YESTERDAY: George Valera homered and reached base six times white Daniel Espino struck out ten batters over five scoreless and hitless innings in a 9-2 Captains win. Lake County scored first on a first inning Valera two-run home run. In the bottom of the first inning the Captains escaped a bases loaded with no outs situation by turning a bizarre 4-3-5-2 double play on a soft fly ball to center field where they got two Dayton runners caught between third base and home to end the inning. Espino settled in following the first, striking out the side in the second and the fifth. The Captains added three runs in the second, and three more in the third before Dayton got on the scoreboard with two unearned runs in the sixth. The Captains added a final tally in the eighth to win 9-2.

TOP OF THE HEAP: The Captains enter today in first place in the High-A Central League East Division. They have held at least a share of first place since their win on Sunday, but had previously not been in first since May 26. That date is also the last time the Captains held a share of a playoff position, but that was before Major League Baseball's July 1 announcement that there would be postseason baseball in the minors this season.

PLAYOFF PICTURE: The Captains enter today 2.0 game behind the Cedar Rapids Kernels for the second playoff spot in the High-A Central League (HAC). Lake County, Cedar Rapids, the Dayton Dragons and the Great Lakes Loons are all separated by just 4.0 games. The Quad Cities River Bandits currently hold the top playoff spot and are 10.0 games ahead of second place. The top two teams in the HAC earn playoff bids (regardless of division).

NINE INNINGS? WHAT'S THAT?: Only three of the last nine Captains games have ended after nine innings. Lake County has played five seven-inning games and one 12-inning game in that span.

NO TRAFFIC: In the month of August, the Captains' pitching staff owns the league's lowest WHIP (1.08), has allowed the fewest hits (112), has the second lowest ERA (3.64) and has the second-lowest batting average against (.203). Their hit total and WHIP are both the lowest in all of High-A, while their ERA and batting average against is third-lowest.

SIT 'EM DOWN: The Captains' starting staff is enjoying its best strikeout month of the season. Lake County starters are averaging a season-high 12.0 K/9 in August (115 K, 86.1 IP). Their 4.00 K/BB rate is also a season-best (29 BB), four of the Captains' six 10-strikeout games have come in August. The other two were on July 24 and 30.

LEADING THE PACK: George Valera leads the High-A Central in OPS (.983), second in on-base percentage .428), third in walks (52), tied for fourth in home runs (16) and fourth in slugging percentage (.556).

NO REST, NO PROBLEM: George Valera has played 25 consecutive games. Since his last game off (July 23), Valera is slashing .270/.481/.635 (1.116 OPS). Valera has eight homers and more walks (29) than strikeouts (22).

HOME COOKIN' TASTES BETTER: The Captains are 26-16 at home, compared to 25-28 on the road.

ALUMNI UPDATE: 2018 Captains LHP Francisco Perez became the 103rd former Captain to reach the major leagues when he debuted for Cleveland on August 12. A record 11 former Captains have made their major league debuts this year - OF Ka'ai Tom (2016), RHP Luis Oviedo (2018-19), LHP Sam Hentges (2016), RHP Louis Head (2012-13), RHP Nick Sandlin (2018), INF Ivan Castillo (2014), Jean Carlos Mejia (2018), RHP Eli Morgan (2018), INF Ernie Clement (2018) and RHP Justin Garza and Perez. That breaks the record for the most former Captains to debut in a single year, besting the nine alumni that debuted in 2013 and 2016.

**LAST TIME OUT:** After giving up two runs in the first inning, Hickman retired the last 14 batters he faced last Sunday against the West Michigan Whitecaps at Classic Park. Hickman held the West Michigan Whitecaps to just two runs on two hits over five innings. He did not factor in the decision, as the Captains won in 12 innings, 4-3, on a walk-off single by **Julian Escobedo**.

**COLLEGE ACCOLADES:** Hickman was named a Preseason All-American by *Collegiate Game*, and Second Team Preseason All-America by *Perfect Game* before the shortened 2020 season.

**2020 DRAFT:** Cleveland selected Hickman in the fifth round (154<sup>th</sup> overall) of the 2020 draft, which was shortened to five rounds. This was considered a bit of a steal by some outlets with both *Perfect Game* and *Baseball America* ranking Hickman as the 65<sup>th</sup> best draft prospect entering the draft.

**COLLEGE WORLD SERIES CLINCHER:** Hickman's shining moment at Vanderbilt came in 2019 as he helped lead the Commodores to their second National Championship in school history. In the series clinching win, Hickman started for Vanderbilt tossing six strong innings, allowing just one run while fanning 10 Wolverines in the 8-2 win. He also started in the CWS semifinals against Louisville throwing six scoreless frames and surrendering just two hits with three strikeouts. In four total NCAA Tournament starts he went 2-0 with a 1.57 ERA in 23 innings.

**CAPTAINS AND VANDY**: Hickman is just the second Captain ever to come out Vanderbilt. The first and only other Commodore to come to Lake County was catcher on the 2003 Captains and Lake County Manager in 2012, David Wallace.

**STAFF LEADER:** In 2019 Hickman found himself starting 2019 out of the bullpen despite being the teams Sunday starter as a freshman, appearing out of the bullpen three times in 2018. After coming out of the pen in his first six appearances of 2019 with a 2.50 ERA Hickman rejoined the rotation and thrived. He finished the year with a 2.05 ERA to lead the team and finish 4th in the SEC.

**COACHES WORDS:** Hickman worked with Tim Corbin at Vanderbilt who has built a powerhouse in Nashville churning out top baseball talent. In recent years Walker Buehler, Sonny Gray and David Price among others have all starred in the big leagues after pitching for Vandy. Corbin says "Mason has turned into one of the most dependable and reliable starting pitchers that we have had in our program. He continues to develop and get better as his craft while taking on a leadership role on our pitching staff. He is a quality young man that excels in the classroom as well. Very competitive in everything that he does."

**STRIKEOUT BUMP:** After striking out just eight batters per nine innings as a freshman in Nashville, Hickman saw an increase in whiffs towards the end of his sophomore season. In his final six starts of the season he struck out nine or more batters five times. He finished 2019 with 129 strikeouts to finish 13<sup>th</sup> in the country and struck out 12 per nine innings.

PROFESSIONAL STAFF: The teammates Hickman worked with at Vanderbilt have been highly regarded around baseball. Pitchers that Hickman joined in the clubhouse that have recently been drafted include Tyler Brown (2020, HOU), Jake Eder (2020, MIA), Drake Fellows (2019, SD), Zach King (2019, MIA), Jackson Gillis (2019, MIL), Joe Gobillot (2019, TB), AJ Franklin (2019, KC), Patrick Raby (2019, CIN), Maddux Conger (2018, DET) and Justin Wilson (2018, NYY). In 2021, Commodores Kumar Rocker and Jack Leiter are both expected to be first round draft picks in 2021 and were teammates of Hickman's in 2019 and 2020. Vanderbilt has also had 12 position players since 2018.
