CARDINALS TOPPED BY WIND SURGE IN SERIES OPENER: Bryan

Torres went 3-for-3 and RJ Yeager homered for the 2nd straight game but a late Springfield rally came up short in a 4-3 loss to the Wichita Wind Surge on Tuesday night at Riverfront Stadium. **Matt Lloyd** drove in 2 runs with a double in the 8th inning for Springfield to his team-leading RBI total to 65 and **Michael Siani** went 0-for-3 in his first rehab appearance. **Zane Mills** and **Leonard Taveras** retired all 12 batters they faced in 4.0 innings in relief of starter **Brandon Komar**. The Cards have lost back-to-back games for just the 3rd time since July 1.



OPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **CJ Culpepper** makes his 3rd start with the Wind Surge this season...Surrendered 4 ER on 2 H with 4 BB and 2 K over 2.2 IP in his last start on Wednesday last week at Midland...Did not factor in the decision...Allowed 3 ER on 4 H in 2.2 IP in his Double-A debut on August 15 at home against Arkansas...Began the season with High-A Cedar Rapids where he went 2-2 with a 2.89 ERA in 10 appearances (9 starts)...Last win came on May 23...Spent about 2 months on the Injured List (May 29-July 28) with a forearm strain...Has not thrown more than 62 pitches or 3.0 innings since his return...Split the 2023 season between the two A-ball levels (Low-A Fort Myers and Cedar Rapids) and went a combined 6-5 with a 3.56 ERA over 21 starts...Struck out 89 K over 86.0 IP...Made one appearance in the FCL in 2022 in his pro debut...Selected by the Twins in the 13th round of the 2022 draft out of Cal Baptist as a draft-eligible sophomore...Earned 2nd team all-WAC as a sophomore in 2022 going 5-3 with a 3.26 ERA...3rd team All-American by NCBWA and Freshman All-American in 2021...22 yeras old

CARDS WRAP UP SEASON SERIES WITH WIND SURGE IN SIX-GAME SERIES: With just 3 weeks left in the regular season, the Springfield Cardinals head to the Sunflower State for a six-game series against the Wichita Wind Surge (Double-A, Minnesota Twins) at Riverfront Stadium. CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD



The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

ON PAGE...: With 70 wins through their first 121 games, the Cardinals are on pace to win 80 games in 2024, which would eclipse the franchise record for wins in a season. The current record is 77 wins which as been achieved twice: 2017 (77-63) and the Texas League title year of 2012 (77-61). Springfield has reaced the 70-win mark 9 other times in franchise history, and has done it in consecutive seasons for the first time since 2009-10. The Cards went 72-66 last season.

LONG, HOT SUMMER: Since the beginning of July, no other team in Double-A has won more games than the Springfield Cardinals. The Cards are 31-15 since July 1, the best record in the Texas League during that time, and 2nd-best in Double-A behind the Tennessee Smokies. Springfield since the calendar flipped to July is 5-1-2 in series and has the best batting average below Triple-A at .277. The Cardinals have an ERA during that time of 3.85, which is 3rd-best in the Texas League. Through the end of June Springfield sported a 4.75 ERA.

ROAD WARRIORS: For the duration of the 2024 season to this point, the Cardinals have been the best road team in the Texas League by a wide margin. Springfield is 36-21 (.632) away from Hammons Field this season, well ahead of the 2nd-best road record belonging to Frisco (32-26, .559). The best road record in Double-A belongs to the Binghamton Rumble Ponies (NYM) of the Eastern League who are 37-19 (.661).

CARDIAC CARDS: Over their last 13 games, the Cardinals have saved their best work for late in games. Despite trailing in the 7th inning or later in 8 of their last 13 games, Springfield is 10-3 during that time. The Cards outscored their opponents 30-9 in the 8th inning or later, and walked off on the Drillers in 3 of the 6 games of last week's series at Hammons Field.

POWER SURGE: After getting off to a slow start in the power category to start the 2024 season, the Cardinals have already eclipsed their home run total from the first half. With 49 longballs in 52 games, Springfield is on pace to hit 65 HR in the 2nd half after hitting just 37 in the 1st half. Springfield has the highest OBP (.351) and OPS (.764) in the Texas League and has scored 12 more runs (277) than any other club in all of Double-A in the 2nd half (since June 24). The Birds ranked 6th in SLG (.361) and 5th in OPS (.712) in the Texas League in the 1st half.

FOR STARTERS: The Cardinals starting rotation has been up and down this season but has been one of the best units in the league since the calendar turned to August. Springfield's starters since August 1 have the 2nd-best ERA in the Texas League at 2.48, trailing only Midland (2.12). Opposing hitters are batting just .230 against Cardinal starters since the calendar flipped. Last week against the Drillers, Springfield starters compiled the best mark in the league with a 1.32 ERA while going 2-0 and racking up 33 K in 34.0 IP with a .202 BAA. The Cards are 3rd in the Texas League with a 3.40 ERA in August.

ON ANOTHER PLANET: Among qualified hitters in the Texas League, nobody has been swinging a hotter bat in the month of August than Cardinals INF/OF **Bryan Torres**. **Torres** is batting .456 through 20 games in the month with 7 2B, a home run and 11 RBI while compiling a .527 OBP and 1.109 OPS. He has recorded multiple hits in 10 of his last 13 games and is a scorching-hot .536 (30-for-56) since August 10. The Texas League Player of the Week for August 12-18, **Torres** leads the league in hitting (.335), OBP (.423), hits (133) and runs (72).

SIANI REHABBING: St. Louis Cardinals rookie OF **Michael Siani** joins Springfield for a rehab stint starting on Tuesday when he went 0-for-3 batting 2nd. In 101 games with St. Louis this season **Siani** is batting .256 with 2 HR and 18 RBIs while going 14-for-17 in SB while ranking top-10 among CF in MLB with 9 Defensive Runs Saved. He was placed on the 10-day injured list on August 4 with a right oblique strain. He was claimed by the Cardinals in September 2023 after being DFA'd by the Reds. He played in 10 games for Triple-A Memphis but did not appear in a game for Springfield.

SLAM THE DOOR: Cardinals closer **Matt Svanson** has been lights out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. **Svanson** is a perfect 23-for-23 and his 46 appearances lead all of Double-A while his 23 saves is 2nd in MiLB. So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer has allowed just one earned run in 23.2 IP (0.38 ERA) and is 13-for-13 in save opportunities. **Svanson** has allowed just one un-earned run over his last 18 appearances, allowing just 12 H with 19 K over 22.2 IP. The Cardinals are 50-1 when leading after 8 innings this season.
