SPRINGFIELD CARDINALS (18-26) vs. ARKANSAS TRAVELERS (27-17)

LHP BRADEN DAVIS (0-3, 7.18 ERA) vs. RHP ADAM LEVERETT (1-1, 5.22 ERA)

SETTING THE SCENE: The Cardinals wrap up their 12-game road trip with the final game of a 6-game series against the Travelers (Mariners) in Arkansas ... Springfield is 2-3 in the series and 6-5 on the road trip ... LHP Braden Davis starts vs. RHP Adam Leverett ... Travs are in 1st in the North Division, 9.0 games up on the Cards.

BRADEN'S BALL: LHP Braden Davis makes his 9th start of the season and his 1st vs. Arkansas ... in his last start on 5/17 at Tulsa he allowed 5 runs on 3 hits over 2.2 innings ... struck out 2 and walked a season-high 5 batters ... has struck out 8 batters in his last 4 starts after striking out 28 batters over his first 4 starts.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Springfield shut out the Travs, 6-0, on Saturday night ... was the Cardinals' first shutout win of the season ... IF Noah Mendlinger finished 2x3 with a double, 2 walks, and 2 RBI ... Cards jumped out to an early 3-0 lead on RHP Ryan Sloan and added 3 more in the 6th.

CIJN-SATIONAL: SHP Jurrangelo Cijntje threw 6.0-scoreless innings in his start on Saturday to lead the Cardinals to their shutout win in Arkansas ... marked Springfield's first 6.0+ inning start and first quality start of the season ... struck out 7 batters and allowed only 2 hits ... was the club's longest start since Cijntje went 5.2 innings on Opening Night at Amarillo on 4/3 ... was his first start against his former team ... went 1-0 with a 2.67 ERA in 7 starts with the Travelers at the end of last season ... struck out 37 in 33.2 IP ... started once vs. Springfield on 8/22/25 and allowed 2 ER with 9 strikeouts over 4.2 IP.

STORY ARK: Tonight's game is the 6th of 24 in the season series and the 6th of 12 in North Little Rock ... the Cardinals finished 9-15 against the Travelers in 2025 and 4-8 in road games.

IT'S A TRIP: The Cardinals close out their season-long 12-game road trip tonight ... are 6-5 on the trip against the top 2 teams in the North Division and can finish with a +.500 record with a win.

TABLE SETTER: IF Noah Mendlinger is hitting .310 (9x29) with 12 walks and just 2 strikeouts during the current road trip ... has only struck out twice hitting out of the leadoff spot.

CASE OF THE MONDAYS: The Cardinals will "work" on Monday for the 1st and only time this season with a 4:35 p.m. game at Route 66 Stadium in honor of Memorial Day.

DOUBLE DEBUT: Two former Springbirds, IF Bryan Torres and LHP Brycen Mautz, joined the big league club this weekend ... Torres debuted on Saturday and had 3 hits in a doubleheader at Cincinnati including his first home run ... he won the TXL batting title in 2024 when he hit .331 in 121 games ... Mautz's Sunday debut on the mound was postponed ... he was the Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2026 after going 8-3 with a 2.98 ERA for Springfield.
