batters he faced. Lake County defeated Lansing, 8-4.

**TURNING IT AROUND:** Coulter has posted a 3.08 ERA since the beginning of July with 21 strikeouts, compared to five walks (4.2 K/BB). In May and June, Coulter had an 8.31 ERA with 26 strikeouts, compared to 12 walks (2.17 K/BB).

**2019:** Across 18 appearances Coulter compiled 36.1 innings out of the bullpen in the Arizona league and finished the season with a 2.23 ERA. After allowing at least one earned run in his first four appearances Coulter found his rhythm in July, only giving up one earned run eight appearances and 14.1 innings in the month. He began to stretch his arm out in August finishing the season with three straight appearances in which he threw three or more innings.

**BEAR DOWN:** Coulter had an up and down career at Mercer where he finished with a career 4.74 ERA. He bounced back and forth between a starting role and the bullpen where he accumulated five saves across his four-year career, including three as a senior in the first three games of the Bears season. His best season came as a senior. After starting the year in the bullpen he was moved to the rotation where he made 11 consecutive starts before bouncing back to the 'pen to finish the season. He completed the 2019 season with a career best 3.90 ERA.

**THREE SPORT STAR:** While at Buford High School Coulter starred as a basketball player and runner on the cross country team as well as the diamond. In 2015 he led the Wolves to a state championship his senior season.
