LAST OUTING: McKendry pitched three innings in relief on August 24 vs. Jacksonville. He allowed a pair of runs in Nashville's 10-1 loss.

AGAINST OPPONENT: McKendry has faced the Redbirds nine times (1 in

2022, 6 in 2023, 2 in 2024) and made seven starts. He is 3-2 with a 4.87 ERA (44.1 IP/24 ER) all-time against the Knights. Four of those nine outings have come as a member of the Sounds.

2024 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

• Went 0-2 with a 6.60 ERA (19.0 IP/11 ER) through first three starts before being placed on injured list

• Picked up first saves since 2021 on July 25 vs. Charlotte (3.0 IP) and August 1 at Gwinnett (3.0 IP)
